Returning from a break after taking the G3 Superlative S. at Newmarket July 8, the imposing colt showed no sign of rustiness as he stalked Russian Blue (Ire) (Danehill) throughout the early stages. Frankie Dettori was in cruise control as he passed that rival at the quarter pole and his only concern was his colt's kink to-

wards the rail soon after, but he straightened Dubawi with a slap of the whip and the 8-13 favorite quickened all the way to the line to record a facile three-length score from the eyecatching Berenson (Ire) (Entrepreneur {GB}). "To have a son of Dubai Millennium win a Group 1 is a great day for Godolphin and he is now very much a Classic prospect for next year," commented Racing Manager Simon Crisford. National S. cont. p2

He gave the impression he had more in hand than the official half-length margin back to Henrik (GB) at Newmarket last time, and once again held something in reserve en rote to his first Group 1 score. "He has never stopped surprising me," Frankie Dettori commented. "I rode him in work this week and he had improved tremendously. He had the race won with one- and-a-half furlongs to go and is still very green. He reminds me very much of his sire." Trainer Saeed bin Suroor added that he will be put away until next season, when he is expected to be aimed at the G1 Epsom Derby. "He is improving all the time and will be better next year," he said. Sense of Style was sent off the 8-5 pick in her unveiling and didn't disappoint, storming from off the pace to win by 2 1/2 lengths at Saratoga Aug. 1. Handling the stiff ascent in class in the Aug. 20, seven-furlong GII Spinaway S., she looked even more impressive in her second trip to post, securing the comprehensive 6 3/4length victory with ease. Adding another panel here, the \$800,000 Keeneland September graduate was acting up a bit and was caught flat-footed as the gates sprang open, getting away last of six. Jockey Edgar Prado kept his mount relaxed and allowed her to settle before asking her to pick it up entering the turn. The leggy bay responded instantly, cruising up to collar the pacesetting Grateful Nancy (Maria's Mon) with a quarter mile left to run. Play with Fire, moving well widest of all, kept Sense of Style honest in mid-stretch, but the latter had another gear and was never seriously threatened. Balletto, racing greenly down the lane, showed good energy late to get the place spot. "I don't know what we'll do next with her," said trainer Patrick Biancone. "She has run three times in 50 days. We could run her once before the [GI] Breeders' Cup [Juvenile Fillies, Oct. 30], or go straight in. We're going to Texas tomorrow to see what the track is like, and decide if and for how long we want to train over it." One of the best racemares of her generation, Sightseek took a four-race winning skein, all versus Grade I competition, into last year's GI Breeders' Cup Distaff, where she never got going in a fourth-place effort at Santa Anita. She began the year with another uncharacteristically poor effort--a fourth in the GI Santa Monica H. at Santa Anita Jan. 25--but got back on track with a dominating win in the GII Rampart H. at Gulfstream in mid-March. Perhaps the slop was to blame when she finished fourth in the GII Louisville Breeders' Cup H. at Churchill Apr. 30, but a facile win in the GI Ogden Phipps H. at Belmont June 19 set the stage for a duel with the great Azeri in the Aug. 1 Go For Wand H. In that one, she gave it her all against the 2002 Horse of the Year and wasn't disgraced when finishing 1 3/4 lengths adrift of that foe. Hammered down to 1-5 favoritism against a lackluster field, the Bobby Frankel trainee raced between Pocus Hocus and Class Above (Quiet American) rounding the turn, moved aggressively when switched to the outside and left them all in her wake as she turned on the afterburners entering the lane. "Everyone is worried about the Breeders' Cup," said Frankel. "If I run her in the [Oct. 9, GI] Beldame S. [at Belmont], she will be a short price in there. Why give away \$750,000? LAST IS BEST AT KEENELAND A colt by Thunder Gulch, the final horse to go under the hammer, attracted a bid of \$320,000 from the Whitehorse Stables of Robert LaPenta to top yesterday's sixth session of the Keeneland September Yearling Sales in Lexington. Consigned by Lane's End, agent, the dark bay is the second foal from Cyber Cat, a Storm Cat daughter of MGISP Future Pretense. The waiting was the hardest part, according to his consignor. "I was worried about him being the last horse in the sale," admitted Lane's End owner William Farish, "but obviously everybody stayed around. He was a lovely horse." Whitehorse Stables was easily the most active buyer, signing tickets on nine horses for gross receipts of over \$1.2 million. A colt from the first crop of Airdrie Stud's Forest Camp (Deputy Minister) attracted the second highest bid during yesterday's proceedings. Consigned to the sale by the Four Star Sales agency, the bay colt was purchased for \$310,000 by Mike Akers on behalf of his Dapple Bloodstock. Akers has been busy so far at the sale, signing tickets on seven horses for gross receipts of just over \$1.3 million, including a \$360,000 filly by Golden Missile on Saturday. So, what drew his attention to this offering? "He's by a first-crop sire, he's a big sturdy horse and he's the best Forest Camp I've seen at all the sales this year," Akers commented. "I knew he was going to be a little pricey. Those kind are always going to be popular in this marketplace." Seven-year-old Forest Camp, winner of the 1999 GII Del Mar Futurity, has proved attractive to buyers this sales season. He is the sire of several six-figure yearlings--off an advertised 2002 stud fee of \$10,000--and was represented by a \$450,000 son of Cope's Light (Copelan) at the Fasig-Tipton July sale. Vinery had a successful day consigning a pair of horses by their More Than Ready (Southern Halo). Hip 1878, a son of Reina Victoriosa (Arg) (Interprete {Arg}), got the ball rolling when he sold to William Heiligbrodt for \$300,000. The dark bay colt received a boost recently when his full brother Ready Ruler won the El Joven S. at Retama Park. "He's just a very nice individual," Heiligbrodt said of his purchase. "He looks like a very good racehorse. He's already got the family there." Late in the day, Buzz Chace, bidding on behalf of Barry K. Schwartz, went to \$250,000 to acquire a More Than Ready daughter of Ceridwen (Lord Avie) from the family of dual Classic winner and horse of the year Point Given. Toppers and Stats, p9

