Adoration (Honor Grades), last year's upset winner of the GI Breeders' Cup Distaff at odds of 41-1, will be retired after injuring her right front ankle. The five-year-

old mare worked six furlongs in 1:13 1/5 at Hollywood Park Wednesday in preparation for this year's Breeders' Cup Distaff at Lone Star Park Oct. 30 and the injury was discovered shortly thereafter. "She was the world's healthiest horse," co-owner John Amerman told Blood-Horse. "As honest as the day is long and

she's been so good to us." Racing six more times after her victory in the Distaff, the \$40,000 Keeneland September yearling purchase added wins in the GI Santa Margarita Invitational H. at Santa Anita Mar. 14, the GII Fleur de Lis H. at Churchill June 12 and the GIII Arlington Matron H. last out Sept. 4. She retires with eight wins, from 20 starts and \$2,051,159 in earnings. Breeding plans have not yet been arranged.

QEII TO HQ

Newmarket racecourse has been unveiled as the host for next year's G1 Queen Elizabeth II S. as Ascot concluded its sharing out of the feature meetings during its redevelopment scheme. The Festival of British Racing, which gets underway on the round course at Ascot today, will take place at the Suffolk venue Sept. 24-25, when the main event will be joined by the G1 Fillies' Mile, G2 Royal Lodge S. and the G2 Diadem S., with Lingfield hosting the Friday card. Ascot's Chief Executive Douglas Erskine-Crum said yesterday, "All of our major festivals have now been relocated for 2005, and we're delighted that Newmarket is staging the September Festival as it is crucial that this very important fixture gets the high profile it deserves." Newmarket's Managing Director Lisa Hancock was looking forward to an autumn program whose existing pillars are the Cambridgeshire meeting and Champions' Day in October. "In a 22-day period we'll be staging no less than 18 group races, including seven Group 1's, as well as nine listed races and several cracking handicaps," she said.

CLEVER TRICK FILLY TOPS KEE THURSDAY

Hip 3508, a daughter of Clever Trick, brought a top price of \$230,000 during Thursday's session of Keeneland's September yearling sale. Kenneth McPeek bought the dark bay or brown filly from the consignment of Rick Littrell's Viking Stud. With four days remaining in the 14-day auction, 2,546 horses have been sold for a sale record of \$312,462,500, an average of \$122,727 and a median of \$55,000. FROM THE DESK OF ...

RECORD SALE

The Keeneland September Sale continues to run almost exactly 15 percent ahead of last year's figures in gross and average. On Day 8, it broke the previous September Sale record of \$291.8-million, and on Day 9, the auction sailed through the \$300-million mark--only the third time ever that milestone has been reached. The previous two were the all-time record horse sale. Keeneland November, 1999, which grossed \$317,666,000, and the November, 2000 sale, which grossed \$302-million. With Wednesday's session finishing up at \$305,647,100, it looks pretty safe to say, by close of business next Monday, Keeneland September 2004 will go into the books as the all-time biggest-grossing horse sale in history. That's a pretty fair accomplishment, and a big vote of confidence in the market by yearling buyers. It makes it about 2-to-5 that this year's major yearling and mixed sales, finishing at Newmarket in December, will break the \$1-billion mark for only the second time.

Not surprisingly, there have been no major developments on the sire front this week, just the numbers offered and sold keep rising, and the averages keep falling. The year's top five sires on average (with 8 + sold) are all finished at Keeneland, I believe, and none of them have had more than 23 sell to date: Storm Cat (16), A.P. Indy (16), Danzig (8), Kingmambo (23) and Seeking the Gold (14). The next four sires on average--Unbridled's Song, freshman sires Giant's Causeway and Fusaichi Pegasus, and second-crop sire Forestry (that's two from Ashford, and two from Taylor Made)--have had 188 yearlings sell among them, for a total of \$66,441,000, and an average of \$353,410, for an average of 47 yearlings sold each. Those four young sires together could have just about had their own Saratoga sale.

Grand Slam (16th on average) had 69 sell from 94 offered. That's a personal gross of \$14,077,000, for an average of \$204,014. Monarchos still clings to first-year sire honors, with 19 sold, averaging \$176,000; Point Given has 31 sold, averaging \$164,097 and Tiznow has 37 sold, averaging \$152,757. Brahms, with a \$117,606 average, in fourth spot among first-year sires, is without doubt the biggest surprise among the sires with their first yearlings. They have sold sensationally.

