American Post (GB) (Bering {GB}) and Antonius Pius (Danzig) return to the scene of this year's bizarre run-

ning of the May 16 G1 Poule d'Essai des Poulains for today's G1 Netjets Prix du Moulin de Longchamp. American Post started as the confident punters' choice on that occasion, but the support looked misplaced as Antonius Pius swamped him in the closing stages, only to stumble into the rail before the line. In the process, Aidan O'Brien's

raider not only lost all chance, but also interfered with Diamond Green (Fr) (Green Desert), who did well to hold on for second. All three have been held winless since. Diamond Green was second in both the G1 St James' Palace S. at Royal Ascot June 15 and the G3 Prix Messidor at Deauville July 11, but Antonius Pius, third in the St James's, has been off the board in his two subsequent starts, including a fifth in the July 28 G1 Sussex S. last time out. American Post failed to see out the extra half mile when sixth in the June 5 G1 Epsom Derby and makes his first appearance in nearly three months. Explaining the triple Group 1 winner's layoff, trainer Criquette Head-Maarek said, "He needed the break after the Derby. He had a hard race at Epsom and you can't run a horse when he's not at his best." The trio take on a field of top older milers.

Making Good on the Promise...

Midas Eyes was pegged as one to watch after posting a 9 1/4-length score in the GIII Swale S. at



Gulfstream Park in March of 2003 and came back to take the GIII Derby Trial in front-running fashion. But he went to the shelf after finishing second by a nose in the GII Riva Ridge Breeders' Cup S. in June and did not fare well in his comeback, finishing Midas Eyes Adam Coglianese eighth in the GI Breeders' Cup Sprint. He ended the year with a

second in the GI Cigar Mile H. in November and a third in the GI Malibu S. in December, but was shelved again after his fourth-place effort in the Strub. Bobby Frankel had him primed for his return, however, and the eyecatching bay responded with a 5 3/4-length allowance victory, stopping the timer for the 6 1/2 furlongs in 1:14 4/5, just two ticks off the track record. Let go at 7-2 in the Forego, Midas Eyes settled in third as first longshot Yessirgeneralsir (Patton) and then 9-5 favorite Strong Hope (Grand Slam) cut out fast fractions, but took over in the stretch and drew clear. "I bided my time, but at the same time I didn't want to give Strong Hope a little breather [because] every time he goes to the lead, he keeps on going," jockey Edgar Prado said. "My horse responded very well."

The Favorite Falters...

Strong Hope was also looking for his first Grade I success, but could not hang on. The four-year-old, winner of the GII Jim Dandy S. over this track last year, was coming off a third-place finish in the May 31 GI Met Mile. He was in front after a half in :44.91, but weakened in the final furlong and finished fourth. "It was a disappointment," trainer Todd Pletcher said. "He didn't run as well as I expected. It looked like he was going to put up a fight until the eighth pole, when he took a funny step. [Jockey John Velazquez] didn't know why he did it." Added Velazquez, "I don't know what he saw. I thought he was going to hold on for second, but then he just lost his momentum."

Silk and Scarlet carries Ballydoyle's main hopes this time, having won the hotly contested Listed Silver Flash S. at Leopardstown July 14 before beating Luas Line (Ire) and Chelsea Rose in the G2 Debutante S. over course and distance Aug. 8. She is opposed by the speedy Jewel in the Sand, who stretches out an extra panel after impressive scores in the Listed Albany S. at Royal Ascot June 18 and the G2 Cherry Hinton S. at Newmarket last time July 6. Conditioner Richard Hannon, who took this in 1993 with Lemon Souffle (GB), told PA Sport, "She's done very well since the July meeting and it is just a question now of whether she will get the trip." Of the more unexposed types, Pictavia and Saoire are interesting contenders. The former represents the Jim Bolger stable responsible for two previous winners and she had Umniya and Slip Dance behind her when finding the top-class Damson (Ire) two lengths too strong in the Listed Swordlestown Stud Sprint S. at Naas last time June 7. Saoire upset the highly regarded Mona Lisa (GB) in a Leopardstown maiden last time Aug. 15 and warrants respect, having been supplemented earlier in the week.

Of the older generation, last year's G1 Premio Vittorio di Capua winner Le Vie dei Colori shaped well on his debut for his new yard when third in the G1 Sussex S. at Goodwood last time July 28. "He has been pleasing us and he seems to be a horse that is improving," commented trainer Luca Cumani.
