ing for a 2 1/2-length score over the promising Summer Raven. "I was not surprised with the way she ran in her debut," commented trainer Patrick Biancone. "She had trained well and we liked her very much before that race. [Jockey] Edgar [Prado] gave her a lovely ride. She relaxed well like she did in the morning." Broadway Gold (Seeking the Gold), won her first two career starts, including the June 27 Astoria S., but was most recently the beaten favorite in the GII Schuylerville S. on opening day, finishing fifth behind Classic Elegance (Carson City). She may not have cared for the off going that afternoon and gets a chance to make amends today. Play With Fire (Boundary) looked every bit a 48-1 longshot as she raced 12 lengths off the pace in her July 29 debut. She looked more like 1-5 after charging home a 2 1/4-length winner, with a final sixteenth of a mile in less than six seconds and could be the one to take advantage of a speed duel up front.

The Old Warrior Fights On...

Despite Bahamian Pirate's past glories, he had looked exposed in his old age despite being kept continually on the go. He showed in his 11th outing this term that he retained all his ability when upsetting Balmont (Stravinsky) in a conditions race at Newmarket July 23, but had subsequently disappointed when sixth back on a firm surface in the G3 King George S. at Goodwood last time July 29. "He gave me a great ride and a furlong out I knew if he went through with it, he'd win," explained Sanders. "It was pretty straightforward and I thought I had everything pretty much covered at halfway," Sanders continued. "He loves that soft ground and [trainer] Dandy [Nicholls] said beforehand if he runs up to his best he's got every chance, but they were more hopeful than confident." Nicholls added, "It's marvelous for such an old horse to come back and dig in the ground. He didn't look nine today and he's a grand horse to train." After much deliberation, Aidan O'Brien decided to let the 3-1 pick One Cool Cat (Storm Cat) take his chance and he justified that decision by flashing home late to grab the third spot. "He's only a threeyear-old, so Jamie [Spencer] had to nurse him and let him find his way and he came out with as much credit as he could without winning," the trainer said. "He's really a horse you look forward to running now and the G1 Haydock Sprint Cup [Sept. 4] and G1 Prix de l'Abbaye de Longchamp [Oct. 3] are options open to him. I made the wrong decisions to run him at a mile-when we brought him back in trip he showed what he could do." Bahamian Pirate will also now be aimed at the Sprint Cup and Prix de l'Abbaye.

Settled in the rear, Soar quickened through the quagmire to head Salsa Brave at the eighth peg and had it comfortably sewn up in a matter of strides. "You never know how they will handle this ground until they actually race on it," Fanshawe commented. "She'll meet Damson in the G1 Cheveley Park S. 

Azeri Sizzles in Work:

Azeri (Jade Hunter) continued her march toward a scheduled start in the Aug. 27 GI Personal Ensign H. with a sparkling workout over the Oklahoma training track Thursday morning. The six-year-old mare, accompanied by regular exercise rider C.T. Lang, covered six furlongs in a crisp 1:11 3/5. "She's something else," said trainer D. Wayne Lukas. "That's mind boggling after the harrow break. Usually I breeze her early in the morning, but today I elected to go later because I wanted to see her all the way around." Commenting on the sluggish nature of the Oklahoma surface, Lukas added, "[Trainer] Nick [Zito] told me that's a world's record on that track. One clocker said he's never seen anything like it." Azeri, who won the GI Apple Blossom H. at Oaklawn earlier this year, most recently defeated Sightseek in the GI Go For Wand H. Aug. 1. "I think I'm getting on the same page with her more a little bit every day," said Lukas. "It always has been a trial-and-error experience. I think I'm learning more about what she likes and dislikes: little subtle things that you do every day with her. I think I am doing a better job with her, frankly."

Jerkens Readies Bowman's Band and Medallist:

Trainer H. Allen Jerkens worked a pair of his stable standouts, Medallist (Touch Gold) and Bowman's Band (Dixieland Band), yesterday over the Saratoga main track. Bowman's Band, who is slated to make his next start in Sunday's GII Saratoga Breeders' Cup H., negotiated seven furlongs in 1:27. "We've been thinking about the race all along," said Jerkens. "We just wanted to give him a final work before this race." The six-yearold most recently ran third in the GI Whitney H. Aug. 7. Also sent out to the main track, stablemate Medallist covered five panels in :59 4/5 and is likely to make his next start in the seven-furlong GI King's Bishop S. Aug. 28. "He's always been a sharp workout horse," commented Jerkens. "Another horse tried to go with him and we decided to slow down Medallist. Otherwise, we would have probably gone with him. He's such a competitive horse." An impressive winner of the May 1 GIII Withers S. and the July 11 GII Dwyer S., Medallist finished fifth in his latest start going two turns for the first time in the GII Jim Dandy S. Aug. 8.

Roses in May Breezes:

Roses in May (Devil His Due), winner of the GI Whitney H. Aug. 7, breezed four furlongs in :48 at Saratoga yesterday morning. "I just wanted him to go out there and stretch his legs," trainer Dale Romans said. "He looked good out there and came back fine. In the meantime, we are going to continue looking at our options for his next race." The four-year-old colt may start next in either the GII Kentucky Cup Classic at Turfway Sept. 28, the GI Jockey Club Gold Cup at Belmont Oct. 2 or the GII Hawthorne Gold Cup at Hawthorne Park Oct. 2.

Canadian Frontier to Questroyal Stud:

Trainer Mike Moroney who trained 2000 Cup winner Brew (Aus) has nominated 23 horses, eight more than Gai Waterhouse and 10 more than Bart Cummings. Godolphin has nominated nine horses for this year's race, while Dermot Weld has six. Irish trainer Aidan O'Brien, who is sending horses to Australia, entered Brian Boru (GB), Excalibur (Ire), Powerscourt (GB) and Solskjaer (Ire).
