FANTASTIC RETURN FOR BARNETT

Trainer Bobby Barnett, a one-time fixture on the Louisiana racing scene, had started just two horses at the current meet at Louisiana Downs. But yesterday, the 55-year-old veteran made a triumphant return to Bossier City, saddling R Bar S Thoroughbreds' Fantasticat (Storm Cat) to a 14-1 upset victory over Borrego (El Prado {Ire}) in the 25th running of the GII Super Derby. The bay colt began his career in Ireland, carrying the colors of Michael Tabor in his first two career starts before being sold to race in this country. In his final European appearance, Fantasticat was third at odds-on in a Tipperary maiden last July 10. The horse that finished second that afternoon was Castledale (Ire), who would adapt to the American brand of racing with wins in the GIII Generous S. on the turf and the GI Santa Anita Derby on the main track. The learning curve for Fantasticat has been a little bit slower. Cont. p3

A TOUGH ACT TO FOLLOW

The Sangster Family's **Playful Act (GB)** (Sadler's Wells) provided her sire with yet another Group 1 winner, leading from flagfall to finish to take yesterday's Meon Valley Stud Fillies' Mile S. at Ascot. Following her impressive victory in the G2 May Hill S. Sept. 9, trainer John Gosden suggested that the filly's main goal for 2005 would be the G1 Epsom Oaks, without the benefit of a Guineas prep. Following yesterday's performance, it seems the conditioner has had a change of heart. "I'll take her straight to the G1 1000 Guineas [at Newmarket in May], as she's a Group 1 winner, so there's no point carrying penalties in a prep," Gosden said. "If she runs a nice race and all goes well, she'll then go straight to the G1 Epsom Oaks." Cont. p2

NOTHING SHORT OF PERFECT

From the day of his birth, there have always been lofty expectations for **Perfectperformance** (Rahy). A half brother to the outstanding racemare Russian Rhythm, he was knocked down as a yearling for \$1.1 million to Team Godolphin. A Listed winner in his most recent outing, the Pennsylvania-bred took another step towards stardom with a facile victory in the G2 Royal Lodge S. at Ascot. **Cont. p3**

FOR THE QUEEN Since being transferred from his base in Italy after taking the 2002 G1 Derby Italiano, Rakti (GB) (Polish Precedent) had harnessed his natural exuberance to win the 2003 G1 Champion S. at Newmarket and the G1 Prince of Wales's S. at Royal Ascot on his return this year. However, that excess energy looked to be getting the better of him when he finished a disappointing eighth in the G1 Eclipse S. at Sandown July 3 and fifth in the G1 Irish Champion S. at Leopardstown last time Sept. 11. Here, jockey Philip Robinson was able to let the habitual hard puller roll at strong pace while stalking Godolphin's rabbit Blatant (GB) (Machiavellian). Striking at the top of the straight, the 9-2 chance was able to employ his inherent stamina on the stiff climb to hold Lucky Story (Kris S.), just missing the track record in the process. His rider was not surprised by the five-year-old's speed. "The first time I sat on him I was astounded to hear he had won over a mile and a half, and I said to Michael [trainer Jarvis] that he seemed like a top-class miler. Mile pace helps him to relax and he was just doing what was necessary in front." Jarvis was rewarded for his patient handling. "He's a horse that gives us problems, as he gets so wound up when he gets to the track," he explained. "He's like an elastic band that's going to snap, but today he was very good." The winner will be pointed for the GI Breeders' Cup Mile at Lone Star Park Oct. 30. "I know nothing about Dallas or the track out there, but, though he is a big horse, he is very athletic and I don't think the bends will be a problem," Jarvis added. Rakti is likely to close out the year in the G1 Hong Kong Cup Dec. 12, a race in which he was second to Falbrav in 2003. The second- and third-place finishers will have a rematch in the G1 Champion S. at Newmarket Oct. 16.

She kicked on the turn into the straight, stole first run on Maids Causeway and was always holding that game rival in the drive to the line. "In the May Hill they went very fast and it was a true test, so we wanted to bounce out and use her stride today," explained winning trainer John Gosden. "There is plenty of stamina on the dam's side, and she really appreciates a test, so we didn't want it turning into a four-furlong sprint." Trainer Barry Hills said that the runner-up has been purchased by American Martin Schwartz and may be aimed at the G2 Rockfel S. at Newmarket Oct. 16. Fantasticat broke his maiden in career start number seven, taking a Fair Grounds event by a length Feb. 28, then went winless for another three months before registering a 1 1/2-length allowance victory at Churchill Downs June 6. Fourth in a second-level allowance in Louisville July 2, he wheeled back on 15 days' rest and shed the blinkers to be a good second to Cryptograph (Cryptoclearance) in the July 17 Round Table S. at Arlington. A non-threatening fifth in the GIII West Virginia Derby Aug. 7, he was coming into this off a neck defeat at the hands of South Africa (Cape Town) in the Aug. 28 Prelude S. at this track. Settled well off the early pace, Fantasticat put in an eye-catching move on the far turn, came out for the drive and outbattled Borrego to the wire. Favored Imperialism (Langfuhr), making his first start since finishing fifth in the GI Preakness S. May 15, was last after a half and offered a mild late bid to be fourth.

The chestnut was challenged by Scandinavia soon after, but showed determination to repel that threat in the drive to the line. "He has class and speed, but he has always looked as if he needs further," trainer Saeed bin Suroor commented. "We thought he was a nice colt earlier in the season, and one-and-a-guarter miles would be perfect for him already, but he'll run next in the G1 Racing Post Trophy [at Doncaster Oct. 23].
