### FUNNY CIDE PREPS FOR CLASSIC

Sackatoga Stable's **Funny Cide** (Distorted Humor) drilled six furlongs beneath assistant trainer Robin Smullen yesterday morning over the Belmont main track in 1:12 4/5, one of his final moves ahead of the GI

Breeders' Cup Classic a week from tomorrow. "He worked really good and came back very strong," said trainer Barclay Tagg. "He's doing very well. He hasn't done a thing wrong." The New York-bred was originally scheduled to work Tuesday or Wednesday, but rains earlier in the week rendered the Belmont oval

sloppy. Funny Cide has been a model of consistency in 2004, with three wins from nine starts and just one off-the-board effort, a respectable fifth behind Pico Central (Brz) in the GI Met Mile. He comes into the Classic off a victory in the GI Jockey Club Gold Cup and his Beyer Speed Figure of 112 is second only to the 114 he earned for his victory in last year's Preakness S. "He's run very well every start this season," Tagg continued. "He's done very well since the Gold Cup...hasn't missed a beat." The chestnut gelding is scheduled to ship to Texas on Wednesday with one more work on tap prior to his departure.

### ON THE OUTSIDE LOOKING IN

3rd Turn Stable's **Honor in War** (Lord at War {Arg}), second to **Nothing To Lose** (Sky Classic) in the GI Shadwell Turf Mile at Keeneland Oct. 9, stretched his legs yesterday morning, going five furlongs over a soft turf course in Lexington. "I caught him in 1:04 4/5," trainer Paul McGee said following the work. "I think that's what the clockers got him in too. I thought he breezed really good. It was nothing flashy, but I think he got something out of it. He came back great and scoped good. We're just hoping he gets in." Honor in War is currently third on the list of also-eligibles, but two horses who drew into the main body of the field have first preferences in other races: Balto Star in the Turf and Bowman's Band in the Classic.

### DURING TO CLAIBORNE

Multiple graded stakes winner **During** (Cherokee Run--Blading Saddle, by Blade) will begin his stud career at Claiborne Farm near Paris, Kentucky, next season.

"We're really looking forward to having During at Claiborne," said the farm's spokesman Bernie Sams. "He's a total outcross for Mr. Prospector and Northern Dancer, he's a very attractive horse and he has a world of talent." During captured last year's GI Swaps S., GI Jerome H. and

GI Discovery H. This year, the four-year-old dark bay won the GI San Fernando Breeders' Cup S. On the board in 12 of 20 starts to date, During has won six races for \$809,030. He will continue to race for James McIngvale until his retirement and then will stand as the property of a syndicate. His fee has not been announced.

### JOCKEY CLUB RELEASES RMB

The Jockey Club yesterday released its annual Report of Mares Bred (RMB), which showed that 3,239 stallions covered a total of 59,342 mares in North America in 2004, according to information received through Oct. 14. The number of stallions declined by 3.1 percent from the 3,342 reported in 2003 while the number of mares bred was up one percent from 58,755 a year ago. "Despite the Aug. 1 deadline for submission of RMBs, we still haven't received reports for about a quarter of all stallions," said Matt Iuliano, vice president of registration services for The Jockey Club. "However, the 2004 mares bred returns to date are similar to those of 2003 which would support our earlier forecast of 37,200 North American registered foals of 2005." The number of stallions bred to over 100 mares increased from 108 in 2003 to 117 this year. Ashford Stud's Hold That Tiger led all stallions with 199 mares bred, six more than that farm's Fusaichi Pegasus. The entire RMB is available at [www.jockeyclub.com](http://www.jockeyclub.com).

Dyna Da Wyna, a perfect three-for-three over the Keeneland turf prior to this effort, took the Stravinsky S. over this course and trip, but had made only two starts since that Apr. 17 effort. Returning from a two-month freshening, the gray filly was fifth in the 1 1/16-miles GIII Nassau S. at Woodbine before taking an overnight handicap sprinting over a yielding Arlington course July 11. Favored in this 10-horse field, Dyna Da Wyna gained an early advantage, zipping through fractions of :21.30, :44.62 and :56.80, while pressed by Speedy Sonata. She turned back the challenge of her pesky rival in upper stretch and pulled clear late for the victory. "She broke like a shot and carried me straight to the lead," said winning rider Pat Day. "They were running fast, but I thought it would be suicidal to try and reach up and take her out of her game at that time, so I just let her go. She was decidedly sharp today."

**Omega Code** (Elusive Quality--Tin City, by Deputy Minister), who set track records in two of his first three career starts, will enter stud next season at Hartley/DeRenzo Walmac South in Ocala, Florida. He will stand for a fee of \$7,500 as the property of a syndicate. From the first crop of Elusive Quality, the bay won the 2002 Cloud Memorial S., covering six furlongs in 1:07 3/5, the fastest time ever recorded by a two-year-old at that distance. In his first start at three, Omega Code stamped himself as one of the leading sprinters of his generation, winning the GIII San Miguel S. in 1:08 3/5. A half brother to multiple stakes winner and MGSP Tempest Fugit and in-bred 4 X 4 to Northern Dancer, Omega Code was a \$350,000 graduate of the Fasig-Tipton Calder sale in 2002. He retires from the races with three wins from 12 starts and career earnings of \$183,847.

Doncaster Bloodstock Sales Company's October Yearling Sale continued yesterday with what DBS Managing Director Henry Beeby described as "a good, very lively trade." The gross advanced a further 3.2 percent on last year's 44-percent increase, for the corresponding session, to 632,450 guineas and, of the 158 yearlings on offer, 139 sold at an average of 4,550 guineas. Hip 807, a Lear Spear colt offered by Catridge Farm Stud, was knocked down to trainer David Elsworth who also conditioned the sire to win the G2 Prince Of Wales's S. at Royal Ascot. The 50,000 guineas session topper is a son of the winning French Gift (GB) (Cadeaux Genereux {GB}), herself a daughter of 1983 European Champion Older Sprinter Soba (GB).
