ONE COOL CAT RETIRED Susan Magnier's One

Cool Cat (Storm Cat--Tacha, by Mr. Prospector) sustained a serious injury on the Ballydoyle gallops yesterday and will be retired. The dual Group 1 winner was preparing for a tilt at Sunday's G1 Prix de l'Abbaye at Longchamp when he suffered a condylar fracture to his near-hind leg and was taken to Troytown hospital. One Cool Cat, who topped the 2002 Keeneland July sale at \$3.1 million, won the G1 Phoenix S. and the G1 National S. at The Curragh as a two-year-old, but disappointed when soundly beaten as the 15-8 favorite in the G1 2000 Guineas at Newmarket May 1. He was discovered to have an irregular heartbeat after that race and, following another sub-par outing, took the G3 Phoenix Sprint S. at The Curragh Aug. 8. He built on that effort to finish third in the G1 Nunthorpe S. at York Aug. 19, but could do no better than sixth in the G1 Haydock Sprint Cup in what would become his final start Sept. 4. "It is highly unfortunate that One Cool Cat's racing career has come to an end, as I always hoped that one day he would display on the racecourse the brilliance he has always shown us at home," trainer Aidan O'Brien said. Jockey Jamie Spencer added, "It is very disappointing news. He is a high-class horse and we probably hadn't seen the best of him yet." Raced by Michael Tabor and Susan Magnier, One Cool Cat retires with a record of 10-5-0-1 and earnings of \$564,798.
