The website also reported that pensioned 27-year-old stallion **Dr. Blum** (Dr. Fager--Due Dilly, by Sir Gaylord) was euthanized at Sugar Maple in early October due to a throat tumor.

HONOR IN WAR LIKELY FOR MILE

Honor In War (Lord at War {Arg}), a good second to Nothing To Lose (Sky Classic) in Keeneland's GI Shadwell Turf Mile last Saturday, is likely to make his

NetJets Breeders' Cup Mile,
trainer Paul McGee indicated yesterday from Kentucky. "He came
out of the race really well," the
conditioner said of the five-yearold, owned by the 3rd Turn Stables of ex-NFL footballer Will
Wolford. "As much as he needed

his race at Arlington [third in the Sept. 18 John Henry S.], I think he also needed the race in the Shadwell and I think he's sitting on a big one." The chestnut also finished runner-up in the 2003 renewal of the Shadwell, but a sprained ankle led to his withdrawal from the Breeders' Cup. The upset winner of the GI Woodford Reserve Turf Classic last season, Honor In War is winless in five starts in 2004.

(Artax) looks the class of today's GII Raven Run S. at Keeneland and will likely go off the crowd's choice despite the 2 1/2-month respite. The chestnut finished third to a good pair in Island Sand and Society Selection in the one-mile GI Acorn S. at Belmont June 4, then established herself as one of the better sprinting fillies of her class with a 2 1/4-length tally in the GI Prioress S. at Belmont July 3. Sent off the chalk in her next, the Test at Saratoga, she took mud in her face at the break and

her belated run wasn't nearly enough to catch Society Selection. Friendly Michelle is five-for-six when sprinting over dry tracks--her lone loss coming in her debut last summer--but with a forecast predicting rain, it's likely she'll be on the off-going once again. Feline Story (Tale of the Cat) has been first or second in five of seven on off tracks, including a rallying victory in her latest, the GIII Floral Park H. run over a sloppy Belmont oval Sept. 18. Look for Vision of Beauty (Danzig) and Salty Romance (Salt Lake) to mix it up early. The former is coming off a Saratoga allowance win, the latter a Belmont allowance win, and both speedsters have a shot to upset wire-to-wire.

Sent off a hot 3-5 choice in his latest, a 7 1/2 furlong test against New York breds here Sept. 24, Commentator recorded an impressive 106 Beyer that day and was made the clear second choice for his stakes debut. On the engine early, the gelding improved his position at every call and drew off in the stretch to win by daylight, setting a stakes record in the process. "He answered a lot of questions today," said winning trainer Nick Zito, winning this for the second time in three years. "He's an amazing horse who just keeps getting better." Graded stakes winner Eurosilver, who was returning from a seven-month respite, finished second as the third choice. Referring to his former stable inmate, Zito added, "I'm very happy that Eurosilver ran the way he did. He's a quality horse and that means we have a nice horse too."

"It's good to be back," Bailey said, after finishing fourth aboard Soul Star in the sixth race. "I feel good. The horses could have run a little better today, but they ran okay." In his other mount, he finished fourth on My Muchacha in the day's fourth race. Bailey is looking forward to Breeders' Cup World Championship day at Lone Star Oct. 30 and his mount aboard Pleasantly Perfect in the Classic. "The guy [Richard Mandella] with the best horse in the world never flinched," Bailey added. "I told him I would be back ready because I knew I would. Ramsey jumped ship with Kitten's Joy, but that's part of the business."
