The Weinstock Family's G1 Epsom Derby winner North Light (Ire) (Danehill) will break from stall 12 as he returns after a lengthy absence following his half-length defeat by Grey Swallow (Ire) (Daylami {Ire}) in the Irish equivalent at The Curragh June 27. Jockey Kieren Fallon expressed himself pleased with the condition of the Classic hero and the berth yesterday. "It's been a long gap since his last run but Sir Michael [Stoute] has proved over the years he can do it with horses with much more time between races and I'm sure he'll have him spot on for the Arc," he told PA Sport. 

Commercante, a Group 3 winner in France, introduced herself to U.S. racing with an 11 1/4-length allowance victory over a yielding Belmont turf course May 29, but reportedly suffered a severe cut in a stall injury and missed some time thereafter. The four-yearold may have found the ground too fast in the Aug. 14 GI Beverly D. at Arlington, where she could do no better than ninth as the 3-1 second choice, but underfoot conditions could be more in her favor this afternoon. The same can be said for Wonder Again, the 123-pound highweight in the field. After a four-year-old campaign which saw the homebred win just one of six starts, the bay is two-for-three this year, including a 5 3/4-length defeat of Beverly D. runner-up Riskaverse in the GI Diana H. on a yielding Saratoga turf course July 31. "I think it's tough to go from three to four," trainer Jimmy Toner said of Wonder Again's performance last term. "You hope they maintain some form and consistency and by the time they get to be five, they've been able to weather the storm." Aubonne came from off the pace to defeat a group of males in the G3 La Coupe in June, but found herself on the lead in the Beverly D. and weakened late to be sixth in that blanket finish. Taking the call today is Jose Santos, whose riding style should be a good fit for the Germanbred filly.

Despite the small field, this select line-up has justified the decision by the Pattern Committee to make it one of its central upgrades this year. She flopped on Deauville's testing ground when last in the G1 Prix Jacques le Marois Aug. 15, but bounced back when going down by a half length to Soviet Song in the G1 Matron S. at Leopardstown last time Sept. 11. Jockey Kevin Darley is concerned about the recent rain. "She's got to have quick ground and it may be a little bit soft for her," he said. "We tried to convince ourselves that she might handle cut at Deauville, but she ran abysmally. I've said to people that nothing can beat her over seven furlongs this year and she'll be that bit better next year." Sir Michael Stoute relies on Chic, who delivered on her early promise when winning the G3 Hungerford S. at Newbury Aug. 14 and G2 Celebration Mile at Goodwood last time Aug. 28. Last year's G1 Prix de Diane and G1 Prix du Moulin heroine Nebraska Tornado, third in the G1 Prix d'Astarte at Deauville last time Aug. 1, will be bidding to book her ticket to Texas for the GI Breeders' Cup Filly & Mare Turf.



THIS WEEK IN HISTORY...

October 2, 1943...Belmont Park hosted "Back the Attack" Day in support of the war effort. Admission was by purchase of \$25 or \$100 war bonds. The track raised approximately \$25 million.

October 2, 1981...At age 17, Behavin Jerry set the record for most career starts by a Thoroughbred, making his 307th appearance. Making his first start as a two-year-old in 1966, he raced every year through 1978, took a two-year break, then returned to race at age 17.

October 3, 1942... With his victory in the Jockey Club Gold Cup, **Whirlaway**, became the first Thoroughbred to earn more than \$500,000.

Oct. 4, 1970...Nijinsky II's 11-race winning streak came to an end when he finished second to Sassafras (Fr) in the Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe at Longchamp.

Oct. 4, 1980...Less than an hour before post time, Spectacular Bid was scratched from the Jockey Club Gold Cup, which was to be the final race of his career. The colt was retired after going nine-for-nine on the season; he was named 1980's Horse of the Year.

Oct. 4, 1989...Secretariat was euthanized at Claiborne Farm in Paris, Kentucky due to complications from laminitis. He was 19.
