ELUSIVE QUALITY'S FEE UPPED TO \$100,000

Third-crop stallion **Elusive Quality** (Gone West--Touch of Greatness, by Hero's Honor), sire of Kentucky Derby winner Smarty Jones and current leader on the general sire list, will stand the upcoming breeding season for \$100,000 at Gainsborough Farm in Kentucky. The 11-year-old stood for \$50,000 in 2004. Owned by Darley Stud, Elusive Quality currently has five 2004 stakes winners and progeny earnings of over \$10 million. "Obviously, he's done great on the racetrack," said Dan Pride, the director of stallion operations for Darley in the U.S. "The horse was booked full this year before Smarty Jones even really got on the radar screen in the spring." Asked if the announcement of Smarty Jones' stud fee, which is also at \$100,000, was considered when setting Elusive

Quality's fee, Pride said, "We look at all stud fee factors--from Gone West going from \$125,000 to \$150,000, and then Smarty Jones retiring at \$100,00--but as big a factor as anything was the commercial success that the yearlings had from the July sale at Fasig-Tipton all the way through [Keeneland] September. All of those yearlings were bred in his fourth year, when the horse was advertised at \$10,000. So that's what really gave us an optimistic view that the market is very much behind this

horse." Elusive Quality is slated to breed a book numbering between 130 to 140 in 2005, which includes mares from the Darley operation. Pride indicated that Darley has averaged about 30 mares to Elusive Quality the past several years, a number that will likely remain the same, but the quality of mares has risen the last two seasons. "Both last year and this year, he's been supported by mares that you'd want in a stallion's book, for sure," he said.

With his spectacular weekend treble boosting his lead over Dubai Millennium to more than £200,000, Giant's Causeway now looks guaranteed to take the title of leading freshman sire in Britain and Ireland in what has been a high-quality competition.

Of course, a great deal was expected of Giant's Causeway, especially after his daughter My Typhoon had set record figures for a weanling filly at Tattersalls' 2002 December Sale and another daughter, Mona Lisa, had topped the European yearling sales in 2003.

We will no doubt be hearing a lot more of these fillies, as My Typhoon was impressive on her debut at Saratoga and Mona Lisa, in my opinion, was unlucky not to go close to winning last month's G1 Meon Valley Stud Fillies' Mile--she was stopped in her tracks at a crucial stage before rallying for fourth place.

However, it wasn't all smooth sailing in the sales ring. I mentioned in my first-crop sire review earlier in the year that "the universal admiration [Giant's Causeway] generated on the track didn't extend to all of his first yearlings, with some judges complaining that he hadn't stamped his stock."

Among the yearlings that struggled were a colt out of Helsinki, whose price of 50,000gns made him the cheapest Giant's Causeway to find a buyer at the Houghton Sale, and a filly out of Vallee des Reves, who was bought in for 25,000gns at Tattersalls' December Sale. The colt is now known as Shamardal, who kept his unbeaten record intact in Saturday's G1 Dewhurst S., not long after the G2 Rockfel S. had fallen to Maids Causeway, the filly who couldn't find a buyer at 25,000gns.

Both are out of mares by sons of Mr. Prospector and both have interesting backgrounds. Another with an intriguing pedigree is Footstepsinthesand, who completed his sire's weekend treble with an impressive maiden-race victory over Olympic, the Danzig colt who was last year's highest-priced yearling colt.

There had been very high hopes when the Helsinki colt was consigned to the Keeneland Sale as a weanling, but the Eaton Sales offering was led out unsold at \$475,000. Even though he didn't sell, it was hard to understand how he came to be sold for the equivalent of \$87,680 as a yearling. Michael Goodbody supplied the explanation on Saturday when he revealed that Shamardal had been the subject of an insurance claim after he'd been diagnosed as a wobbler. However, the colt made a miraculous recovery and it was apparently the insurance company which sold him as a yearling.

Shamardal is now a clear favorite for the 2000 Guineas, but the bookmakers seem less sure about his Derby prospects. These reservations no doubt stem from the fact that his grandsires are Storm Cat and Machiavellian, but I wouldn't rule out the possibility that he could last a mile and a half.

His second dam, Helen Street, was an Irish Oaks winner by the Derby-winning Troy--a very powerful influence for stamina--and his dam Helsinki is a sister to Street Cry, who was so impressive in winning the Dubai World Cup over a mile and a quarter. Remember, too, that Giant's Causeway won over an extended mile and a quarter in the Juddmonte International.

Incidentally, Helsinki is to be sold at Keeneland on Nov. 10, in foal to Cherokee Run, and she will be accompanied by her Unbridled's Song filly.

Moving on to Maids Causeway, she has an interesting pedigree in that her dam Vallee des Reves is inbred 3x2 to Nureyev, through his daughters Miesque and Venise.

This Kingmambo mare never raced and must have retired early, as she was already in foal to Danehill when she was sold for 320,000gns as a three-year-old. As her price indicates, this is an excellent family and Maids Causeway follows the likes of Vallee Enchantee, Volga and Vespone as the sixth group winner produced by daughters of Venise.

Vallee Enchantee has the distinction of being inbred 2x3 to Nureyev, as is her group-placed brother Vassilievsky. The German Oaks winner Silvester Lady is another inbred to this exceptional stallion, this time 3x3, and I suspect we will be seeing more examples of this type of inbreeding over the next few years. After all, why not try to reinforce the influence of a stallion who sired 17 percent stakes winners?

