### SMARTY JONES TO STAND FOR \$100,000

Recently retired Kentucky Derby and Preakness winner **Smarty Jones** (Elusive Quality--I'll Get Along, by Smile) will begin his stud career next year at Three Chimneys for a fee of \$100,000 guaranteed live foal. "We were oversubscribed for shares in Smarty Jones, and have had immense interest in him amongst breeders," said Three Chimneys owner Robert Clay. "Indeed, we began this week giving breeders the option of buying four-year contracts for Smarty Jones seasons, so that they can be assured they will have a season to the horse each of the first four years he is at stud." Smarty Jones' book of mares will be limited to 110 mares, plus one Breeders' Cup season.

### ACTION HEATS UP AT BELMONT

Racing returns to Belmont Park today and the stakes action will heat up in a hurry, with three Grade I events scheduled for Saturday. Highlighting the graded stakes menu is the GI Woodward S., which yesterday drew a field of eight headed by last year's GI Vosburgh winner **Ghostzapper** (Awesome Again). "People don't realize how good he is," Trainer Bobby Frankel said of Ghostzapper, who is coming off a win in the GIII Iselin H. "I guess it's because he hasn't won the big races, yet. He's a good horse. He just wins and he wins easy." Also on tap Saturday at Belmont are the GI Man o' War S. and the GI Gazelle S. Trainer H. Graham Motion has entered **Better Talk Now** (Talkin Man) in the Man o' War. "He's pretty consistent now," Motion said of the GI Sword Dancer Invitational H. winner. "He used to be pretty headstrong, but he's been much better this year. He's just gotten more mature." GI Mother Goose S. heroine **Stellar Jayne** (Wild Rush) will tackle eight foes in the Gazelle. The D. Wayne Lukas trainee is coming off a runner-up effort in the GI Alabama S. "She's just such a classy filly," said Lukas assistant Peter Hutton. "She's got such a big heart and I know Wayne has been very impressed with her." *Fields p5-6*

### ALL IN THE FAMILY

One day after her half sister Echoes in Eternity (Ire) took the G2 Park Hill S. over the St Leger trip at this track, **Playful Act (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells) showed the same family trait of class allied with stamina to knock two seconds off Doncaster's juvenile track record in capturing the G2 betfair.com May Hill S. After a runner-up performance in her debut at Newmarket Aug. 14, she registered a facile score at the same venue last time Aug. 27. Here, she was settled in third, off the strong early pace and was always in the right spot, with jockey Jimmy Fortune making the decisive move in tackling the leaders approaching the quarter pole. Hitting the front soon after, she galloped resolutely to the line as **Queen of Poland (GB)** (Halling) won her private battle for the runner-up spot with arch-rival **Maids Causeway (Ire)** (Giant's Causeway). "They went a good pace and it panned out perfectly, as she stays well," Fortune explained. "She really stuck to her game and she's a very nice filly." *Cont. p. 2*

Owner Ben Sangster hailed Playful Act's "fantastic performance" in yesterday's G2 May Hill S. and gave due credit to her trainer. "John Gosden was adamant that she should run back, as it was only 13 days since her last run, but I'm absolutely delighted," he said. "Magnificent Style has been a very lucky mare for us, as she's produced four stakes winners from four foals. She's at Coolmore Stud in foal to Sadler's Wells as we speak." The Florida-bred Magnificent Style, a half sister to Grade I winner Siberian Summer, captured the G3 Musidora S. in 1996. Her first foal is the American stakes winner Styleistick (Storm Cat). The 11-year-old mare is currently represented on the racecourse by four-year-old filly Echoes in Eternity (Ire) (Spinning World), a multiple Group 2 winner; and the highly regarded three-year-old colt Percussionist (Ire) (Sadler's Wells). She has a yearling filly by Danehill. Playful Act will be aimed at the G1 Fillies' Mile at Ascot Sept. 25, along with Maid's Causeway. **QUIFF LEGER DECISION LEFT LATE** Juddmonte Farms' **Quiff (GB)** (Sadler's Wells) has been declared for Saturday's G1 St Leger at Doncaster, but connections may yet scratch the filly if the forecasted rain fails to arrive on Town Moor. Khalid Abdullah's Racing Manager Teddy Grimthorpe announced, that while the St Leger is the aim for the impressive G1 Yorkshire Oaks heroine, "it will be a last-minute decision" as to whether she will line up against the colts in the Classic. The Sangster Family yesterday withdrew **Percussionist (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells), leaving nine to face Godolphin's likely favorite **Rule of Law** (Kingmambo). Racing Manager Simon Crisford issued an upbeat bulletin on the G2 Great Voltigeur S. winner on Wednesday. "Rule of Law is in tremendous condition," he said. "We're very happy with him and he has the right profile and credentials for the race." Of Percussionist's withdrawal from the race, Ben Sangster explained, "I spoke to John Gosden on Thursday morning and [Percussionist's] white cell count is high, quite how high I don't know, but he thinks the problem can be rectified over the weekend with a little bit of luck. If he were to do a nice piece of work next week, he might run in the G3 Arc Trial at Newbury." *Full Field p. 4*

