The colt was successful in the five-furlong Listed Windsor Castle S. at Royal Ascot June 15 and G2 Flying Childers S. at Doncaster Sept. 11 on either side of a disappointing lastplace effort in the G2 July S. and his trainer Nick Littmoden believes the best is yet to come. "We are very pleased with him," he told PA Sport. "He impressed at Doncaster and has been in

really good form since. His Newmarket run was too bad to be true, but he obviously redeemed his reputation at Doncaster last time." Chateau Istana faces a competitive line-up, including Satchem (GB) (Inchinor {GB}), who beat the subsequent July S. scorer Captain Hurricane (GB) in a conditions event at Yarmouth before following up in a nursery at this track July 8. Switched from the David Loder yard soon after, he reappeared after a break to beat Council Member by 1 1/2 lengths in the G3 Sirenia S. at Kempton last time Sept. 4. "He's done nothing but improved and I was lucky enough to get hold of him," trainer Clive Brittain commented. "I'd only worked him half speed and was convinced he was Group 1 then. He's a horse that loves to be full of himself and bubbling, so I haven't wanted to take the edge off him since Kempton." Satchem's form links him to Iceman (GB) (Polar Falcon), who had beaten Council Member by a half length in the G2 Coventry S. at Royal Ascot June 15. Iceman returned from a break to fail by a half length to give five pounds to Etlaala (GB) in the G2 Champagne S. at Doncaster last time Sept. 10. He represents the John Gosden stable successful two years ago with Oasis Dream (GB). "He is in great form and the only worry is dropping back a furlong, but he will love the fast ground," commented Cheveley Park Stud's spokesman John Marsh. cont. p.3

Derby Winners Added to Arc...

Sunday's G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe received a boost when the G1 Irish Derby and winner **Grey Swallow (Ire)** (Daylami {Ire}) and G1 Prix du Jockey-Club (French Derby) hero **Blue Canari (Fr)** (Acatenango {Ger}) were supplemented to the contest at a cost of €60,000 each. There were doubts surrounding Grey Swallow's participation after connections revealed that his run when fourth in the G1 Irish Champion S. at Leopardstown Sept. 12 had taken a lot out of him, but he will line up after what Dermot Weld termed a "satisfactory" mid-week workout.

Arc Field Takes Shape...

Sheikh Hamdan bin Rashid al Maktoum's Mubtaker (Silver Hawk), who finished runner-up in the Arc 12 months ago, was yesterday scratched by trainer Marcus Tregoning following long deliberations over his uncharacteristically poor effort when seventh in the G1 Grosser Preis von Baden last time Sept. 5. "We feel that he may not have returned to his best form after a lacklustre run in Germany," he explained, before adding that the veteran will remain in training as an eight-yearold. With connections of G1 Yorkshire Oaks winner Quiff (GB) (Sadler's Wells) deciding not to supplement her and Lord du Sud (Fr) (Linamix {Fr}) withdrawn, a total of 21 remained in the feature event yesterday. Those include Lord Derby's dual Oaks winner Ouija Board (GB) (Cape Cross {Ire}) after conditioner Ed Dunlop decided she should take her chance. "We might have only one chance in a lifetime to win this famous race," he told the Racing Post. "We realise how difficult it is going to be for a three-year-old filly, but she is in great shape." With a safety limit of 20, Mister Farmer (Fr) (Trempolino) will be balloted out with the lowest rating, meaning that Michael Tabor's Listed Kilternan S. winner Acropolis (Ire) (Sadler's Wells) makes the cut.

Magical Romance was pitched into the G3 Princess Margaret S. at Ascot July 24 after a promising Kempton maiden score 10 days previously. But, she disappointed on the fast surface when only sixth there and was given time to recoup before her confidence-boosting nursery success last time. "She's a lovely filly who has always shown plenty at home," commented conditioner Brian Meehan, who was saddling his first Group 1 winner in Britain. "I thought she'd be in the first three, but I was in two minds to run as she didn't like the firm ground at Ascot. The rain came and she is suited by slow ground, so the idea was to be positive." He added, "I would think that's the end for this year as she's done enough for one year. The G1 1000 Guineas is definitely the plan." David Wachman was far from downhearted by the run of the 10-11 pick **Damson (Ire)** (Entrepreneur {GB}), who held every chance before staying on up the rising ground to finish a close third. "She hasn't picked up as she has in the past, but we were beaten fair and square," he said.

THIS WEEK IN RACING HISTORY...

October 2, 1943...Belmont Park hosted "Back the Attack" Day in support of the war effort. Admission was by purchase of \$25 or \$100 war bonds. The track raised approximately \$25 million.

October 2, 1981...At age 17, **Behavin Jerry** set the record for most career starts by a Thoroughbred, making his 307th appearance. Making his first start as a two-year-old in 1966, he raced every year through 1978, took a two-year break, then returned to race at age 17.

October 3, 1942...With his victory in the Jockey Club Gold Cup, **Whirlaway**, became the first Thoroughbred to earn more than \$500,000.
