Blood-Horse

101 ENTERED FOR BREEDERS' CUP

A total of 101 horses have been pre-entered for Breeders' Cup XXI, which will be held in the Southwest for the first time Oct. 30 at Lone Star Park in Grand Prairie, Texas. Though that equals the number of horses entered in last year's renewal at Santa Anita, only 11 entrants are based overseas, 10 from Europe and one

from Japan. "We know that it's a little bit more of a recruiting challenge when we are warm-weather venues," said Breeders' Cup President D.G. Van Clief. "We had the same problem last year at Santa Anita. They have more

to overcome to ship to Texas or California than they do to Kentucky or New York." Van Clief added, "When there are three weeks between the Arc de Triomphe, which was the case this year, instead of four, then it's a little tougher to ask those horses to come over." The European headliner this year is the sophomore filly **Ouija Board (GB)** (Cape Cross {Ire}), a dual Oaks winner who was most recently a fast-finishing third in the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe. The Lord Derby homebred has been supplemented to both the \$2-million G1 Breeders' Cup Turf and the \$1-million G1 Breeders' Cup F/M Turf.

All Class...

The \$4-million G1 Breeders' Cup Classic has drawn all of the top U.S. horses in training, including defending champion **Pleasantly Perfect** (Pleasant Colony) and 2002 Horse of the Year **Azeri** (Jade Hunter), who has also been cross-entered in the \$2-million G1 Breeders' Cup Distaff. The Japanese-based **Personal Rush** (Wild Rush) is the lone surprise entry in the Classic, which will feature the 10-furlong debut for a pair of lightly raced four-year-olds unbeaten this year, **Ghostzapper** (Awesome Again) and **Roses in May** (Devil His Due). The three-year-old **Birdstone** (Grindstone), conqueror of Smarty Jones in the G1 Belmont S. and winner of the G1 Travers S., is slated to face his elders for the first time.

A Hot Hand for the Ramseys...

Owners Kenneth and Sarah Ramsey are no strangers to the racing game, but the Breeders' Cup has proven somewhat elusive to the couple. Since the championship's inception 21 years ago, the Ramseys have been represented by a single contestant, Catenus, who finished 13th in the 1999 Classic at Gulfstream Park. This year, however, they have a three-pronged arsenal led by sophomore turf star **Kitten's Joy** (El Prado {Ire}), probable favorite in the 12-furlong Turf; Classic hopeful **Roses in May** (Devil His Due) and **Nothing to Lose** (Sky Classic), who will contest the Mile. With the absence of many of Europe's top horses, Kitten's Joy appears to hold the upper hand in the Turf division. A winner of six of seven starts this term, Kitten's Joy most recently scored in Arlington's GI Secretariat S. Aug. 14 and Oct. 2 GI Turf Classic Invitational at Belmont Park. As if those credentials weren't impressive enough, stablemate **Roses in May** is a perfect five for five this term, highlighted by a victory in the GI Whitney H. While winless in his first five starts of the season, **Nothing to Lose** ran in the money in four of those races, but recently bumped his game up a notch with an impressive victory in Keeneland's GI Shadwell Turf Mile last time out Oct. 9.

Stevens To Skip Cup...

Jockey Gary Stevens has decided not to participate in this year's Breeders' Cup World Thoroughbred Championships, citing concerns over the limits of workers' compensation insurance in Texas and other racing jurisdictions. "I won't ride the Breeders' Cup or any other state without workers' comp," the 41-year-old told the *Blood-Horse*. "That includes Texas, Kentucky, Florida and several others." Stevens, who was seriously injured in a spill in the 2003 Arlington Million, explained that medical expenses incurred as the result of an injury are currently capped at \$100,000. "Because of the money involved in the Breeders' Cup, they are the roughest run races the whole year," he added. "It's ironic that we're riding for a million dollars and we're only covered up to \$100,000."

