GREEK SUN RISES IN OAK TREE DERBY

Greek Sun (Danzig) moved back into the spotlight Sunday with a come-from-behind move, taking the GII Oak Tree Derby at Santa Anita Park. Well back in the early going, the well-bred three-year-old mounted his attack, while racing five wide, heading into the stretch

and swept to the front in the final strides, outgaming Laura's Lucky Boy (Theatrical {Ire}) for the prize. "He's a nice horse who needs a little room to get himself going and he did that," explained winning rider Edgar Prado, who flew in for the mount. Lightly-raced Greek Sun

started off his career with three-straight victories, including the GIII Cinema Breeders' Cup H. at Hollywood Park June 26 before finishing a respectable second to turf star Kitten's Joy next time in the GI Secretariat S. at Arlington Aug. 14. A flat eighth over the soggy Belmont turf in the GI Man O War H. Sept.11, Greek Sun was made the 7-5 to make it two for two over the track and distance. Then comes the G1 Prince of Wales's S., which will be run at York. We will then stretch him up to a mile and a half, and the GI King George VI and Queen Elizabeth Diamond S. [at Newbury] would be the obvious race for that."

Shirocco (Ger) (Monsun {Ger}) capped a memorable day for Germany at the San Siro when denying Electrocutionist (Red Ransom) in a pulsating finish to yesterday's G1 Gran Premio del Jockey Club. Following hot on the heels of a German one-two in the G1 Gran Criterium, Baron Georg von Ullmann's G1 Deutsches Derby winner made virtually all the running and pulled out all the stops to deny the home hope by a short head in a bobbing finish "Shirocco is very good and today he really showed some guts when he was fighting for victory," his owner Baron Georg von Ullmann told *PA Sport*.

Shirocco debuted at Krefeld only in March, but has made rapid strides subsequently, winning the Listed Derby-Trial at Mulheim May 15 before filling third spot in the G2 Oppenheim-Union-Rennen at Cologne June 13. He destroyed his rivals with a relentless display of galloping when winning the Deutches Derby by four lengths at Hamburg July 4 and returned after a summer break to finish third behind Warrsan (Ire) in the G1 Grosser Preis von Baden last time Sept. 5. Von Ullmann announced that he will remain in training as a four-yearold, when the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe will be his main target. "He is a top-class horse and we hope that he will be a real star in Europe's best races next season," he added. Electrocutionist's trainer Valfredo Valiani told PA Sport, "We chose to run even though we knew the ground was really too soft. Imperial Dancer (GB) (Primo Dominie {GB}) finished third, but was disqualified and placed fifth.

Germany continued its domination of the afternoon, with the Gestut Schlenderhan homebred stable mates Konigstiger and Idealist filling the first two places here. With just a debut score at Baden-Baden Sept. 1 to his name entering this contest, Konigstiger was deserted by Andreas Suborics in favor of the Listed Junioren-Preis scorer, but it was Filip Minarik who benefited from that decision to cause the upset. Settled in a stalking position off the moderate early pace, he followed Hearthstead Wings through when that rival was committed with three furlongs remaining and challenged soon after. Getting the better of that rival in the final 100 yards, he held on to his slim advantage as Idealist closed late under Suborics. Konigstiger marks the first Group 1 winner for his owner-breeder's stallion Tiger Hill (by Danehill), who was also responsible for the runner-up. Pride relished the deep turf of Chantilly when winning the G3 Prix Allez France May 7 before finding the faster surface against her in a third-place effort in the G2 Prix Corrida at Saint-Cloud May 31. After finishing fifth in the G1 Grand Prix de Saint-Cloud July 4, she filled the runner-up spot in the G2 Prix Jean Romanet at Deauville Aug. 22 and was third in the G1 Prix Vermeille at this track Sept. 12. She was allowed to take her chance in the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe back here, but did not enjoy the best of runs and finished down the field last time Oct. 3. Back on her favored soft ground, she traveled easily in rear before quickening at the top of the straight to pass all her rivals before reaching the eighth peg. Manduro was providing his ownerbreeder Baron Georg von Ullmann with an afternoon to cherish after the San Siro exploits of his star performer Shirocco (Ger), also by Monsun. He is the fourth foal bred from the Listed-placed mare Mandellicht, whose progeny include the G1 Preis der Diana (German Oaks) third Mandela (Ger).

and Aug. 14 before heading to New York. A close fourth, beaten 1 1/4 lengths, to Lady Tak in the GI Ballerina H. Aug. 29, she chased that filly again when second in the GII Gallant Bloom H. last Sunday. Trainer Dallas Stewart opted to wheel his charge right back and Molto Vita was up to the challenge. Breaking alertly under meet-lead-

ing rider Rafael Bejarano, she rolled along on the front end with a clear advantage through splits of :22.09 and :45.75. Favored My Trusty Cat took a run at her down the lane, but Molto Vita kept finding more and maintained her momentum going under the wire. "My filly broke very, very sharp and even though there were two other speed horses in the race, I was sitting against her all the way," Bejarano said. "She won super easy." As for the decision to run Molto Vita back quickly, Stewart said, "Sometimes it works and sometimes it doesn't. She bounced out of that last race well, so [owner] Mr. Gunther and I put our heads together and we felt if everything was good this morning, we would go ahead and do it. And look what she did!"
