It happened seven times in the first 30 years the double was possible--from 1881 through 1921, a septet of GI Spinaway S. winners came back to take the GI Alabama S. the following year. But, in the last 83 years, there has only been one filly capable of winning

both races, and that was Top Flight, who followed her Spinaway victory in 1931 with an Alabama score in 1932. Can Ashado (Saint Ballado) become the first in more than seven decades to match her feat? She will be heavily favored to do so Horsephotos at Saratoga this afternoon. First or second in 10 of her 11 ca-

reer starts, the dark bay took both the Spinaway and the GII Schuylerville S. at the Spa last year. She settled for third in the GI Frizette S. and second in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies, but has won four of her six starts since, including the Apr. 30 GI Kentucky Oaks and, in her most recent start, the July 24 GI Coaching Club American Oaks at the Alabama distance of 10 furlongs. Trainer Todd Pletcher said, "She runs a good race all the time. The mile and a quarter is not a problem, and she has good tactical speed, so she's pretty versatile." But adding her name to the record books is far from a cinch. Ashado faces Stellar Jayne (Wild Rush), who got the better of her in the June 26 GI Mother Goose S., and GII Delaware Oaks heroine Yearly Report (General Meeting). The Cal-bred has been beaten just once, running second in the Dec. 27 California Breeders' Championship S. in her juvenile finale. And, according to trainer Bob Baffert, "She shouldn't have lost that day. She had some trouble at the start and it cost her." She makes her first start against Grade I company in the Alabama. "We'll see what she's made of," Baffert said. Alabama field, p2

Afleet Alex (Northern Afleet), who won his first three starts by a combined 28 1/2 lengths, will try to make it a perfect four-for-four in the GI Hopeful S. at Saratoga Race Course this afternoon. The bay colt kicked off his career with an 11 1/4-length maiden victory at Dela-

ware Park June 26 and came back to take an allowance test at that track by 12 lengths July 12. He made his stakes debut as the slight 3-1 favorite in the July 29 GII Sanford S. and was once again much the best, beating Flamenco (Dance Master) and Consolidator (Storm Cat) in handy fashion. He stretches out to seven furlongs for the first time, but trainer Tim Ritchey is not concerned about the added eighth. "He rates very kindly and that's a big

plus with two-year-olds trying to get more distance," Ritchey said. While Afleet Alex has proved he can conserve his speed, Devils Disciple (Devil His Due) has gone gate to wire in his last two, taking the July 3 Criterium S. by nine lengths and the July 25 Dear Murray S. by 9 1/2, both at Calder. Off at 8-5 in her career opener, Sense of Style earned a 91 Beyer for her maiden win going 6 1/2 furlongs at Saratoga Aug. 1 and was the odds-on choice facing Grade I company at second asking. Never far from the front, the bay took over as they raced into the stretch and pulled away to win with ease. But trainer Patrick Biancone is convinced that she will only get better as the races get longer. "Seven furlongs, I would say, is going to be the minimum she wants," he said. "The way she is bred, distance is never going to be a problem." As for what lies ahead, he added, "We'll look at the Matron [GI at Belmont Park Sept. 19]. If she keeps going the way she has been going, we may go for the Breeders' Cup [at Lone Star Park Oct. 30]."

Aidan O'Brien, who saddled Giant's Causeway and Hawk Wing to take this contest, is represented by Oratorio and Carnegie Hall this time. While both are unproven on a soft surface, the former has form at the top level, having chased home Damson (Ire) when runner-up in the G1 Phoenix S. at this track last time Aug. 8. That followed a success in the G3 Anglesey S. Carnegie Hall was scoring on his debut on the undercard here July 18. That may not be the case for Artiste Royal, who delivered an impressive turn of foot to beat Islero Noir the Listed Prix Ridgway on a faster surface at Deauville last time Aug. 1. But his sister Aquarelliste (Fr) was never at her best in the mud and he heads a weak home defence alongside Delfos, who needs to improve on his second in the G2 Prix Eugene Adam (Grand Prix de Maisons-Laffitte) last time July 14. Lord Mayor has had genuine excuses for not building on his success in a competitive Epsom handicap June 5, but he showed when fifth in the Listed July Trophy at Haydock last time July 17 that he is compromised by rain-softened ground.