He is represented in the massive Keeneland September catalogue by just three horses, but Put It Back (Honour and Glory) made an excellent first impression during Saturday's session. The six-year-old stallion, who stands at Arthur Appleton's Bridlewood Farm in Ocala, Florida, is the sire of hip 1446, a dark bay colt which is off to Japan after being purchased by the Durham Company Ltd. for \$230,000. A son of the nine-year-old mare Pleasant Dixie (Dixieland Band), the Florida-bred is well-related. "He was a real good moving colt and he's a half brother to one of the top horses in America," said Denali Stud's Craig Bandoroff, referring to Southern Image (Halo's Image), a dual Grade I winner and of one of the leaders of this year's handicap division. Put It Back entered stud following a perfect three-year-old campaign, which included victories in the Best Turn S. at Aqueduct and the GII Riva Ridge Breeders' Cup S. at Belmont Park. September 20, 1965...Future Hall of Fame jockey **Jorge Velasquez** made his American riding debut at Atlantic City Racecourse. He won with his first mount, 8-1 Keypoint, in the sixth race.

September 20, 1976...Two-year-old **Seattle Slew** made his racing debut, winning a six furlong maiden race by five lengths at Belmont Park.

September 20, 1980...Four-year-old **Spectacular Bid** won the Woodward S. at Belmont Park in a walkover. It was the first walkover in a major U.S. stakes since Coaltown took the '49 Edward Burke H.

September 21, 1938...A hurricane disrupted racing at Rockingham Park, which canceled its card after the sixth race. Thirteen barns were destroyed by the storm.

September 21, 1940...For the first time since the inception of the photo-finish camera, a triple dead-heat for the win was recorded at Willow's Park in British Columbia.

September 25, 1866...Jerome Park, named for its founder, Leonard W. Jerome, opened in the Bronx, New York.
