ROMAN LOOKS TO RULE FUTURITY

A field of seven juveniles will go postward in today's GII Del Mar Futurity, with a pair of unbeaten colts set to battle it out for supremacy of their division. **Roman Ruler** (Fusaichi Pegasus), the prohibitive 3-5 morning-

line favorite, became an instant sensation with a dominating seven-length victory in the Aug. 15 GII Best Pal S. It was just the second career outing for the dark bay colt, who effortlessly won his debut by four lengths at Del Mar June 19, and came after a troubled trip in which he was forced to steady to avoid a fallen horse. Roman Ruler could

start a new Futurity streak for trainer Bob Baffert, who conditioned seven straight before missing out to Richard Mandella's Siphonizer last year. Baffert also has the once-raced maiden Allright (Silver Charm) entered in the seven-furlong Futurity. The 5-2 second choice on the morning line is the unbeaten Chandtrue (Yes It's True). The colt, who adds blinkers today, reeled off three straight stakes victories at Hollywood Park, culminating with a half-length tally in the July 17 GIII Hollywood Juvenile Championship. Also on his resume are a fourlength victory in the May 23 William Proctor Memorial S. and a seven-length romp in the June 20 Haggin S. The Futurity field also features maiden winner Declan's Moon (Malibu Moon), who powered clear to a fivelength debut win at Del Mar July 31.

CASTLE GANDOLFO DIES IN CHILE

The five-year-old stallion Castle Gandolfo (Gone West--Golden Oriole, by Northern Dancer) died Sunday in a breeding shed accident at Haras Mocito Guapo in Chile. He had entered stud at Walmac International in Kentucky earlier this year. "He had covered about 80 mares in Kentucky, and was booked to about 60 mares in Chile," said Walmac's Johnny Jones. Trained by Aidan O'Brien during the early part of his racing career, Castle Gandolfo captured the G3 Beresford S. at two and ran second to stablemates High Chaparral (Ire) and Ballingarry (Ire), respectively, in the G1 Racing Post Trophy and G1 Criterium de Saint-Cloud. The chestnut never regained his form following a 12th-place finish in the 2002 GI Kentucky Derby and was retired to stud at the beginning of this year. Produced by a full sister to champions El Gran Senor and Try My Best, he had stood for \$6,000 live foal at Walmac.

SOUTHERN IMAGE TO SKIP CLASSIC

GI Santa Anita H. winner **Southern Image** (Halo's Image) will not contest the GI Breeders' Cup Classic as he battles persistent foot problems. "The foot is better, but it won't be 110 percent for the Breeders' Cup," trainer Mike Machowsky told *Daily Racing Form*. The four-year-old colt has not started since running a narrowly beaten second in the GI Stephen Foster H. in June. To date, Southern Image has won six of eight races and earned \$1,843,750. In addition to the Big 'Cap, he won this year's GI Pimlico Special and last season's GI Malibu S.

GOT KOKO RETIRED

Grade I winner **Got Koko** (Signal Tap--Baby North, by Northern Baby) has been retired from racing with a recurring ankle injury, according to *Daily Racing Form*. "She just didn't make it back," trainer Bruce Headley told the *Form*. On the board in 12 of 15 starts, Got Koko won seven times and earned \$960,946. She captured the 2002 GI La Brea S. and the 2003 GII Lady's Secret Breeders' Cup H., GII La Canada S. and GII El Encino S. She was third in last year's GI Breeders' Cup Distaff and, in her final start, ran third in the GI Santa Monica H. in January.

The \$750,000 GII Pennsylvania Derby drew some very smart three-year-olds. The field included GI Wood Memorial S. victor Tapit; the GII Leonard Richards S. and GII Illinois Derby captor Pollard's Vision; Niigon, the hero of the Queen's Plate; My Snookie's Boy and Pies Prospect, an excellent second and third in the GI Haskell Invitational on their most recent appearance; and the GI Belmont S. third Royal Assault.

