but it is only in the last decade that it has gained popularity as a prep for the Midsummer Derby.

A Classic Double?

No less than 56 GI Belmont S. winners have gone on to try their luck in the Travers, and exactly half have completed the double, including Triple Crown winner Whirlaway and greats like Ruthless, Man o'War, Native

Dancer, Damascus and Arts and Letters. Point Given was the last to add the accomplishment to his resume in 2001. But, in modern history, no colt has tried to go straight from the Belmont to the Travers without a prep. Can Birdstone (Grindstone) break that streak? Trainer Nick Zito is not concerned about the layoff since his last start.

"That's how he runs his best races," Zito, who also saddles The Cliff's Edge (Gulch), second in the Aug. 8 Jim Dandy; and Sir Shackleton (Miswaki), who will try to become the first to use the GIII West Virginia Derby as his Midsummer Derby prep. The pressure of having three starters in a million-dollar event is starting to build for Zito. "I'm starting to feel it, but...you've got to enjoy these things," he said. "I hope I'm doing the same thing next year and every year until I retire. It's an up-and-down game--you've got to know when it's your turn. Yeah, there's pressure, but be thankful these horses are in there and they're OK." Travers cont. p2

"He ran so well in the Jim Dandy--I hope he can duplicate it," said the meet's leading trainer, who bids for his first Travers score. "It was as good as any three-year-old has run all year." But

Purge Adam Coglianese the connections of The Cliff's Edge

(Gulch), runner-up in the Jim Dandy, and **Eddington** (Unbridled), who was third that afternoon, are hoping to follow in the hoofsteps of the six who improved on their Jim Dandy efforts on Travers day. "Hopefully [Purge] will regress a little bit," said Eddington's trainer, Mark Hennig. "If he regresses and we move forward, maybe we can make a race of it."

From the Jersey Shore to a Travers Score...

The last three Travers winners who shipped to the Haskell for their final prep--Point Given (2001), Coronado's Quest (1998) and Holy Bull (1994)--were victorious at Monmouth Park as well. **Lion Heart** (Tale

of the Cat) looks more than capable of adding his name to that list. With jockey Joe Bravo aboard, the chestnut led every step of the way in his last start, but trainer Patrick Biancone maintains that his speed is now under control. "Before, we couldn't really handle him," Biancone said. "He wanted to

do everything his own way. Now he does everything our way. He's a lot more mature." He added, "He's a tough horse. Not many horses have his speed and stamina." Nick Zito agrees. Aug. 8. Medallist had blazed his way downstate in the GIII Withers S. May 1 and the GII Dwyer S. July 11, putting up 110 and 112 Beyer Speed

CHAMPIONS DAY AT THE SPA Storm Flag Flying

(Storm Cat) and Azeri (Jade Hunter) both reigned as queens of the 2002 Breeders' Cup. Azeri concluded her Horse of the Year campaign with a Distaff victory, while Storm Flag Flying's future seemed limitless after an unbeaten, championship season was capped by triumph in the Juvenile Fillies. But 2003 proved anticlimactic for the Phipps homebred, who failed to win in two starts at three and spent most of the year on the sidelines with a small fracture in her right hind cannon bone. After returning with a win in a Gulfstream optional claimer in February, the dark bay was third in the GII Distaff Breeders' Cup H. Mar. 27 before getting her picture taken in the GII Shuvee H. May 15. She was second--with Azeri fourth--in the GI Ogden Phipps H. June 19 at Belmont, then ran third to the two-time Eclipse Champion Older Mare in the GI Go for Wand H. Aug. 1.

Pace 101...

