MONARCHOS COLT TOPS AT KEENELAND A colt from the first crop of 2001 Kentucky Derby hero

Monarchos brought a final bid of \$550,000 to top yesterday's fifth session of the Keeneland September sale in Lexington. Consigned to the sale by the Woods Edge Farm of Peter O'Callaghan, the gray colt is a son of Lac du Printemps (Meadowlake), a full sister to GI Champagne S. winner Greenwood Lake as well as a half sister to GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile hero Success Express and Canadian champion Charley Barley. Trainer Bob Baffert signed the ticket on the Mar. 3 foal, "I'm very partial to grays," said Baffert, who was buying on behalf of Bob and Beverly Lewis. "I've been waiting for the Monarchoses and this horse was pretty outstanding looking. He looked the part. I like a certain look and he fit all of my qualifications." Woods Edge Farm, a pinhooking operation, has had a terrific sale thus far, consigning horses that sold for \$700,000 and \$650,000 on Wednesday in addition to yesterday's session topper. O'Callaghan was pleased that buyers such as the Lewises and their advisors thought so highly of the colt. "It's very satisfying," he admitted, adding that Woods Edge acquired the colt as a weanling in a private transaction. "He's a wonderful horse. He's the epitome of his sire--he looks a lot like him. And he's from one of the best families in the stud book. They liked him and we wish them the very best of luck," he said. The top-selling filly during Saturday's trade was a daughter of Arch--Questress (Seeking the Gold), purchased by Robert LaPenta's White Horse Stable for \$360,000. LaPenta, who campaigns The Cliff's Edge, also purchased a half brother to the filly for \$45,000 at this venue in 2002. That colt, who would become GI King's Bishop S. winner Pomeroy, was pinhooked for \$300,000 at the 2003 Fasig-Tipton Calder sale. Trainer Nick Zito, who signed the ticket on behalf of his client, did not immediately know whether LaPenta would keep the filly to race or return her to the two-year-old sales next year. The \$360,000 price tag was matched by hip 1421, a colt by Golden Missile--Ms. Copelan (Copelan). Consigned to the sale by Meg Levy's Bluewater Sales as agent, the bay was purchased by Mike Akers' Dapple Bloodstock. Akers has been in the Thoroughbred business for 15 years and his agency offers a wide variety of services to its clients. The racing arm of the operation, Dapple Stable, employs trainers Steve Asmussen, Bill Mott, Christophe Clement and Bertrand de Brevedent.
