The victory provided trainer Pascal Bary with his fifth renewal of the race and the third for the Niarchos Family, following the successes of Six Perfections (Fr) and Denebola in the last two years. *Prix Marcel Boussac cont. p3*

EASY WIN FOR ROMAN RULER

"He proved to me that he's still the best two-year-old in the country," jockey Corey Nakatani said after guiding GII Best Pal S. victor **Roman Ruler** (Fusaichi Pegasus) to an effortless win in yesterday's GII Norfolk S. at Santa Anita. The handsome dark bay colt faced just three rivals in the 1 1/16-mile race and was made the prohibitive 1-20 favorite to make amends for his narrow loss in the GII Del Mar Futurity. Wearing blinkers for the first time, Roman Ruler was rank in the early going, but inhaled pacesetter **Littlebitofzip** (Littlebitlively) turning for home and stormed clear to a 4 1/2-length win.

How the Race was Won...

Breaking well, the 8-1 Bago was reined back to mid-division as the pace was forced by **North Light (Ire)** (Danehill) and **Tap Dance City** (Pleasant Tap) and traveled easily until momentarily stopped on the turn into the home straight. The dark bay picked himself up as Cherry Mix was committed by Christophe Soumillon at the quarter pole and his high-speed pursuit carried him past that game rival in the final 50 yards for Arc glory. Conditioner Jonathan Pease described him as "the best horse I have trained." Racing Manager Alan Cooper added, "We always felt Bago was an exceptional horse, but at York the sticky ground didn't help and again was slightly against him in the Niel. He showed us in the mornings that he had bounced back from that race, which actually helped bring him forward." before **Click for the racingpost.co.uk chart or the [free brisnet.com](http://free.brisnet.com) catalogue-style pedigree.**

Talent Always There...

Bago topped the International Classifications at two when winning the G1 Criterium International by six lengths at Saint-Cloud in November before a virus kept him off the track this spring. His emphatic three-length defeat of Cacique (Ire) on his return in the G1 Prix Jean Prat overshadowed the G1 Prix du Jockey-Club run on the same Chantilly card June 6 and he confirmed those placings in the G1 Grand Prix de Paris at this track three weeks later. He lost his unblemished record, but no caste, in defeat behind Sulamani (Ire) and Norse Dancer (Ire) at York and got going too late behind **Valixir (Ire)** (Tremolino) in the Niel. He has an engagement in Texas to fulfill now. "We always said he would end his three-year-old campaign in the G1 Breeders' Cup Classic [at Lone Star Park Oct. 30] and we have three weeks before he has to be shipped, so we need to see how he is over the next few days," Cooper added.

A # will distinguish first-time stakes-winners, a @ will indicate first-time graded stakes-winners, a ▲ will denote a first-time Grade/Group 1 winner.

The Vanquished..

Andre Fabre took defeat on the chin after watching the Lagardere Family's Cherry Mix worn down in the final strides. "He is a good horse who goes on any ground," he said. "There is absolutely no shame in being beaten by Bago, who was champion two-year-old in Europe and is a real star." Trainer Ed Dunlop was also "thrilled" with the performance of Lord Derby's **Ouija Board (GB)** (Cape Cross {Ire}), who finished with a late flourish to briefly threaten in third. "She has proved again that she is the best of her sex in Europe with a top-class run," he commented. "I think any normal year she would have won as she was too far back, and we'll have a go again next year. In the meantime she might go for the G1 Breeders' Cup Filly and Mares Turf [at Lone Star Park Oct. 30]." Sir Michael Stoute described the ground as "marginally too quick" for the Weinstock Family's **North Light (Ire)** (Danehill), who stayed on at one pace when headed in the straight. "It was a pity the Japanese horse took us on as we were nicely settled in front at one point, but he's come out of it with a lot of credit," he said. "He's finished for the year now, but hopefully he'll stay on as a four-year-old and get another shot at it." Trainer Elie Lellouche was pleased with the run of **Vallee Enchantee (Ire)** (Peintre Celebre), who "had to make up a lot of ground wide from a bad draw." Conditioner Dermot Weld was downcast after the disappointing effort of **Grey Swallow (Ire)** (Daylami {Ire}), whose wide move was short lived. "It was a residual of the hold-up we had with him and he just ran a little bit flat," he explained. "We didn't see the real Grey Swallow today, unfortunately."

Pitch Perfect for Oratorio...

