
in Grade I races--a second in last year's Cigar Mile and a third in the Malibu--and will take plenty of action to finally break through.

NONSUCH BAY RETIRED Nonsuch Bay (Mr. Greeley--Brighter Than Gold, by Light Idea) has been retired by owners Joseph and Mary Platt, who plan on offering the five-year-old mare in the Keeneland November Breeding Stock sale. Purchased for \$75,000 at the 2001 OBS April Two-Year-Olds in Training Sale, the chestnut became a leading three-year-old of her generation with a runner-up finish in the GII Bonnie Miss S. and wins in the GII Nassau Breeders' Cup S. followed two starts later by the most important victory of her career in the GI Mother Goose S. Placed in no fewer than 16 stakes events, she recorded one victory in eight trips to the post this year, a successful defense of her title in the Banshee Breeze H. at Gulfstream Park. Bred in Kentucky by Sabine Stables, Nonsuch Bay retires with a record of 27-7-5-8 and earnings of \$747,078.

E.I. KELLY PASSES AWAY Trainer Edmund I. Kelly died Thursday at his home in Brooksville, Florida. He was 83. Kelly followed his brother, Hall of Famer Tommy, into racing and was working for Circle M Ranch in Kentucky when he was called on to serve in a tank outfit in Europe during World War II. He returned to Circle M after he was discharged, then took out his own trainer's license, saddling his first winner, Ardent Miss, in 1945. The Baltimore native enjoyed one of the longest-running and most successful partnerships in racing history, training for owner Harry Isaac's Brookfield Farm from 1949 until Isaac's death in 1990. The name of nearly every Brookfield runner began with an I. The collaboration produced Intentionally, the champion sprinter of 1959, as well as stakes horses I Enclose, I'm in Time, I'm Sky High, In From Dixie, In True Form, I Rejoice, I Speed Up and Is Your Pleasure. Kelly retired shortly after Isaac passed away, but remained a part of racing as an owner. He co-owned Lucky Coin, who won seven of nine starts, including the GII Kelso H., and was fourth in the 1997 GI Breeders' Cup Mile. He is survived by his wife, Margaret; sons E.I. Jr. and Michael and daughter Colleen; and brothers Tommy and John. Funeral arrangements are pending.

Backed at even-money to take his four-yearold debut in a \$100,000 optional claimer at Gulfstream Feb. 20, he didn't let his supporters down, winning by 1 1/4 lengths. Stepped up in class for his next start in the GII Mervin H. Muniz Jr. Memorial H. at the Fair Grounds last out Mar. 21, he could do no better than seventh. Returning off the long layoff here, he raced towards the back of the pack, was swung out for the stretch run and got up in time. In the six-time champion jockey's first interview since his high-profile arrest along with fellow jockeys Fergal Lynch and Darren Williams and trainer Karl Burke Wednesday, he told the *Daily Mirror* newspaper, "The whole thing is a complete joke. I make enough money through my percentage of prize money, riding fees and stallion rights. It's not in my nature--I've never done it and I never will. Obviously I've left myself a bit more open than I should have sometimes. I should have been more careful, but that's the top and bottom of it. We all know you can't fix races. It doesn't happen. It does in a fairytale world, but not in the real world." Those arrested could face reviews of their licences by the Jockey Club.
