


A ROSE GROWS AT THE CURRAGH

Chelsea Rose (Ire) (Desert King {Ire}) held on gamely to win yesterday's G1 Moyglare Stud S. at The Curragh by 3/4 lengths. The filly lowered the colors of Silk and Scarlet (Ire) (Sadler's Wells) on her debut in a Leopardstown maiden June 9, but could only finish third behind that rival in the G2 Debutante S. over course and distance last time Aug. 8. Trapped wide in mid-division under Pat Shanahan throughout the early stages yesterday, Chelsea Rose raced keenly without cover and was asked to stride to the front passing the three-furlong marker. The 9-1 chance was tackled by Belle Artiste (Ire) (Namid {GB}) soon after, but repelled that challenge before asserting in the closing stages as Pictavia (Ire) (Sinndar {Ire}) and the luckless Saoire (GB) (Pivotal {GB}) ate into her advantage. "We always thought an awful lot of her," explained trainer Con Collins' daughter Tracey. "Whatever she did this year was always going to be a bonus, as she will improve." She added, "She will not run again this season and her campaign will be geared around a crack at next year's G1 Irish Oaks here in July." TAPIT RETURNS IN PENNSYLVANIA DERBY

It's not the Smarty party that Philadelphia Park officials were hoping for, but a solid field of 12 sophomores will go postward in today's GII Pennsylvania Derby. The 1 1/8-miles contest is headed by **Tapit** (Pulpit), who has been sidelined by respiratory problems since running ninth behind Smarty Jones in the May 1 GI Kentucky Derby. The gray colt, trained by Michael Dickinson, stamped his ticket to the Derby with a gutsy half-length victory in the Apr. 10 GI Wood Memorial. The field also includes the former claimer turned graded stakes performer My Snookies Boy (Crafty Friend). Claimed for \$50,000 in April, the chestnut colt was a game second behind Lion Heart in the July 17 GIII Long Branch Breeders' Cup S. and was runner-up to that rival again in the Aug. 8 GI Haskell Invitational H. Nick Zito, with a deep sophomore bench, will saddle Pies Prospect (Crafty Prospect) and GI Belmont S. third-place finisher Royal Assault (Kris S.) in the Pennsylvania Derby. "The original plan was to run [Grey Lilas] in the G1 Prix de l'Opera [at Longchamp Oct. 3], but we felt she had won so easily in the Nonette that she had not done enough, as she needs a lot of work," commented Andre Fabre, who was collecting his fifth renewal of this event. "We decided to give her another race and I knew she had come back to her best." Grey Lilas had provided Stevens with his first French winner when taking a course-and-distance conditions event Apr. 4, and gave the American his first group score when following up in the G3 Prix de la Grotte over the same terrain three weeks later. She found only Torrestrella (Ire) too strong in the G1 Poule d'Essai des Pouliches (French 1000 Guineas) at Longchamp May 16 before filling the third spot in the G1 Prix de Diane at Chantilly June 13. Her tune-up at Deauville and subsequent work had shown Andre Fabre that she was ready to mix it with the colts. "I would like to thank Gary Stevens for the great job he has done with this filly, as she has always come back remarkably well from her races," Fabre added. "She will now go for the [G1 Prix de l'Opera], as she is not eligible for the Breeders' Cup." Runner-up Diamond Green will be pointed at the G1 Queen Elizabeth II S. at Ascot Sept. 25 or the G1 Champion S. at Newmarket Oct. 16.