HAAFHD RETIRED Sheikh Hamdan bin Rashid Al Maktoum's G1 2000 Guineas and G1 Champion S. winner **Haafhd (GB)** (Alhaarth {Ire}--Al Bahathri, by Blushing Groom {Fr}) has been retired to stud, it was announced yesterday. Despite early suggestions that the homebred colt would race on at four after his 2½-length success in Saturday's feature of Champions' Day, connections have called time on his career. Haafhd, who is out of Sheikh Hamdan's G1 Irish 2000 Guineas winner Al Bahathri, emerged on the scene with an emphatic success in the Listed Washington Singer S. at Newbury in August, breaking Newbury's juvenile track record in the process. He could only finish third in the G2 Champagne S. at Doncaster and G1 Dewhurst S. at Newmarket in October, but returned to the latter track to record a five-length score in the G3 Craven S. Apr. 15. He beat no less than four subsequent Group 1 winners in the mile Classic May 1, but disappointed when fourth in the G1 St James's Palace S. at Royal Ascot June 15 and ninth in the G1 Sussex S. at Goodwood July 28. He bounced back with aplomb in what proved to be his finale in the Champion S. Sheikh Hamdan's Racing Manager Angus Gold paid tribute yesterday. "Sheikh Hamdan decided he was a very important cog in his breeding operation and what gave him such immense pleasure was that this horse was a product of a stallion he bred and race himself out of the first really good filly he raced," he commented. "He is very close to Sheikh Hamdan's heart and got a lot of the dam's quality and toughness. What is lovely about him from a stud point of view is that he had the speed to win over six furlongs and stamina to win over a mile and a quarter at the end of his career. In between he defeated a high-class field in a Guineas run in a very fast time. His form dipped a bit in the summer and as Richard Hills said we got him spot on for Guineas day and its hard to maintain that level of form right through the season. It was great to see him come back to his very best and dominate the Champion S. He was not only a very talented horse, but a versatile one too." Haafhd retires with five wins in nine starts and lifetime earnings of £492,288.

STUD FEES SET FOR LION HEART AND CHAPEL ROYAL Recently retired graded stakes winners **Lion Heart** (Tale of the Cat) and **Chapel Royal** (Montbrook) will enter stud at Ashford Stud near Versailles, Kentucky in 2005. Lion Heart will stand for \$30,000, while Chapel Royal's fee will be \$10,000. Lion Heart, who brought top price of \$1.4-million at the 2003 Fasig-Tipton two-year-old in Training Sale, won the 2004 GI Haskell Invitational H. and the 2003 GI Hollywood Futurity and also finished second to Smarty Jones in the GI Kentucky Derby.

The chestnut retired with five wins from 10 starts and career earnings of \$1,390,800. Chapel Royal, who also weighed in at a hefty \$1.2 million at last year's Ocala Breeders' Sales Co. juvenile sale, recorded his biggest wins in last year's GII Sanford S. and finished runner-up in the GI Champagne S. and the GI Hopeful S. The bay won three of eight starts through two seasons, while amassing earnings of \$495,571.

Mubtaker (Silver Hawk) has arrived safely in Toronto from his British base. Last year's Arc runner-up is bidding to bury the memory of his disappointing seventh in the G1 Grosser Preis von Baden last time Sept. 5, the only time the seven-year-old has missed the frame in his career. "I spoke to [trainer] Marcus [Tregoning] yesterday and he said he seemed to have traveled well and looked fine on arrival," commented Angus Gold, racing manager for owner Sheikh Hamdan. "It will be a tough assignment, but he's been unbelievably tough and genuine for us and a thoroughly admirable character in every way. The only time he has been unplaced was his last run, which was disappointing, but Marcus very definitely felt that it was the ground and he has been working tremendously well recently, so we will hope for a bit of luck on the day."

Holland died early Wednesday morning in Royal Adelaide Hospital as a result of injuries sustained in the accident. Phillip McEvoy, Kerrin's father and Holland's son-in-law, said Holland was helping educate a filly for a neighbor. "He was still so active for somebody of his age. He had just come back from shearing 160 sheep a day and was about to reapply for his trainer's licence," he told Melbourne's Herald-Sun newspaper. McEvoy, 22, won the 2001 Melbourne Cup on Brew and ran third in the 2002 Cup on Beekeeper, a ride that caught the attention of Godolphin and resulted in McEvoy going to Dubai to ride for the internationally dominant stable.