For the first time since 1953, a dead heat was called in this marathon contest. While Millenary looked the certain winner as he claimed the grey inside the final eighth, Kasthari was not to be denied and staged a game rally to share the spoils. For Millenary's conditioner John Dunlop, it was a "wonderful" result for the 2000 G1 St Leger winner, who had taken the G2 Yorkshire Cup May 13 before filling third spot in the G2 Lonsdale Cup last time Aug. 17. "I thought he traveled very well all the way round and [jockey] Richard [Quinn] gave him lots of confidence," he said. Kasthari finished a length third in the G3 Jockey Club Cup behind Persian Punch (Ire) and Millenary on his latest start on the flat at Newmarket in October, before spending the winter over the jumps. His jockey Johnny Murtagh said, "I thought I had won, then Richard Quinn appeared on the scene and got a neck up, but my lad stays very well and when I gave him a few smacks, he really responded." Quinn added, "I knew I'd got him, but he just ran out of stamina as that's his limit, and the other fellow had the benefit of the rail." With track records falling like flies this week, Pastoral Pursuits became the latest to write his name in the history books with an impressive success, dipping well under the previous best which had stood since 1963. Sidelined after winning the G3 Sirenia S. at Kempton last August, he returned to finish a half-length runner-up to Madid (Ire) in the Listed Surrey S. when attempting to defy a six-pound penalty June 3. He showed he had the speed for six furlongs when taking the Listed Hackwood S. last time July 17. Ridden towards the rear throughout the early stages, he picked up in impressive fashion as Frankie Dettori took Firebreak to the fore at the quarter pole. Swamping that rival passing the eighth peg, he proved his stamina in the closing stages as the game runner-up rallied under his penalty. "He was a bit fresh and he's not a nice horse, but he's a good horse, so we'll allow him a bit of nonsense," said jockey Steve Drowne. Trainer Hughie Morrison added, "The G1 Prix de la Foret [at Longchamp Oct. 9] is a target, but he's already achieved more than we expected this year." Early March opened his account at Clairefontaine Aug. 26 and benefitted from an enterprising ride from Olivier Peslier to wire this contest. Always in control of the fractions, the imposing bay was hand-ridden to maintain his advantage as Stop Making Sense closed late under Christophe Soumillon. "He's a real nice colt," trainer Criquette Head-Maarek commented. "He won well first time, and confirmed his class today. All being well, he'll now return for the G1 Grand Criterium on Arc day [Oct. 3]."

"He's in good form and is training well," bin Suroor commented. "He has the class and he has improved all year." Mark Johnston interrupted the Godolphin juggernaut with Lucky Story 12 months ago and will be bidding for back-to-back renewals with Elliots World. He scored by six lengths on debut at York July 9 before his defeat of Oude last time. **Iceman** beat a host of subsequent stakes winners when taking the G2 Coventry S. at Royal Ascot last time June 15, but pays the price for that with a five-pound penalty in this contest. Barry Hills has won this race four times and saddles **Etlaala**, who looked promising when winning on debut at Newbury Aug. 14.

**WTBA Forced to Re-Sell 22 Yearlings:**

The Washington Thoroughbred Breeders Association has been forced to find new homes for 22 horses that were originally sold during Tuesday's Summer Yearling sale, according to *Blood-Horse*. The original buyer refused to pay for the horses, who were purchased by his recognized agent. Bloodstock agent Brett St. Amand signed the ticket for the horses who brought a total of \$341,000--12.2 percent of the auction's \$2,796,300 gross. St. Amand identified the buyer he was representing at the sale as Cecil Underwood and said, "Everything I did was in good faith with [Underwood]'s interests in mind. He wanted to get bargain horses and he didn't tell me how many to buy. He said, 'I can spend a half-million dollars on horses and not blink an eye.'" The WTBA will not charge consignors commissions on the unsold horses and will waive entry fees and commissions if the horses are entered in the organization's Dec. 5 mixed sale.

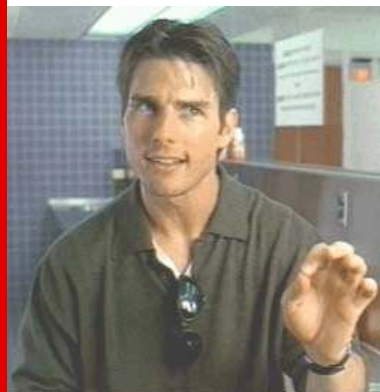
