GLOBETROTTER TOPS INTERNATIONAL FIELD

Born in Ireland, Godolphin's Sulamani (Ire) (Hernando {Fr}) started his career in France, but has traveled far



and wide over the last three seasons. The bay's passport picked up a new stamp when he landed north of the border for today's GI Canadian International S. at Woodbine. The five-vear-old has already accounted for six wins at the International distance of a mile and Michael Burns half, including the G1 Prix du

Jockey-Club at three and the G1

Dubai Sheema Classic and GI Turf Classic at four. He had made four previous starts this year, all in Britain, running third in the July 24 G1 King George VI & Queen Elizabeth S. and most recently posting a 3/4-length victory in the Aug. 17 G1 Juddmonte International S. According to connections, he has settled down comfortably in his new surroundings. "Since he got [to Woodbine], he's done everything we've asked of him," said Godolphin assistant Tony Howarth. "He's eaten well. He seems happy in the shedrow. He has traveled before, so he is a horse that pretty much adapts quickly."

Take Two...

Sulamani isn't the horse in the International field with frequent flyer miles, but Mubtaker (Silver Hawk) has

restricted his travel to Europe. The seven-year-old makes only his 20th career start this afternoon, but he has made the most of his opportunities, hitting the board 18 times and winning no less than nine races. A shock second at 32-1 in the 2003 G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe, the chestnut opened 2004 with a win in the Aug. 14 G2 Geoffrey

Motivator had created quite a stir when opening up six lengths in his debut, a Newmarket maiden Aug. 13, but the dry conditions had kept him in his stall while the major prizes were played out over the summer. He had been training well for his second career start, however. "He's been doing it at home and I'm delighted he got the chance to go through the gears," Michael Bell said. "We've been very careful to protect him from the fast ground, and our patience has been rewarded." Jockey Kieren Fallon reported that Motivator had felt a "bit flat" going to post, but was impressed with him on the way back. "He got there too soon and idled, but it was a big step up and he proved how good he is," he said. "If something had come to him he would have shown more gears, and he's got a great attitude." Michael Bell revealed that the G1 2000 Guineas at Newmarket may be on the agenda before a tilt at the G1 Epsom Derby in June. "He's got plenty of speed and wouldn't be inconvenienced by a mile," Bell said. "He'd be fine on ordinary good ground and he'll be stronger next year." Most bookmakers were offering Motivator at 16-1 for the 2000 Guineas. Prices for the Epsom Derby ranged between 10-1 and 20-1.

Praise for the Also-rans...

Aidan O'Brien was not disappointed by the effort of the runner-up, Albert Hall. "He probably found the ground a bit difficult and is best on good ground, but he's a big rangy horse with scope so he's a horse to look forward to for next year," O'Brien said. Jockey Ted Durcan was even more enthusiastic about thirdplace finisher Henrik. "We're over the moon with him," Durcan told Sporting Life. "He's run a huge race, but the ground has found him out. He's got plenty of speed, but it was blunted by the ground today. He's going to be a smashing horse over a mile on better ground next year."

Earlier this week, ebullient trainer Graeme Rogerson received a call from a potential buyer offering A\$10 million the elegant Savabeel and responded typically, "Which leg do you want?" As Cox Plate fever intensified this week, Rogerson earnestly touted the colt, who was coming off a win in the Oct. 2 G1 Spring Champion S. at 2000 meters, as the best horse he had ever trained. Still, the three-year-old remained a glaring omission from every tipsters' selections. "All the experts said he couldn't win, but he is the best horse in Australia and you won't buy him now for A\$20 million, I'll tell you that much," an emotional Rogerson said. "I knew he could do it, he was running the sectionals in his work. I put my reputation on the line, and maybe I am not such a bad judge." Breaking the Sophomore Jinx...

Aided by a superb ride from Chris Munce, Savabeel became the first three-year-old since another son of Zabeel (NZ), Octagonal (NZ), got the job done in 1995,

and he beat a genuinely worthy field to capture the Southern Hemisphere's weight-for-age showpiece. Savabeel drifted from 8-1 to 14-1 on course as Caulfield Cup victor Elvstroem (Danehill) rapidly assumed favoritism. The sophomore

settled third, some four lengths behind Regal Roller (Regal Classic) and Miss Potential (Dolphin Street {Fr}), but as the field bunched at the home turn, Munce let the long-striding colt go. Fields of Omagh gave his all, powering home from sixth, but under his light weight, Savabeel would not be collared, while the much-hyped Starcraft scrambled out of a pocket to capture third ahead. Munce said he worried that his mount was racing too fiercely early. "He was unbelievable," the rider said. "I thought he was going too hard and decided there was no use both of us pulling. He was a lot keener that I wanted him to be, so we ended up three deep and three off the lead, and with no weight on his back, I wasn't going to wait for them to come. He finds plenty under pressure, and he loves it. There's a lot of depth to him." Savabeel becomes his sire's 29th Group 1 winner. He will make his next start in Saturday's G1 Victoria Derby as he aims to become the first horse in 30 years to do the double. Favored Elvstroem lacked pizazz, settling for sixth from the rear.

