BREEDERS' CUP DOUBTS FOR RAKTI Michael Jarvis yesterday revealed that Gary Tanaka's Rakti (GB) (Polish Precedent) may sidestep the GI Breeders' Cup Mile at Lone Star Park Oct. 30. Instead, Jarvis could freshen the five-year-old for a winter campaign in the Far East. Describing Saturday's G1 Queen Elizabeth II S. winner as "very happy and absolutely 100 percent" after his half-length victory in the Ascot contest, the Newmarket conditioner ruled out the G1 Champion S. at Newmarket Oct. 16 before voicing doubts about a tilt at the Mile in Texas. After talking it over with Tanaka, Jarvis told PA Sport, "I would have some concerns about the track in America. Obviously I haven't been there, but with a maximum of 14 it sounds to me as though it is very sharp like Chester and we all know what happens to outside horses there, so we are in a bit of a quandary where we go next. I think the Champion comes a bit quick and I would be worried about the track at the other one. So it's a possibility he might go to Japan [for the G1 Mile Championship at Kyoto Nov. 21] or we might even wait for the G1 Hong Kong Cup [at Sha Tin Dec. 16]."

No horse had ever won the Deutschlandpreis, Pokal and Preis von Europa, three of the Group 1 jewels in Germany's middle-distance championship crown, in the same season, but yesterday Albanova made history when completing the treble with a stirring defeat of Saldentigerin. Settled off the pace set by that runaway leader throughout the early stages, she showed the tenacity that has contributed to her historical feat when reeling in that rival in the final strides under a powerpacked Seb Sanders drive. She also becomes the first distaffer to take this event. There is something about Germany that ignites the fire in Albanova, who got to within 1 1/4 lengths of Mamool (Ire) in this race 12 months ago. She returned to this country after nine months off the track to down Dayano (Ger) in the G1 Deutschlandpreis at Dusseldorf July 25, recording her first success at the highest level, and beat yesterday's G3 Cumberland Lodge S. winner High Accolade (GB) comfortably in the G1 Pokal over course and distance last time Aug. 15. She duly established her dominion by makingit three in a row here. Connections are eyeing a tilt at the G1 Premio Roma Nov. 7 before an honorable retirement alongside her dual Champion S. winning sister Alborada (GB) at the end of the year. 

Last year's winner High Accolade was tried over staying trips after finding Albanova (GB) too strong in the G1 Pokal at Cologne Aug. 15. He was far from disgraced when fourth in the G2 Doncaster Cup, where the two-and-a-quarter mile trip may have been a bridge too far at this stage of his career, but, back at his beloved Ascot, he showed determination to record backto-back successes in this event. "He's a very tough performer and loves Ascot," commented winning trainer Marcus Tregoning. "Kieren's horse may just have been hanging, which made it harder for him, but he loves a scrap. It has been difficult for him taking on the older horses this year, but I thought he looked terrific in the paddock before the race today and he does love this place."

As for the roan's future plans, Polanco added, "Hopefully, from there, it will be the GI Breeders' Cup Distaff [at Lone Star Park Oct. 30]." Also possible for the Lady's Secret is MGISW Musical Chimes (In Excess {Ire}), although the Neil Drysdale trainee would have to be supplemented, at a cost of \$5,000, for the 1 1/16mile event. "We're thinking about it," said Drysdale. "The plan is for Kent [Desormeaux] to ride her." With Desormeaux slated to ride Musical Chimes, the mount on Island Fashion, who the rider partnered for a pair of wins in last year's GI La Brea S. and GI Santa Monica H., will be up for grabs.

#### Jockey Dean Kuntz Dead at 48:

Veteran jockey Dean Kutz, who rode more than 2,800 winners during a racing career spanning four decades, died Sunday morning at Lexington's Saint Joseph Hospital after a lengthy battle with throat cancer. He was 48. The Carrington, North Dakota native began riding in 1972 and competed for over 20 years along the Midwest circuit before he was temporarily forced to the sidelines to receive a kidney transplant. In 2000, Kutz lost his larynx after he was diagnosed with throat cancer, but in a great show of courage, returned to the saddle for a brief stint in August 2001. Kutz, who was inducted into the North Dakota Sports Hall of Fame, also received the 2001 George Woolf and 2002 Mike Venezia Awards. A winner of 2,835 races and \$33,691,225 in purses, Kutz's biggest victories came in the 1997 GII Arlington-Washington Futurity and the Cradle S. with Cowboy Dan.