However, they were all decisively beaten for the cash by Love of Money, a horse who had never previously started in a stakes. In fact most of the main protagonists for the Pennsylvania Derby had established themselves as major players before Love of Money had even been seen in public, as Love of Money's first outing didn't come until a week after the GI Belmont S. In that debut, in a six-furlong Belmont maiden event, Love of Money led throughout to stroll home six lengths clear. He was the beaten favorite for a six-furlong allowance event at Belmont next time out, finishing second, but on his only other outing he made no mistake when rolling home six lengths clear in a Saratoga allowance, covering the seven furlongs in 1:22.2. In the Pennsylvania Derby, Love of Money was in front early, and despite trying to bear out early in the straight, he continued to draw off, eventually crossing the line 81/2 lengths clear of Pollard's Vision. Love of Money is a son of Not For Love, a horse who has established himself as the pride of the Maryland stallion community (in fact in 2003 he was the number one stallion by progeny earnings standing outside of Kentucky). A handsome and extremely well-bred individual (by Mr. Prospector out of Northern Dancer's Grade I-winning daughter Dance Number), Not For Love didn't quite live up to his pedigree or looks on the racetrack, and although he won six of 29 starts for earnings of \$178,870, the best he could do in stakes company was a third in a minor event, the 8½-furlong Bob Harding S. on turf.

As a stallion, however, Not For Love's career has more reflected his pedigree than his race record, and he has 27 stakes winners from his first five crops, most sired at relatively inexpensive stud fees. He already has nine individual stakes winners in 2004, with Love of Money being joined by other graded stakes winners He Loves Me, Angela's Love and Presidentialaffair. His earlier stars include the multiple graded stakes winning Duckhorn, and graded stakes scorers Touch Love, Sheila's Prospect and Four Rubies, and with the better mares he is now receiving as result of his early success, the record looks sure to continue improving.

Oddly enough, Not For Love's stud career is far more impressive than that of his full brother Rhythm. Champion at two, and winner of the GI Travers S. at three, Rhythm began his stud career in Japan. His only stakes winner from five crops in that country was the steeplechaser Legacy Rock.

Re-imported to the U.S., Rhythm, who now stands in California has sired four stakes winners from his first four crops, non of them graded. He did do better in a Southern Hemisphere foray, getting seven stakes winners in four crops, including G1 Melbourne Cup heroine and champion stayer Ethereal and two other graded winners. However, Not For Love is bred on similar lines to two more successful sires. He is half brother to the dam of Mutakddim (by a son of Not For Love's sire, Mr. Prospector), and his granddam, champion Numbered Account is a sister to the dam of Mr. Prospector's highly successful son, Woodman.

Love of Money is the fourth foal of his dam. Mescalina, and is half brother to two other winners, including the Concern filly, Astrid, winner of the My Juliet S. at Philadelphia Park, and the Serena's Song S. at Monmouth. Mescalina is a daughter of Smarten, a Maryland stalwart who also appears as broodmare sire of Not For Love's graded stakes-winning daughter Touch Love. Mescalina is half sister to another of Not For Love's best offspring, Sheila's Prospect, an earner of nearly \$500,000, who captured the GIII Bessarabian H. Love of Money's second dam, Tequila Sheila, is a multiple stakes placed daughter of Hagley, and she is half sister to Wisherwell, the granddam of another Maryland-bred Grade I winner in the shape of the Polish Numbers filly Tenski, successful in the GI Queen Elizabeth II Challenge Cup.

Since Love of Money's granddam produced a graded stakes winner by Not For Love, it's logical to look to the distaff side of Love of Money's pedigree for some affinities with Not For Love. The first is a reinforcement of the ubiquitous genetic relatives from the La Troienne family. Not For Love's granddam Numbered Account has the three-parts sisters Busanda and Striking (granddaughters of La Troienne) 2x3 in her pedigree, and Hagley (the broodmare sire of Love of Money's dam) is out of a mare by Jet Action, who was out of Striking's sister Busher. Love of Money's third dam, Well Bold, is by Boldnesian. He was by a son of Nasrullah out of mare by Polynesian, and this is reversed in Not For Love's sire Mr. Prospector, who is by a grandson of Polynesian, out of a mare by a son of Nasrullah. Not For Love's broodmare sire, Northern Dancer reinforces this, as he is by a son of Nearco (sire of Nasrullah) out of a mare by Native Dancer (son of Polynesian).