On To Europe...

There have already been three major yearling sales in Europe. First, Deauville in August. Then the popular Doncaster St. Leger sale, which usually conflicts with the first week at Keeneland, but was the week before this year. That sale was up over 30 percent, to new records in gross and average (over \$40,000). This week's the Fairyhouse sale, which traditionally has the lowest average of the six major European sales.

Next week we kick off what may prove to be the permanently new, revamped formula--or not. Goffs goes first, selling from Monday night through Friday. Leading into Arc weekend, it is in the slot which had previously been the Houghton Sale at Newmarket. But that's been absorbed into Tattersalls' new, improved (they hope) sales formula: October 1, the week after the Arc; October 2 the week after that. It's not the route we've been used to taking after the Arc, but no doubt most of us will eventually find our way to where we're supposed to be. It sounds simple enough: Goffs, Arc, Newmarket, Newmarket.

Starting next Monday--just as Keeneland's new record gross for a single sale is being calculated--more than 3,100 yearlings are catalogued for Goffs and Newmarket over the next three weeks. Last year, Goffs' old sale grossed €37-million, and Tattersalls' October Sale (Parts 1 & 2) grossed 47-million guineas. We'll figure out what to call all that in which currency as we go along, but you may bet confidently that all grosses will be up. They have to be, because so many more horses are selling. There are 154 sires with oldest foals three-year-olds and up in 2004, and who were assigned mid-year 2004 APEX ratings, represented in the three catalogues. The accompanying Table (see p.5-9) lists some relevant numbers for each, including (since 1/1/1998): number of year-starters ('runners') in Europe, number of A Runners, A Runner Index; overall number of year-starters (including also North America and Japan), with overall number of A Runners, A Runner Index; overall B Runner, C Runner, combined ABC Runner indexes; and age ratings, based on each sire's ABC Runners. Remember that younger sires have a tendency to 'come back to the pack' as they have more runners.

Among the many sires with first yearlings and two-year-olds who do not have APEX ratings, it's worth pointing out that both Coolmore's Galileo and Dalham's Fantastic Light, with very limited representation, both averaged quite a bit higher than the top American first-year sires. So we should expect some big numbers from them--and also from Coolmore Danehill son Mozart, who died tragically of colitis at age four. Danehill just could be a good bet as a sire of sires, so it maybe won't do to just go dismissing Mozart because he'll only have the one crop. Bold Reasoning sired Seattle Slew and Super Concorde from 60 foals, way back when; Dubai Millennium may have the best two-year-old in Europe, Dubawi, from his only crop of fewer than 60 foals.

NORTH EAST BOUND RETIRED Veteran runner North East Bound (D'Accord--North East Dancer, by Far North), a gritty second behind War Chant in the 2000 GI Breeders' Cup Mile, has been retired from racing. The eight-year-old gelding has been sent to Sunny Oak Farm in Kentucky to enjoy a well-deserved retirement. North East Bound hit the board in 22 of 50 starts with 12 victories and earnings of \$1,363,228. He won the GII Meadowlands Cup H., GIII Kent Breeders' Cup S., GII Maker's Mark Mile S., GIII Cliff Hanger H., GIII Canadian Turf H. and GIII Oceanport H. "When horses tried to wear him down, he just kept going," said trainer Bill Perry. "They could get to him, but not by him. The only way to beat him was to be moving fast on the outside near the wire." Sent off a 42-1 longshot in the Breeders' Cup, North East Bound led every stride but the last one. "That was his best race, even though he lost," Perry said. "He started from post 14 against the best milers in the world and he led all the way. He never saw the winner coming, so he never had a chance to react. I was really proud of him that day." The gelding pulled a suspensory while running sixth in the Sept. 5 Bob Harding S. in his final outing. "With a younger horse, you would just give the injury time to heal and bring him back. But North East Bound is eight, and there's no time for him to come back. He was just a nice horse to be around, never any trouble, and all professional racehorse. Those kind are very hard to replace," Perry said.


