Kentucky Derby runner-up Lion Heart (Tale of the Cat--Satin Sunrise, by Mr. Leader) suffered a broken coffin bone in his right front foot while running seventh and last in Saturday's GI Travers S. at Saratoga and has



been retired from racing. Purchased by Michael Tabor and Derrick Smith for \$1.4 million at the 2003 Fasig-Tipton February Sale, Lion Heart was unbeaten in three starts at two and ended his juvenile campaign with a 3 ½-length victory in the GI Hollywood Futurity. He began 2004 with runner-up efforts in the GII

San Rafael S. and GI Blue Grass S. before a game secondplace finish behind Smarty Jones in the Kentucky Derby. A well-beaten fourth in the Preakness S., the chestnut rebounded with wins in the GIII Long Branch Breeders' Cup S. and GI Haskell Invitational H. at Monmouth Park. Sent off the 5-2 Travers favorite off his Haskell victory, Lion Heart set the pace Saturday, but faded badly turning for home. Trainer Patrick Biancone said the injury, which will not require surgery, likely occurred when the colt switched leads nearing the stretch run. "The horse has been very generous to us," Biancone said. "He gave everything he had. I'll look forward to training his babies." On the board in eight of 10 starts, Lion Heart retires with five wins and earnings of \$1,390,800.

Birdstone Heads Straight to Classic

Birdstone (Grindstone), winner of Saturday's GI Travers S. at Saratoga Racecourse, will not start again until the 10-furlong GI Breeders' Cup Classic at Lone Star Oct. 30, according to trainer Nick Zito yesterday. "Marylou Whitney and John Hendrickson said [yesterday] they'd like to go right to the Classic," Zito said. "If he's gonna fire his best shot, might as well go for four million dollars." Zito added, "I've told everyone enough times that this horse needs time between races, so what else can I say, other than we showed you." Zito also indicated that Travers second-place finisher The Cliff's Edge (Gulch) came out of the 10-furlong contest in good order and is likely to make his next start in the GI Jockey Club Gold Cup at Belmont Park Oct. 2. "We'll walk him for the next few days," said McCarthy. Pletcher wouldn't confirm where the winner of the GII Jim Dandy S. will appear next, although he offered suggestions. "The [Jockey Club] Gold Cup [Belmont, Oct. 2] is a possibility, but he's a horse than can appreciate time, so it would come down to that or the GI Breeders' Cup [Oct. 30]," Pletcher said, adding, "We'll just take it day by day."