When the gates sprang open, **Roar Emotion** (Roar) bounced out quickly to set the pace under Jerry Bailey, and Pat Day proved unable to get 3-5 Azeri to settle into an easy rhythm 1 1/2 lengths behind in second. Roar Emotion raced along with fractions of :23.15 and :46.26, but Azeri moved to her throatlatch through three-quarters in 1:09.78, and Roar Emotion began to drop back at the head of the lane. But Storm Flag Flying, seven lengths behind on the backstretch, advanced on the far turn and came up to head Azeri with a furlong to go. Though the six-year-old valiantly tried to stave off her younger rival, Storm Flag Flying switched back to her right lead late and drew clear in the final strides. The two could meet again, perhaps even before the Breeders' Cup. "The Breeders' Cup Distaff [Oct. 30] is where we want to go, and I could train her up to it," McGaughey said. "We'll wait and see how she comes out. We'll see how the Beldame [GI, Oct. 9] and Spinster [GI, Oct. 10] shake out." According to Azeri's trainer D. Wayne Lukas, the latter is the next stop for the chestnut. "We'll bring her back to Kentucky for the Spinster at Keeneland," he confirmed. Lukas was pleased with Azeri's effort. "I felt she ran a strong race," he said. "Pat got into the race a little more than what we would have wanted; she was trying to run and he let her run. I'm not critical of that. It came down to two champions."

Settled in a stalking role early by William Mongil, he was committed at the top of the straight, where the French challenger Glavalcour (Fr) (Glaieul) clipped heels and fell, bringing down Rajpute (Ger) (Deploy {GB}) in the process. Ay Caramba beat subsequent GII Inglewood H. winner Leroidesanimaux (Brz) in a Group 1 event going a mile on the grass at Gavea in June Of 2003, but ended his Brazilian stint with a sixth-place effort in a 10-furlong Group 1 run over a heavy turf last September. Nayyir returns to the scene of his finest domestic efforts when successful in the G2 Lennox S. last July and second in the G1 Sussex S. last time July 28. He had Hurricane Alan back in seventh when going down by only a neck to Soviet Song (Ire) in the Sussex over course and distance and should confirm that form on his favored soft surface. But trainer Gerard Butler has warned that heavy ground may mean that Nayyir will be scratched. "I have walked the course myself and the jockeys are talking about it being very testing," he told PA Sport yesterday. "The horse does not want extremes of going, neither too hard or too soft. They say they are not forecast to get any more rain and obviously I hope that is the case, but looking up at the sky, I could not be sure it will be dry." Chic put a string of disappointments firmly behind her when taking the G3 Hungerford S. in authoritative style over seven furlongs at Newbury last time Aug. 14, but connections are wary of risking her on the testing conditions. "It's difficult to say whether she will run, because we are waiting to see what happens with the weather," owner/breeder Cheveley Park Stud's Managing Director Chris Richardson told PA Sport yesterday. "I think that she will be fine stepping back up to a mile, but if the ground is testing, it's not ideal." Passing Glance took the G3 Diomed S. at Epsom June 5 before finding the competition too hot in the Sussex, but shaped better when fourth behind subsequent G1 International S. runner-up Norse Dancer (Ire) in the G3 Sovereign S. at Salisbury last time Aug. 12. He bids to go one better than 12 months ago, when he was denied by a head by Priors Lodge (Ire) in this race.



West Nile Claims Racehorse:

California Horse Racing Board officials have confirmed that Quick Nip (Whiskey Wisdom) was euthanized Aug. 10 at Golden Gate Fields after the fiveyear-old mare was infected with the West Nile Virus. Claimed for \$12,500 out of a winning effort May 30 at Hollywood Park, Quick Nip had not raced since finishing sixth at that track July 9. Though infected horses are not contagious, owners and trainers are urged to maintain vaccination schedules. "Two excellent weapons we have against this disease are mosquito control and two USDA fully licensed equine vaccines," said Dr. Annette Whiteford, director of Animal Health & Food Safety Services with the California Department of Food and Agriculture. "We urge horse owners to consult with their veterinary practitioners to make certain that the vaccination status of their horse is current. It is also very important to remember that a horse infected with the West Nile Virus is not contagious. The horse does not amplify the virus sufficiently to infect and enable biting mosquitoes to spread the disease to other horses or humans."
