BIRDSTONE TO GAINESWAY

Classic winner Birdstone (Grindstone-Dear Birdie, by Proud Birdie), retired after suffering a chip in his left



front ankle, will go to stud at Gainesway Farm in Lexington, it was announced yesterday. The three-yearold will stand as the property of his owner/breeder, Marylou Whitney. "With his tremendous victory over Kentucky Derby and Preakness winner Smarty Jones in the Belmont. Birdstone solidified his status as a great racehorse," said Gainesway President Antony Beck. "We are Birdstone Horsephotos thrilled to add him to the Gainesway roster of stallions." Added Whitney,

"The horse gave us so much pleasure. We are delighted to have him coming home where we can still see him on a regular basis." Birdstone will stand for a fee of \$10,000 in 2005. "We are committed to Birdstone's stallion career long term," Whitney said. "That's why we priced him so attractively."

ONE COOL CAT RETIRED

Two-time Group 1 winner One Cool Cat (Storm Cat--Tacha, by Mr. Prospector) has been retired and will head to Coolmore Stud in Ireland for the 2005 breeding

season, A \$3.1 million KEEJUL yearling, the dark bay colt enjoyed a stellar juvenile season, capped by wins in the G1 National S. and G1 Phoenix S. He added a victory in the G3 Anglesev S. this year, and was rated the top sophomore sprinter after running third in the G1 Nunthorpe S. at York in August.

The three-year-old retires with five wins and a third from 10 career starts for earnings of \$564,798. "We're delighted that One Cool Cat will remain in Ireland, as our American base was also very keen to have him." said Coolmore's Christy Grassick. A stud fee has not yet been set, but Grassick added, "He'll be competitively priced and should prove popular with breeders."

HALFBRIDLED RETIRED

Halfbridled (Unbridled--Half Queen, by Deputy Minister), champion juvenile filly of 2003, has been retired. On the shelf since finishing second in the Apr. 8 GII Beaumont S., the three-year-old had returned to the track and was galloping when she suffered a recurrence of the cannon bone injury that sidelined her in the spring. The Wertheimer homebred was undefeated in four starts at two, taking the GII Oak Leaf S., GI Del Mar Debutante and GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies. She started just twice this year, running second in the GI Santa Anita Oaks and the Beaumont. She earned \$959,400. A 2005 mating has not yet been decided.

SWASHBUCKLER

It may be a juvenile contest, but the G1 Criterium de Saint-Cloud usually separates the men from the boys. Musketier (Ger) (Acatenango {Ger}) should relish this stamina fest today. After taking a conditions event at Deauville Aug. 24, he went down by a short neck to subsequent G1 Criterium International winner Helios Quercus (Fr) in the G3 Prix des Chenes at Longchamp Sept. 18 before recording a convincing six-length success in the G3 Prix de Conde Oct. 17. He re-opposes Vatori (Fr) (Vettori {Ire}), who followed a third in the Prix des Chenes with a hard-fought score in the G3 Prix Thomas Bryon over a mile at this track last time Oct. 7. Trainer Aidan O'Brien, who saddled Ballingarry (Ire) and Alberto Giacometti (Ire) to win in 2001 and 2002, is represented by Yehudi (Ire) (Sadler's Wells), who went gate to wire to win Sunday's Listed Eyrefield S.



High winds could help dry out the grass course, but there is still likely to be some give in the ground at Aqueduct this afternoon. That's good news for Eleusis, who makes her U.S. debut in the 12-furlong test. Experienced on soft turf, the three-year-old filly has been beaten just once and ended her European campaign with her fourth consecutive victory in the Oct. 1 Prix Joubert at Chantilly. She is a perfect two-for-two at the Long Island distance. The morning-line favorite, Arvada, is a question mark both for the condition of the track and the trip. Third in the G1 Prix Saint-Alary at three, the bay four-year-old was off the board in four straight at the end of her sophomore season and was sent to the States. She kicked off her American stint with a fourth at Santa Anita in March, then lost out on two photos when second at Hollywood in April and at Belmont in June. The British-bred earned her first U.S. score in a Saratoga allowance test Aug. 11 and made it two in a row with a front-running tally over Spice Island and subsequent GI Breeders' Cup F/M Turf runner-up Film Maker in the second division of the Sept. 5 GIII Glens Falls H. But that effort did not earn her a trip to Lone Star. "I didn't think she was good enough to run with the best fillies and mares," trainer Bobby Frankel explained. "Even though she beat Film Maker, she was getting a lot of weight from her." Second in her only other try at 12 panels, Savedbythelight set the pace in the first division of the Glens Falls before tiring to third.

BATES MOTEL DEAD Bates Motel (Sir Ivor), the champion older horse of 1983 after winning the GI Santa Anita H., GI Monmouth H. and GI San Antonio H., was euthanized Oct. 12 at Gainesway Farm in Lexington due to the infirmities of old age. He was 25. Bred and raced by Jacqueline Getty Phillips, the bay won nine of 19 starts and earned \$851,050. He entered stud at Gainesway in 1984 and sired 38 stakes winners, including Private School, Rare Blend and Canadian Classic winner Blondeinamotel. His progeny have earned more than \$24 million. Bates Motel was pensioned in August of 2003. "[Bates Motel] was a fixture at Gainesway for more than 20 years and we are saddened by the loss of this great champion," said Gainesway President Antony Beck.

GIANT'S CAUSEWAY FULL BRO TO WALMAC

Tumblebrutus (Storm Cat--Mariah's Storm, by Rahy), a full brother to second-leading freshman sire Giant's Causeway, will stand his first season in 2005 at Walmac Stud Management LLC in Lexington. 
