LIGHT AT THE END OF THE TUNNEL?

Arnold Weinstock's dream of winning the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe was not realized in his lifetime, but there is still the chance that his colours will be carried to victory in the venerable event. Bidding to become the fourth G1 Epsom Derby winner since 1971 to follow up at Longchamp in the same season, **North Light (Ire)** (Danehill) will flaunt the pale blue of Weinstock's Ballymacoll Stud when he goes to the post for the 83rd running of the Arc this afternoon. Ballymacoll went painfully close with Sun Princess (GB) in 1983 and watched Pilsudski (Ire) fall short behind a pair of brilliant Arc winners in 1996 and 1997, but North Light could change the luck of his storied stable. Ballymacoll Manager Peter Reynolds is aware of the importance of the moment. "You always set yourself targets and [the Arc] was a target set by the late Lord Weinstock for many, many years," he told *PA Sport*. "He wasn't a greedy man and he said to win one Derby would be fine--he just wanted to win one Arc as well." North Light looked to have the world at his feet when beating subsequent G1 St Leger winner Rule of Law at Epsom June 5, but came back with muscle problems after going down by a half length to **Grey Swallow (Ire)** (Daylami {Ire}) in the Irish equivalent at The Curragh June 27. **Cont. p4-5**

GOOD HUMOR

The popular champion **Funny Cide** (Distorted Humor) had come up short in several photo finishes this year, but he rebounded with a determined victory in the \$1-million G1 Jockey Club Gold Cup at Belmont. "He's always been a game horse, and he showed it here today," said winning trainer Barclay Tagg. The Kentucky Derby hero, second by a head in the GII MassCap June 19 and third by a neck in the G1 Suburban H. July 3, had been second in the GII Saratoga Breeders' Cup H. Aug. 22 in his most recent outing. After alternating with favored **Love of Money** (Not for Love) in the early stages, the chestnut looked to be dropping back on the turn, but surged back between **Newfoundland** (Storm Cat) and **The Cliff's Edge** (Gulch) to win. **Cont. p2**

STILL LAUGHING Funny Cide (Distorted Humor)'s bid for the Triple Crown last year ended on a similarly gloomy day, when the chestnut settled for third in the GI Belmont S. last June. Third in the GI Haskell Invitational H., he didn't race again until the GI Breeders' Cup Classic at Santa Anita, which proved a disappointing denouement to his sophomore campaign. He nearly blew the first turn that day and wound up ninth in the 10-horse field. After kicking off 2004 with an allowance win at Gulfstream Jan. 10, he filled the show spot in both the GI Donn H. Feb. 7 and the GII New Orleans H. Feb. 29 before taking the GIII Excelsior Breeders' Cup H. Apr. 3. He could only manage fifth in the GI Met Mile May 31, but performed with credit when a close second in the GII MassCap June 19 and an excellent third in the GI Suburban H. July 3. He ran second to **Evening Attire** (Black Tie Affair {Ire}) in the GII Saratoga Breeders' Cup H. Aug. 22 at the Spa, and trainer Barclay Tagg opted for this spot over the GII Hawthorne Gold Cup the same afternoon.

Where's the Love...

The speedy three-year-old **Love of Money** (Not for Love) went postward as the slight choice over Funny Cide, and the two favorites exchanged the lead several times down the long line of Belmont's backstretch. As they rounded the turn, things didn't look great for Funny Cide, who began to back up a bit. But he became resurgent when passed by **The Cliff's Edge** (Gulch) to his outside, and got back in the thick of things in the stretch. The Derby winner pinned his ears and outbattled **Newfoundland** (Storm Cat) for his third Grade I victory. "I thought he was done," admitted Tagg when asked about his horse on the turn. "Maybe he just wanted to take a breather, I don't know. But he came back running, and he always does that." As for the favorite, trainer Richard Dutrow Jr. didn't have any answers. "Right now, I am very disappointed," he said. "I don't know what to think. You know, I really expected him to win today."

