Jockey Stephane Pasquier, chasing his first Group 1 victory, engaged cruise control in mid-division off generous early fractions before moving his mount up to take command with a quarter mile remaining, and Westerner made his way to the historic double-double. "It's wonderful to own such a consistent horse, who is top-class in his category," owner/breeder Alec Wildenstein commented. "We'll enjoy him for one more season, when he'll follow the same program involving the Ascot Gold Cup, Cadran and Royal-Oak."

### GODOLPHIN ACQUIRE SHAMARDAL Shamardal (Giant's Causeway) will race in the royal blue next year as he headed a list of five new acquisitions for Godolphin. Transferred from Mark Johnston's yard, Shamardal, the unbeaten G2 Vintage S. and G1 Dewhurst S. winner and Lucky Story (Kris S)., had been running under the Gainsborough Stud banner. Lucky Story was second in the G1 Queen Elizabeth II S. at Ascot before disappointing when down the field in last Saturday's G1 Champion S. at Newmarket. Godolphin have also transferred the G1 Prix Morny runner-up and G1 Grand Criterium third Layman (Sunday Silence) from Andre Fabre, G3 Solario S. scorer Windsor Knot (Ire) (Pivotal {GB}) from John Gosden and G1 Cheveley Park S. runner-up Suez (GB) (Green Desert) from Michael Jarvis. "We are very pleased to take charge of such talented horses," Racing Manager Simon Crisford said yesterday. "Mark Johnston has done a wonderful job with Shamardal and Lucky Story, and we will be hoping to continue his excellent work."

### Sulamani Wins International (cont. from p1)

Jockey Frankie Dettori briefly found himself behind a wall of horses turning for home aboard Sulamani in yesterday's GI Canadian International. "He's got an explosive turn of foot, but I was concerned at the time," Dettori said of the traffic congestion. "Kieren [Fallon aboard runner-up Simonas] kept me pretty boxed in and when he kicked, he opened the race up for me. I knew with tremendous acceleration, I would get it. Kieren had first run on me. It took three lengths out of me, but I managed to close the gap and go past him pretty easily. [Sulamani's] got a tremendous turn of foot." The traffic didn't worry trainer Saeed bin Suroor. "Sulamani loves to be in behind and the best races he has won, he came from behind," bin Suroor said. "The last two furlongs kept him close and the horse has the speed." With his win in yesterday's Canadian International, Sulamani's earnings surpassed the \$5-million mark. The five-year-old, who has Group 1 victories in France, England, Dubai and the U.S., was coming off a win in the Aug. 17 G1 Juddmonte International S. Of what is next for Sulamani, Godolphin Racing Manager Simon Crisford said, "He's done so well for us. I think now, maybe, is the right time that he'll retire to stud.
