#### NO BREEDERS' CUP FOR BALTO STAR

Balto Star (Glitterman), a graded stakes winner on turf and dirt, suffered a slight tear in his right front

tendon in his most recent workout and will not run in the GI Breeders' Cup Turf at Lone Star Park Oct. 30, according to trainer Todd Pletcher. Pletcher said that he would be "given a vacation," but that he wouldn't be retired. The six-year-old was also pre-entered in the GI Breeders' Cup Mile. A winner of the GII Arkansas Derby at three, Balto Star scored the biggest victory of his

career in the 2003 United Nations H. at Monmouth. He kicked off the 2004 season with a game second in the GI Gulfstream Park Breeders' Cup H. Feb. 22, but didn't visit the winner's circle until posting a half-length tally over Classic hopeful Dynever in the GII Meadowlands Breeders' Cup S. last out Oct. 8.

#### BIRDSTONE BREEZES AT SARATOGA

Birdstone (Grindstone), winner of this year's GI Belmont S. and GI Travers S., breezed six furlongs in 1:16 4/5 over a muddy Saratoga training track yesterday morning in preparation for a tilt versus his elders in the GI Breeders' Cup Classic. "He worked really well," trainer Nick Zito told *Blood-Horse*. "The track was very heavy this morning after several days of rain, but this was our last chance to work him before leaving tomorrow. I just hope he can run a good race and close out the year on a good note." He is scheduled to ship to Lone Star Park today.

#### NAKATANI BOOKED FOR EIGHT BC MOUNTS

Jockey Corey Nakatani has been booked by his agent Nick Cosato to ride in all eight Breeders' Cup races. The 34-year-old jockey would equal the record of most Breeders' Cup mounts in a single day established by Jerry Bailey three times and John Velazquez twice. "This is the most I've ever ridden in a Breeders' Cup," Nakatani said. "Normally my horses run pretty good, but I've never had the opportunity in the past that I have this year."

#### ARE YOU MOTIVATED?

When the British autumn weather kicks in, it usually gets soft on Doncaster's Town Moor, making the G1 Racing Post Trophy a traditionally tough test for juveniles. But what **Motivator (GB)** (Montjeu {Ire}) lacks in

experience, he could make up for in class today. He made an instant impression when slicing through the mud to beat a subsequent dual winner by six lengths in a Newmarket maiden on debut Aug. 13, but had to wait for the ground to ease again before revisiting the track. "He's in great order and I think the race will suit him," trainer Michael Bell told the Racing Post. "I'm really pleased with him and he's working well. We've been champing at the bit to

run him...he's a very exciting horse. I suppose the fact that he's only had one run is of slight concern and he may be a bit fresh, but he's got the talent to overcome that." Henrik (GB) (Primo Dominie {GB}) won on his debut at Goodwood May 19, but has not been out since a fine half-length second to Dubawi (Ire) in the G3 Superlative S. July 8. "It was the plan to give him a break, but he is in great heart and I don't think a mile will be a problem," conditioner Mick Channon told the Post. Aidan O'Brien, who has won four of the last seven renewals, saddles Albert Hall (GB) (Danehill) and Hills of Aran (GB) (Sadler's Wells). The former looked a luckless runner-up in a Curragh maiden Sept. 19, but made amends when making all to win the G2 Beresford S. Oct. 10.



Australasia's A\$3-million weight-for-age championship is shaping as genuinely intriguing with longtime favorite Starcraft maintaining his dominance. The Australian-bred **Elegant Fashion** has jetted in from her Hong Kong base, while international competitor **Paolini** will fly the flag for Germany. Winner of the G1 Dubai Duty Free Mar. 27 at Nad al Sheba, Paolini was injured in his next start when unplaced in the G1 Singapore Airlines International Cup at Kranji May 16 and most recently returned to finish sixth going a mile in the G1 Prix du Moulin at Longchamp Sept. 5. But the overseas challengers will have to deal with an able cast of locals, headed by Starcraft, who must overcome an unfavorable inside draw. "I am sure we'll see his best with the speed on and we are certain to get that on Saturday," said trainer Garry Newham. Winner of the 2400-meter AJC Derby in the autumn, Starcraft resumed to win the G1 Mudgway S. over 1400 meters in New Zealand Aug. 28 and most recently ran third to Mummify (Aus) in the G1 Yalumba S. at Caulfield Oct. 9. Elvstroem, who posted a gallant win in the G1 Caulfield Cup last Saturday, could be set for a Northern Hemisphere campaign next year. "The plan could be that Elvstroem be sent to Dubai for one of the rich staying races...he could then journey to England," said trainer Tony Vasil.

"When I bought him, I had no intention of running him on the turf," winning trainer Charles Simon explained. "His breeder, David Greathouse, told me that his mother only ran on the turf and that we should try him. He is pretty tough. #### Bush Signs Foreign Sales Corp. Bill:

The Foreign Sales Corporation bill was signed into law by President George W. Bush yesterday as he traveled aboard Air Force One. The FSC bill includes a provision that would repeal the 30-percent alien withholding requirements, which will open the door for international common pools. The 30-percent withholding that foreigners had paid on winnings from parimutuel wagers into U.S. pools had effectively prevented the foreign market from participating in common pools. Officials at the National Thoroughbred Racing Association estimate that this bill could mean an increase of as much as \$4.25 billion in handle and \$135 million in commissions for the U.S. racing industry. This year's Breeders' Cup will feature international common pools with Australia, Austria, France, Germany, Ireland, Panama, Peru, South Africa, Switzerland and the United Kingdom. The FSC bill also eliminates tariffs on a variety of exports to the European Union, including horses.

#### **DISREPUTE DECISION DELAYED**