The 14-year-old mare had produced a Storm Cat colt May 28 for Eagle Holdings, a subsidiary of Ireland's Coolmore Stud. Bred by Sugar Maple Farm, she was the first foal from GI Alabama S. heroine Maplejinsky and was acquired by Georgia Hofmann--who had bred Maplejinsky and sold her as a yearling--for \$355,000 at the Fasig-Tipton Saratoga Sale. Sky Beauty crossed the finish line first in each of her five starts at two, including the GI Matron S. and the GII Adirondack S., but was disqualifed from victory in the GI Spinaway S. After opening her three-year-old season with a second in Gulfstream's GII Bonnie Miss S., the bay returned to her beloved New York, where she rattled off a winning sequence in the GI Acorn S., GI Mother Goose S., GI CCA Oaks, GI Alabama S. and the GII Rare Perfume S. But her chances for an Eclipse Award disappeared when she travelled to Santa Anita for the GI Breeders' Cup Distaff, only to run fifth to subsequent champion Hollywood Wildcat. Her four-year-old campaign was somewhat similar, as she started with five straight victories that included the GI Shuvee H., GI Hempstead H., GI Go for Wand H. and the GI Ruffian H.--the latter under 130 pounds--but faltered to ninth in the GI Breeders' Cup Distaff, this time at Churchill Downs. Still, she was honored with the Eclipse Award as Champion Older Mare, and returned to race again at five. After repeating her victory in the GIII Vagrancy H., the Allen Jerkens trainee was second in the Shuvee and third in the Hempstead, and was retired to stud with a record of 21-15-2-2 and a bankroll of \$1,336,000. Sky Beauty produced three foals for Hofmann's Wycombe House Stud, including two winners, before selling in foal to Gone West as part of a dispersal in 1999 at Keeneland November, where John Magnier signed the ticket for her at \$2.85 million. Her next three foals were by Storm Cat, including the current two-year-old filly Desert Tigress, a winner in Ireland. Sky Beauty's yearling colt by Storm Cat was withdrawn from last week's Fasig-Tipton Saratoga Sale. Sky Beauty was among the nominees for the Hall of Fame this year.

KATIES EUTHANIZED Katies (Ire) (Nonalco--Mortefontaine {Fr}, by Polic {Fr}) was euthanized yesterday at Taylor Made Farm in Nicholasville, Kentucky due to the infirmities of advancing age. The 23-year-old mare, winner of the 1984 G1 Irish 1000 Guineas and England's champion three-year-old filly that season, had resided at Taylor Made since 1989 when she was purchased by Masaichiro Abe for \$1 million at the Fasig-Tipton November sale. In 1998, she again went through the sales ring, selling to Aaron and Marie Jones for \$625,000. For Abe, Katies produced multiple Japanese champion Hishi Amazon (Theatrical {Ire}) and Japanese stakes winners Hishi Nile (A.P. Indy) and Hishi Pinnacle (Theatrical {Ire}). She was the dam of 15 foals, seven of whom were offered at public auction, where they averaged \$875,000. Machikane Ukon (Theatrical {Ire}), now five, sold for \$1 million at the 2000 Keeneland July Yearling sale and Word of Mouth (Saint Ballado), now four and unraced, sold to The Thoroughbred Corporation for \$2.6 million at that same sale in 2001. He re-sold as part of The Thoroughbred Corporation dispersal at the Barretts March sale this spring for \$525,000. Katies has a 2004 colt by Theatrical (Ire). The mare will be buried at Taylor Made.





CHRB Delays Rulings on Jockey Weight Issues:

The California Horse Racing Board heard two hours of testimony regarding the on-going jockey weight debate during its monthly Board meeting, but delayed making any decisions on the issue. There were two hours of testimony concerning the Jockeys' Guild proposal that would establish a minimum weight of 118 pounds for jockeys riding in Thoroughbred races, not including clothing and equipment, and would require that any rider licensed after Jan. 1, 2004 maintain a body-fat content of at least 5 percent. CHRB Board members were divided on whether California should go ahead and take action, or await a national resolution on the subject. CHRB Chairman John Harris asked the staff to "come up with another proposal" that would address the concerns of the Board, and said he will review recommendations by the American Dietary Association. The issue will be revisited at the next CHRB meeting, set for Sept. 15.

Roy Wood to Retire:

Roy Wood, the executive director of the California Horse Racing Board, will retire at year's end, it was announced Thursday. Wood, 60, has held his post since Jan. 1, 1994. He cited the health problems of his wife, Gennie, as the reason for his retirement. "California is a paradise for most of us, but it's a different story for people with respiratory problems, including my wife Gennie," Wood said. "She has not been able to adapt to the air quality in the Sacramento area, and it is on the advice of medical counselors that she should not remain a resident of the area." The Woods will relocate to Louisiana. Roy Minami, the assistant executive director who oversaw operations in 1993 as the CHRB sought a new executive director, will once again hold the post as interim director while a new search is undertaken for a permanent replacement for Wood.