Making his turf debut here, Eddington showed newfound determination to earn his first career stakes victory and his first trip to the winner's circle since a Feb. 28 allowance win at Gulfstream. The chestnut had posted a somewhat frustrating series of third-place finishes in major races since then, completing the trifecta in the GI Wood Memorial S., GI Preakness S. and the GI Travers S. In his most recent trip to the post, he came up a neck short as the even-money choice in the GIII Pegasus H. Oct. 1. Jockey Eibar Coa tucked the colt into a ground-saving position, and the duo waited patiently for a seam in the stretch. Eddington kicked on in the final furlong, caught pacesetter Bob's Proud Moment and got his head down on the line. "He deserves to win one of these graded stakes," said winning trainer Mark Hennig. "It opens the door for a lot of opportunities for him. Built Up had won no fewer than nine added-money events entering this test, but had never taken a graded race before gutting out the head victory here over Super Frolic. The six-year-old gelding finished third by a neck to a tough competitor in Champali in the GIII Smile Sprint H. over this strip July 10, but faltered as the 3-5 choice in his next, the Groomstick H. July 31, fading to sixth. Switched to the lawn in the GIII Miami Mile Breeders' Cup H. Sept. 11, he clearly didn't appreciate the rain-softened sod and was eased. A return to the main track saw the bay finish second in the 1 1/16thmile Sumter S. Sept. 26 and he was sent off the second choice to go one better. Rated in fifth under Eibar Coa, Built Up launched his bid leaving the backstretch, surged clear by 2 1/2 lengths two furlongs from home and dug in gamely to stave off the closing Super Frolic. "This horse has had a very good year," said winning conditioner Enrique Alonso. "I think he is getting younger, like his trainer."

Sister Swank had success in stakes company on the main track, running third in the GII Silverbulletday S. at Fair Grounds in February and second in the Sunland Oaks at Sunland Park Mar. 27, but she has excelled since switching surfaces. The chestnut was sent to the bench after her effort in New Mexico, returning to win an Arlington Park allowance in her turf debut Aug. 22. Taking on grassy stakes foes at 25-1 in her latest, she was not disgraced in finishing third behind the talented Ticker Tape (GB). Sister Swank was sent off the second choice while facing a softer field here. She settled off the flank of pacesetter Jinny's Gold through moderate splits over the vielding course and still had 2 1/2 lengths at mid-stretch, but caught the frontrunner late and edged clear. "The ground is getting chewed up, but she handled it pretty well," jockey Pat Day said. "She was slow to find her best stride, but once she leveled off, she found her best gear."

Habaneros was sidelined for 15 months before returning to beat \$25,000 claimers on the dirt at Del Mar July 24. The chestnut gelding added an entry-level allowance score Aug. 29, then moved to the turf and was second by 3/4 of a length in a starter allowance going nine furlongs at Santa Anita Oct. 11. Stretching out while taking on graded-stakes foes off that effort, he was ignored at odds of 14-1, but led from gate to wire, cutting out soft fractions before holding off fellow 14-1 shot Pellegrino in the dying strides. "I knew we were walking," winning jockey David Flores said. "It was just a matter of who was going to move early, but nobody was in a rush so I took my time on him. He loves to run, this horse, and he's very sharp." Continuously (Diesis {GB}), the 13-10 chalk, trailed the field early and had no rally late, beating just one horse home. "The turf was too hard for him, that's all," jockey Corey Nakatani said.

Orcadian made the most of the atrocious conditions to wire this contest and spring a huge surprise. The ground at Newbury had deteriorated markedly as the afternoon wore on and had claimed most of his rivals by the top of the straight, including the returning Asian Heights. Pulling further clear of the struggling field inside the final quarter, he had a lot of daylight on the second horse by the time he had reached the line. Orcadian had split Haafhd (GB) and Milk It Mick (GB) in the Listed Washington Singer S. at this track last August, but had failed to fire this term over much shorter trips. 