Heading to the Breeders' Cup? It looks as though Funny Cide will be making his next start in the Lone Star State. "I said, 'if he wins [the Gold Cup], we'll have to go,'" said trainer Barclay Tagg. Jack Knowlton, managing director of Sackatoga Stables, concurred. "This year, the goal was to win \$1 million and get back to the Breeders' Cup Classic," he said. "As long as he comes out of the race well, we're on to Texas and that's all we could ask for. Maybe he'll be fifth or sixth favorite in the Breeders' Cup, but anyone who takes him too lightly is making a mistake." Runner-up Newfoundland could also make the journey. "I'll talk to the owners," said trainer Todd Pletcher. "Based on this race and the Suburban [both at 10 furlongs], you could make a case and take a shot."

CAT ON A HOT STREAK

Kitten's Joy (El Prado {Ire}), so impressive in winning the GI Joe Hirsch Turf Classic, will form part of a powerful one-two punch at the Breeders' Cup for owners Ken and Sarah Ramsey and trainer Dale Romans. Kitten's Joy will be among the favorites in the GI Breeders' Cup Turf, and stablemate **Roses in May** (Devil His Due), unbeaten in five starts this year, will tackle the GI Breeders' Cup Classic.

"We're going to train right into Lone Star," said Romans. "We're looking to go out there two weeks ahead of time with both horses. I want them to get familiar with the surroundings and work over the track once." Romans doesn't hide his regard for Kitten's Joy. "I think you can make a strong case for this horse to be three-year-old champion," he said. "He's beaten older horses, while Smarty Jones didn't. And Birdstone hasn't, unless he wins the Breeders' Cup Classic."

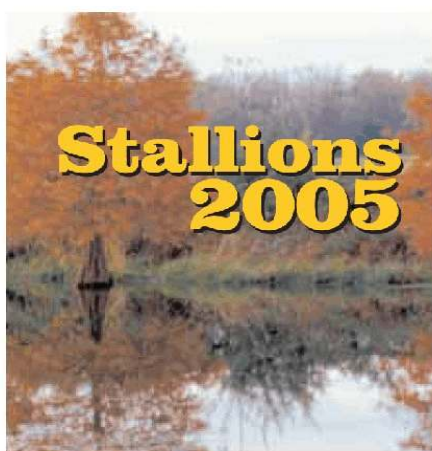

He'd never gone 12 furlongs or faced his elders, but Kitten's Joy answered both of those questions emphatically with this effort. The Ramsey homebred had captured seven of his previous starts on the turf, with his only loss coming by a head to Prince Arch in the GIII Jefferson Cup June 12. He gained his revenge on that colt in winning the GIII Virginia Derby July 10--with Artie Schiller second--and displayed sharp acceleration in taking the GI Secretariat S. Aug. 14 at Arlington. Content to race in fourth down the backstretch, Kitten's Joy crept up on the outside on the turn and pounced on favored Magistretti as they straightened into the stretch. The duo raced in tandem until the eighth pole, when Kitten's Joy spurred clear and opened up, despite switching back to his left lead. "He impresses me more and more every race," said winning trainer Dale Romans. "What amazed me about him is his turn of foot, acceleration and how kind he is during the race." Pico Central ran his record to a perfect three-for-three in Big Apple Grade Is with a dominating victory in the GI Vosburgh S. Shipped to the East Coast off a victory in Santa Anita's GII San Carlos H. Mar. 7, the dark bay beat Strong Hope on the square in the GI Carter H. at Aqueduct Apr. 10 and returned seven weeks later to take the GI Metropolitan H. May 31. Freshened off that effort, he returned to action in the Aug. 15 GII Pat O'Brien Breeders' Cup H. at Del Mar, but wilted to third after setting a torrid pace. Allowed to stalk the pace outside of Speightstown and the returning Cajun Beat (Grand Slam), Pico Central was roused to the front turning for home and proved much the best. "I was concerned about him coming into this race, because he didn't run well at Del Mar," said winning trainer Paolo Lobo. "Today...he was perfect and ran like hell." A 20-percent supplement would be needed for the Breeders' Cup. "We'll decide about that next week," said Lobo, adding, "But he doesn't have to run in the Breeders' Cup to become sprint champion."

The Domestic Defence...

