Helios Quercus (Fr) (Diableneyev) found a golden rail and used it to maximum effect to power to a 1½-length win over Dubai Surprise (Ire) (King's Best) in the G1 Criterium International at Saint-Cloud yesterday. The

colt gave the small yard of Cyriaque Diard and virtually unknown rider Alexandre Roussel a dream day when winning the G3 Prix des Chenes at Longchamp Sept. 18, but topped that with a stirring effort in the testing ground here.

Stalking the moderate pace set by the 11-10 pick Early March (Fr) (Dansili {GB}), he was full of run with nowhere to go inside the final quarter, but seized the initiative when the gap opened at the eighth pole and had enough staying power to hold on. "This has to be the greatest moment of my career, "Diard said. "For a small provincial trainer like me, it is hard to be confident taking on the big stables and runners from abroad, but he has worked really well this week and I knew the soft ground would help." GHOSTZAPPER TO RETURN IN 2005

Trainer Bobby Frankel said yesterday that GI Breeders' Cup Classic hero **Ghostzapper** (Awesome Again) will be back next season. "We'll put him away for a while now and bring him back for the Met Mile in the spring," Frankel said. "Then there will be a summer

campaign for him." Added owner Frank Stronach, "He is a very exciting horse and I think I owe it to the racing public to run him next year." But the colt will not be heading overseas to compete. "I will race him in America. I don't plan for any races outside the country," Stronach said. "We won't be

going to Japan or Dubai with him." Will Ghostzapper be the reigning Horse of the Year when he returns in 2005? Frankel believes he should earn the title. "It's a no-brainer," he said, adding, "This horse--you can run him six furlongs or you can run him as far as you want. He'll go head-and-head or he'll come from 20 lengths out of it. And he doesn't carry his racetrack around with him. He's a dream horse and he might well be a super horse."

Seven of Eight to Race Again...

With only Breeders' Cup Sprint winner Speightstown (Gone West) slated for retirement, seven of the eight Breeders' Cup champs will race again in 2005. Trainer Don Chatlos Jr. will bid to take the Mile back-to-back with Singletary (Sultry Song). "We'll probably use the same pattern of races as this year," Chatlos said. "I think the one turn [mile] at Belmont will be to his advantage." The 22nd World Thoroughbred Championships will be held at Belmont Park next Oct. 29.



We think we've maintained a good level of performance all year and we think he's running as well as he ever has. We'll be back to run again next year. We're very careful and take good care of him. He's had some minor foot problems, but that's all."

Not Quite Perfect...

Pleasantly Perfect (Pleasant Colony), who finished third in his Classic title defense, was scheduled to make one more start in the Nov. 27 G1 Japan Cup Dirt, but a minor hind ankle injury may prevent the overseas foray. "He came back a little jarred up behind," trainer Richard Mandella said. "It doesn't look like anything serious, but we'll run him through a scan." The six-year-old shipped back to California yesterday morning.


Eventful Day for Spencer...

Jockey Jamie Spencer relived his Lone Star Park misfortunes after stepping off the plane to ride a double at Leopardstown yesterday. Just beaten into second in the GI Breeders' Cup Mile on Michael Tabor and Susan Magnier's Antonius Pius (Danzig), he offered an explanation for the errant stretch run of the Aidan O'Brientrained sophomore. "I thought when I got the gap turning for home I'd definitely win and he usually goes right, but he copped the chute just before the furlong pole and went left," he said. "The reason he does it is because he's finding everything so easy, but he ran his heart out and by far the best run of his life. Some day, hopefully, I can produce him right on the line with no daylight." As for the GI Breeders' Cup Turf third Powerscourt (GB) (Sadler's Wells), he offered, "He was slow away and I had to take my time for the first circuit and then they steadied right up and he traveled real strong. He had a couple of weeks off after the Irish Champion and it was maybe that and maybe me going a tad too soon, as he emptied inside the final furlong."

Helios Quercus was tackling stakes company for the first time when beating subsequent G3 Prix de Conde winner Musketier (Ger) and G3 Prix Thomas Bryon scorer Vatori (Fr) in the Prix des Chenes last time. That was labeled as a surprise, but he had shown smart form when capturing a conditions event at Deauville Aug. 11, one of four successes at that level this term, and made good on that promise in his first Group 1 attempt. Cyriaque Diard expects even bigger things from the dark bay next season. "We'll put him away now and bring him back with the G1 Prix du Jockey-Club [French Derby] in mind," he said. Making her stakes debut as a 5-1 shot, the Paulsonbred runner settled in fifth as first Fencelineneighbor (Wild Rush) and then Good Student cut out the fractions. The winner had 8 1/2 lengths to make up as they raced past the three-eighths pole and was still three lengths from the front when they hit the final furlong, but finished with determination to post the narrow score and give trainer Bobby Frankel a 1-2 finish. "I waited for the right time to go," winning jockey Rene Douglas said. "I asked her turning for home, because I only had to beat two fillies. I knew my filly would give me a good kick at the end. I timed it perfect and I knew I was going to get up." Added Humberto Ascanio, assistant to Frankel, "We were waiting for [an allowance race] to run her short...and Bobby said, 'no, no, wait,' and finally he said, 'let's step up and see how good she is.'