Moving on to Footstepsinthesand, he could hardly have been more impressive in winning a 20-runner maiden race easing up. While it could be dangerous to read too much into a win in a Naas maiden, this colt showed an encouraging amount of speed to lead all the way over six furlongs. Footstepsinthesand's dam, the group-winning Glatissant, is bred to the same Rainbow Quest--Green Dancer cross as the Derby winner Quest For Fame, so here is another colt who should eventually stay a mile and a quarter.

Bearing in mind that Storm Cat's matings with granddaughters of Blushing Groom have produced not just Giant's Causeway, but also the multiple Group 1 winner Aljabr, breeders were bound to try Giant's Causeway with mares with more Blushing Groom blood.

Anthony Oppenheimer, of the Hascombe and Valiant Studs, took this one step further by sending a Rainbow Quest mare to Giant's Causeway. Rahy, the broodmare sire of Giant's Causeway, is by Blushing Groom and has a Herbager mare as his second dam. He is therefore bred along similar lines to Rainbow Quest, who was sired by Blushing Groom from another Herbager mare. This means that Footstepsinthesand is inbred 4x3 to Blushing Groom and 6x4 to Herbager.

While the two lines of Herbager are fairly distant, I always find it interesting when he appears more than once in a pedigree. This is because his dam Flagette was incestuously bred--both parents are by St Leger winner Firdaussi. Singspiel has two lines of Herbager; his Group 1-winning son Papineau has three.

ORATORIO OUT FOR THE YEAR

Oratorio (Ire) (Danehill), second to Shamardal in Saturday's G1 Darley Dewhurst S. at Newmarket, pulled a muscle during the race and will miss the rest of the season, the *Racing Post* reports. The two-year-old had been expected to run in the Oct. 30 GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile. "Oratorio ran very well, but the muscle that he pulled was in his hindquarters, so he won't go to America and he's finished for the season," trainer Aidan O'Brien told *Racing Post*. "We probably won't have a runner for the Juvenile now."

The temperamental Sweep Tosho, transferred from retiring trainer Sakae Watanabe to Akio Tsurudome's barn in February, was allowed to settle well off the pace. She showed steady acceleration with a furlong to run and finished strongly to hold off last year's champion two-year-old filly Yamanin Sucre for a half-length victory in the third leg of the filly triple crown. Sweep Tosho broke her maiden last October and took the G3 Fantasy S. in November before ending her juvenile campaign with a fifth-place effort in the G1 Hanshin Juvenile Fillies. The bay filly won the Jan. 18 Kobai S. in her seasonal debut and added the Mar. 6 G3 Tulip Sho before suffering defeats in the Oka Sho and Japanese Oaks in the spring. After a freshening, Sweep Tosho returned to run third in the Aug. 15 G3 Queen S. She is expected to start next in the Nov. 14 G1 Queen Elizabeth II Commemorative Cup at Kyoto. Odds-on favorite Dance in the Mood (Jpn) (Sunday Silence), runner-up in the July 3 GI American Oaks at Hollywood Park, never posed a serious threat and finished fourth. **Stakes Results cont. p4**

PERFECT SOUL RETIRED Charles Fipke's **Perfect Soul (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells--Ball Chairman, by Secretariat), who was scheduled to make his final career start in the GI Breeders' Cup Mile at Lone Star Oct. 31, has been retired from racing, according to *The Blood-Horse*. The six-year-old reportedly came down with a fever following a seventh-place finish in his latest start, Keeneland's GI Shadwell Turf Mile, a race he had won in 2003. Breeding plans have not been finalized.

"We felt it wouldn't be fair running him," trainer Roger Attfield told *Blood-Horse*. "Other than that, he's as sound as a bell of brass." Named last year's Canadian Turf Champion following wins in the Shadwell Mile and the GII King Edward Breeders' Cup H. at Woodbine, Perfect Soul captured this year's GII Maker's Mark H. at Keeneland and also finished second to Soaring Free in the GI Atto Mile. The Irish-bred retires with seven wins from 21 starts and earnings of \$1,527,764.

Rock Hard Ten (Kris S.), on the sidelines since emerging from a disappointing sixth-place finish in the Aug. 8 GI Haskell Invitational H. with a respiratory illness, is set to return to serious training.

"He was going to work this week, but it's been raining out here, so it will probably be next week some time," said his trainer, Jason Orman. Second to Smarty Jones in the GI Preakness S. in mid-May, the towering Rock Hard Ten re-

Orman said that the time off has been good for his charge and that, should all go to plan, Rock Hard Ten will return in time for the Strub series at Santa Anita. "We're going to point toward the [GI] Malibu S. [Dec. 26] and just go from there," said Orman.

THIS WEEK IN HISTORY...

October 20, 1923...Zev, winner of the 1923 Kentucky Derby, defeated English hero **Papyrus**, winner of the 1923 Epsom Derby, in a \$100,000 match race at Belmont Park. The race, called the International Special, marked the first time an English champion was sent to the U.S. to race. Public interest was so great the race was broadcast on the radio--a first.

October 21, 1961...Jockey **Eddie Arcaro** won the Jockey Club Gold Cup for a record 10th time, riding the great Kelso to victory at Belmont Park. Winner of the race in 1960 as well, Kelso went on to take the race in '62, '63 and '64, setting the mark for most consecutive victories in a stakes race.