Given a break following his G2 Futurity S. success at The Curragh last time Aug. 21, Oratorio, a 3-1 chance here, was kept under cover against the rail by Jamie Spencer off a furious early gallop set by Early March. As Layman tackled and passed the long-time leader inside the final quarter, a golden rail opened and Oratorio dug deep to wrest the prize from his warring rivals in the final strides and score by a short neck, taking nearly a second off the previous race record time in the process. "He's a real Danehill," commented winning trainer Aidan O'Brien, who had won this race previously with luminaries Giant's Causeway, Rock of Gibraltar (Ire) and Hold That Tiger since 1999. "He's tough, he handles fast ground, he has plenty of speed and he stays well. He was held up after his Group 2 and we were a bit worried about his fitness, but he's a real racer and it's very possible he could run in the G1 Dewhurst S. [at Newmarket Oct. 16]." Oratorio has not looked back since disappointing when seventh in the G2 Coventry S. at Royal Ascot June 15. Returning to the The Curragh to win the G3 Anglesey S. July 18 and finish runner-up in the G1 Phoenix S. Aug. 8, he appreciated the extra panel when winning the Futurity convincingly last time. Divine Proportions showed textbook class when defeating colts to win the G3 Prix du Bois at Chantilly June 28, the G2 Prix Robert Papin at Maisons-Laffitte July 25 and the G1 Prix Morny at Deauville last time Aug. 22. She swept aside Layman there on desperate ground, but traveled with far greater ease back on this faster surface under a confident Christophe-Patrice Lemaire when stalking the leader Titian Time throughout under cover against the fence. Responding instantly when a gap opened inside the final quarter, she hit the front at the eighth pole before settling the result in a matter of strides, just missing the race record in the process. "She's a fantastic filly and, for a trainer, a filly like her is a dream," conditioner Pascal Bary commented. "She is exceptional, and each time she is running she is winning easier. She handled the mile beautifully and, although it is hard to compare with past generations, she is just amazing. I can't say which Guineas she will go for next May, but she has shown a liking for Longchamp." Kevin Manning provided an exhibition of daring bravado rarely seen on this stage when threading Alexander Goldrun through the pack to upset Grey Lilas before connections had to sweat out an inquiry. Noel O'Callaghan's filly had delivered a potent turn of acceleration to win the Listed Park Express S. at The Curragh Mar. 21 and G3 1000 Guineas Trial at Leopardstown May 9 and was the only rival to give Attraction (GB) a race when a length second in the G1 Irish 1000 Guineas back there May 23. She finished fourth behind Lattice (Ire) in the G1 Prix de Diane at Chantilly June 13 before finding only Chorist (GB) too strong in the G1 Pretty Polly S. back at The Curragh last time June 26. Freshened for this, she was held up in rear throughout the early stages before quickening up the rail at the top of the straight and finding a charmed passage to challenge Grey Lilas inside the final eighth. She bumped that rival when grabbing the lead with 100 yards remaining en route to a convincing score, but the stewards judged that it had not affected the outcome. "We were concerned about the ground, but we needn't have been," her trainer Jim Bolger explained. "She's had three months off as we'd given her a hard time and it was always the plan to run here. He encountered vastly contrasting conditions to last year, but it was just as easy for Westerner, who out-classed his rivals to record back-to-back successes in this contest. He had to travail through the mud 12 months ago en route to a five-length victory before displaying admirable versatility when dropped in trip to take the G1 Prix Royal-Oak back at this track. Following another course win in the G3 Prix de Barbeville Apr. 22 and a surprise defeat in the G2 Prix Vicomtesse Vigier May 23, he met his match in Papineau (GB) in the G1 Ascot Gold Cup at the Royal meeting June 17. After a failed attempt to drop in trip in the G1 Grand Prix de Saint-Cloud July 4, he warmed up for this by taking the G3 Prix Gladiateur at this venue last time Sept. 12. Always traveling with supreme ease under cover in fourth, he was full of run when angled wide for his run at the top of the straight by Olivier Peslier and quickened clear in a matter of strides for an emphatic score. "He's a really grand stayer and Olivier [Peslier] told me he was so relaxed he didn't need to take out the ear plugs," trainer Elie Lellouche commented. With only one home-trained sprinter in the line-up, this contest was always due for export, and it was the trail-blazing Var who departed with the spoils when just missing the track record set by Habibti (GB) in 1983. After winning an optional claimer at Calder Jan. 2, the dark bay, who broke his maiden in for a \$30,000 tag at Aqueduct in March of 2003, joined Newmarket conditioner Clive Brittain and met with an immediate setback when receiving a kick and losing a quarter inch of his shoulder blade. After weeks of nursing, he was kicked again and missed more time, but showed electric speed when wiring the Listed Starlit S. at Goodwood on his European debut Sept. 11. He almost got away from The Tatling in the G3 World Trophy at Newbury before being caught in the final strides a week later, but had too much rope this time and the post came in time for Frankie Dettori as that rival ate into his advantage late on. "He's had a few setbacks and, after swimming and therapy, I was training him twice a day," Brittain explained. "Last time he probably went too quick, but he showed me that he was top class and won nicely today. The GI Breeders' Cup Sprint [at Lone Star Park Oct. 30] could be on the cards as well as the G1 Hong Kong Sprint [at Sha Tin Dec. 12]." "He'll be operated on [Monday] and they'll put two or three screws in his right ankle," explained trainer Nick Zito. "Gary [jockey Stevens] said he felt it on the turn, and I guess that is when he was going by Funny Cide." A \$200,000 KEESEP yearling, The Cliff's Edge captured his debut at Saratoga in 2003 and closed out his juvenile campaign with victories in the GIII Iroquois S. and the GII Kentucky

Jockey Club S. In his second start this year, he was the runner-up in the GI Florida Derby before defeating Lion Heart in the GI Toyota Blue Grass S. in April. He lost two shoes during the running of the GI Kentucky Derby, but still wound up fifth to Smarty Jones. Following a layup with a foot bruise, The Cliff's Edge returned to run second in the GI Travers S., the GII Jim Dandy S. and the GII Dwyer S. before taking on his elders at Belmont Saturday. The colt made a menacing move on the turn before finishing third to last year's Kentucky Derby winner, Funny Cide. The Cliff's Edge heads into retirement with a record of 13-4-5-2 and a bankroll of \$1,265,258. "He's going to Vinery to be a stallion, and he's going to be a great stallion," added Zito. "Consistency is what makes a horse great, and he was consistent. He's by Gulch out of a Danzig mare."
