Wayne Lukas trainee allowed an eager Tamweel (Gulch) to take control, sitting just off the flank of that foe through splits of :23.35, :46.99 and 1:11.71. Azeri, given just a slight nudge turning for Bill Straus home, poked a head in front in upper stretch before strid-

Another Up for Azeri...

It's been an up-and-down year for 2002 Horse of the Year Azeri. Transferred to the D. Wayne Lukas barn for the 2004 season, the six-year-old mare kicked off the year with a spectacular victory in the GI Apple Blossom H. in early April, but a narrow defeat by Mayo on the Side (French Deputy) in the GI Humana Distaff H. at Churchill May 1 was followed by lackluster off-theboard efforts in the GI Metropolian H. May 31 against the boys and GI Ogden Phipps H. June 19. Just as the naysayers were mounting in number, she returned to her winning ways with aplomb, handing the brilliant Sightseek a 1 3/4-length loss in the GI Go For Wand H. at Saratoga Aug. 1. Made the 3-5 pick for her latest, Azeri suffered another slight setback when she got caught up in a fierce speed duel and couldn't fend off Storm Flag Flying in the 1 1/4-mile GI Personal Ensign H. at the Spa Aug. 27, finishing a length and a quarter adrift of that foe. Sent off the 2-5 pick to rebound once again, Azeri cruised under the wire with something left in yesterday's feature at Keeneland. Jockey Pat Day, riding Azeri for the fifth straight time after replacing Mike Smith, was as impressed as anyone with the racemare's performance. "I don't know what price she finally went off at, but every cent was richly deserved," he said. "She may be as good as any mare I've ridden. She's absolutely genuine." Weel in the Sky...

Runner-up **Tamweel**, second to last year's Breeders' Cup Distaff winner Adoration in the Sept. 4 GIII Arlington Matron H., come right back to run a very good race against another top-class mare in Azeri. "Last time we ran, we got beat by the best filly or mare in the country," said trainer Wayne Catalano. "This time, it took the best to beat us again. Second place in a Grade I is a feather in her cap. As far as the Breeders' Cup [Distaff] is concerned, we've always been pointing toward it."

Pt's Grey Eagle was haltered by Craig Dollase exactly 11 months ago, then disappeared. Tried on the turf in his return, a Hollywood allowance test June 13, the gray ran fifth and was switched back to the dirt. He finished second in his next two before besting entrylevel allowance foes at Del Mar Aug. 22, an effort that earned him a chance vs. stakes company. Sent off at 6-5 in the Foothill S., he grabbed the lead late after pressing the pace, but couldn't quite hang on and settled for second. The Santa Anita handicappers looked at that form and quickly dismissed Pt's Grey Eagle in his Grade I debut, but they were wrong to do so. Carrying just 109 pounds, the gelding changed tactics to sit off the pace as Hombre Rapido clipped off fractions of :21.04 and :43.79. Pohave took over as they raced down the lane, but Pt's Grey Eagle soared through the final furlong to catch the crowd's choice in the shadow of the wire. It would cost \$90,000 to supplement the winner to the GI Breeders' Cup Sprint for \$90,000, but Dollase said, "There's a possibility. We'd have to ante up some money, but [owner J. Frankie Dettori currently holds a healthy lead in the British jockeys' championship, but he took a day off from domestic duty to return to his homeland for Europe's race of the day. Giving his rivals a free pacesetting lesson, he secured his fourth renewal of this since 1999, guiding Ancient World to an easy first Group 1 win. Trained by Andre Fabre for Sheikh Mohammed last year, Godolphin's colorbearer returned after being gelded to record an impressive success in the valuable William Hill Mile handicap at Goodwood July 30. He disappointed next time when eighth of 12 behind Norse Dancer in the G3 Sovereign S. at Salisbury Aug. 12, but was back at his best when defeating Gateman (GB) in the G3 Winter Hill S. at Windsor Aug. 28, his latest offering. After sending Ancient World straight to the front at the start, Dettori allowed his mount a breather rounding the home turn, then upped the tempo once more in the straight. Ridden along inside the final quarter mile, the four-year-old ran on strongly to wire for a decisive tally. The winner's second dam is a half-sister to 1976 Kentucky Derby winner Bold Forbes. Super Brand, third in her only other U.S. outing in the Aug. 11 De La Rose S. at Saratoga, tracked the early leaders but couldn't hold off Stay Forever late. "From the time we left the gate, she was rank, she clipped heels, and when she did I thought that might make her want to settle, but she wouldn't," said the South African mare's jockey Pat Day. "She was rank around the entire racecourse. It is solely up to [trainer] Mr. [Kiaran] McLaughlin and [owner] Team Valor, but I thought she earned her chance maybe to running in the Breeders' Cup Filly and Mare Turf." "He's a grand horse, he was raw the first day and he was still raw today," commented trainer Aidan O'Brien. "He has a big engine and he is a strong, galloping horse."