WARRSAN FLIES TO BADEN-BADEN WIN

Warrsan (Ire) (Caerleon) furnished Kerrin McEvoy with his finest moment since leaving his native Australia when holding the outsider Egerton (Ger) (Groom Dancer) in a pulsating finish to yesterday's G1 Preis von Baden. In so doing, he provided trainer Clive Brittain, who has been something of a pioneer on the international stage throughout his career, with handsome reward for his bold campaigning of the tough six-yearold. The Saeed Manana homebred fared well on his travels last term, winning the G1 Coronation Cup at Epsom in June and finishing second in the G1 Gran Premio di Milano later that month, then running third in the G1 Pokal at Cologne in August, the G1 Gran Premio del Jockey Club at Milan in October and the G1 Hong Kong Vase at Sha Tin in December. Warrsan showed he retained all his ability when collecting a second Coronation Cup June 4 and only went down by a head to Refuse to Bend (Ire) after a battle royal in the G1 Eclipse S. at Sandown July 3. As he had 12 months ago, he disappointed when trailing in the G1 King George VI & Queen Elizabeth Diamond S. at Ascot last time July 24, but bounced back after a freshener to break the million-pound mark in earnings. Reserved in mid-division throughout the early stages as the evenmoney pick Mubtaker (Silver Hawk) proved a reluctant leader, he was brought wide for his challenge on the turn into the straight as that rival faded. Shirocco (Ger) (Monsun {Ger}) and Andreas Suborics went to the front approaching the quarter pole, but Warrsan swooped immediately to take control and had enough in the tank to hold the late lunge of the maiden Egerton and Andreas Helfenbein. "He is a very tough horse and likes traveling," Brittain told PA Sport. "Maybe we will now run in the G1 Irish Champion S. [at Leopardstown] in a week's time, or maybe we will go for the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe [at Longchamp Oct. 3]." Mubtaker's jockey Richard Hills reported that the favorite, who faded early in the straight to finish seventh, "didn't like the ground." Chart p3. 

SUCCESS AT BADEN-BADEN

Apart from the fireworks created by John Ferguson's bid of €400,000 for hip 66, Gestut Brummerhof's Acatenango (Ger) colt, Saturday's Baden-Baden Yearling Sale was marked by a major strengthening of the middle market. With a strong foreign contingent present, thanks mainly to the international exploits of German-bred horses this year, the session provided evidence that German bloodstock is more marketable than ever before. In a particular boost to the domestic sphere, home-based sires such as Acatenango, Big Shuffle, Dashing Blade (GB), Lando (Ger) and Monsun (Ger) generated considerable overseas interest. Figures were up across the board, with a 76-percent clearance rate, a 37-percent increase in average and a healthy 93percent rise in the median. Not long after the excitement surrounding hip 66 had died down, Dirk Eisele's BBA Germany caught the crowd's attention when paying \in 220,000 for hip 143, a colt from the first crop of Galileo (Ire) from the draft of Gestut Wittekindshof. He was out of the prolific producer La Luganese (Ire), the dam of the G2 Henkel-Rennen (German 1000 Guineas) winner La Blue (Ger) from the family of the champion Lomitas (GB). Gestut Fahrhof secured the top-priced filly when he bought hip 79, Gestut Park Wiedingen's Monsun half-sister to Friday's Listed Baden-Baden Cup winner Qsar (Ger), for \in 170,000.

THIS MONTH IN RACING HISTORY...

September 7, 1970...Del Mar...**Bill Shoemaker** surpassed Johnny Longden's record of 6,032 wins, guiding dares J to victory to become the world's winningest jockey.

September 8, 1990...Del Mar...Bill Shoemaker scored his first stakes win as a trainer, saddling Baldomero (Ire) to capture the Osunitas H.

September 11, 1976...Jockey John Oldham and his wife, jockey Suzanne Picou, became the first husband and wife to compete in the same parimutuel race. Oldham finished second and Picou was 11th in the third race at Latonia.

September 12, 1970...Nijinsky II won the St. Leger S. and became the 15th winner of England's Triple Crown. No three-year-old has completed the Triple since.

September 13, 1974...Trainer D. Wayne Lukas notched his first Thoroughbred stakes victory, saddling his own three-year-old colt **Harbor Hauler** to take the second division of the Foothill S. at Pomona. The winner's share of the purse was \$6,312.