The Niarchos family has come close to Arc victory with Northern Trick, Hernando (Fr) and Sulamani (Ire). In **Bago (Fr)** (Nashwan), they may have a horse that can give them their first win. Rated Europe's top juvenile after his emphatic score in the G1 Criterium International, he overcame a troubled spring to win the G1 Prix Jean Prat and G1 Grand Prix de Paris in June, and ran best of the sophomores when third in the G1 International S. at York Aug. 17, where he shaped as if a mile and a half would suit. The colt confirmed that impression when third behind the Lagardere family's **Valixir (Ire)** (Tremolino) and Wertheimer et Frere's **Prospect Park (GB)** (Sadler's Wells) in the G2 Prix Niel over course and distance Sept. 12. Valixir bids to provide trainer Andre Fabre with a sixth Arc triumph.

The Warr Horse...

Six-year-old **Warrsan (Ire)** (Caerleon) comes from a family that includes past luminaries Luso (GB), Needle Gun (Ire) and Cloud Castle (GB), but he could eclipse them all with a win in the Arc. The veteran has already taken the last two renewals of the G1 Coronation Cup at Epsom and earned a first major international triumph in the G1 Grosser Preis von Baden on his latest start Sept. 5. But it has taken time for his evergreen trainer Clive Brittain, who also conditioned his illustrious relatives, to get the best out of Warrsan. "I knew I had a potential champion who just had to relax and grow up," Brittain explained. "When he came to me, he was so sour he didn't even want to come out of his box. All he needed was time and in the end he would follow me round like a dog. He's much more mature physically this year and has the confidence now he knows that life revolves around him."

Bettors Go for the Grey...

On the eve of the Arc, **Grey Swallow (Ire)** (Daylami {Ire}) has replaced North Light as the market leader, but connections are hoping for just a bit more cut in the ground. The going at Longchamp is currently "good to firm," and that's a concern for Grey Swallow's rider, Par Smullen. "Coming here on Arc day, you are always expecting to have some cut in the ground, but that doesn't seem to be here this year--and I hope some rain arrives," Smullen told the BBC. "Grey Swallow handled the ground well at The Curragh, but his preference has always been for a bit of cut. It remains to be seen if he will handle quick ground for a second time."

Feminine Wiles...

Fillies have largely struggled since the heady days of Allez France, Ivanjica, Three Troikas (Fr), Detroit (Fr), Gold River (Fr), Akiyda (GB) and All Along (Fr), who captured the Arc between 1974 and 1983, but there is a formidable distaff presence this time. The Wildenstein family, who succeeded with Allez France and All Along, look for a third distaff Arc winner in **Vallee Enchantee (Ire)** (Peintre Celebre). The filly beat the boys in last year's G1 Hong Kong Vase, but has been off the track since finishing fifth in the G1 King George VI & Queen Elizabeth Diamond S. at Ascot July 24. British and Irish-trained fillies simply do not win the Arc, but if ever there was a talent ready to reverse the trend it is Lord Derby's G1 English and Irish Oaks heroine **Ouija Board (GB)** (Cape Cross {Ire}). "We realise that the history books are against us and that it is very difficult for a three-year-old filly, but Ouija Board is giving us all the right signals and is in tip-top shape," Lord Derby told *PA Sport*. "[Trainer Ed Dunlop] has never been as happy with her and we go there full of hope that she can have a big say." She faces the G1 Prix de Diane winner **Latice (Ire)** (Inchiner {GB}), who disappointed with forcing tactics when eighth in the G1 Prix Vermeille over course and distance last time Sept. 1.

"He tends to just run with the others and doesn't want to leave them. He came on again when the other was by him, but he doesn't have really strong acceleration and couldn't make up enough ground."

"Knowing this was her Breeders' Cup prep and not having ridden her before, I was a little concerned that I do everything right," winning rider Eibar Coa said. "But she broke perfectly and put me right in position." Assistant trainer Tristan Barry said they considered the GI Beldame S. at Belmont versus older horses next week-end for their star filly, but preferred this spot. "It was not a tough decision," Barry commented. "This was a nice spot for her and we were hoping she wouldn't have to work too hard for the win. We really wanted that extra week, a good 30 days before heading to Texas."
