

SURGERY FOR KITTEN'S JOY

Ken and Sarah Ramsey's **Kitten's Joy** (El Prado {Ire}), the leading candidate for champion turf horse, had surgery Wednesday morning to remove a chip from his left knee. Dr. Larry Bramlage performed the surgery at the Rood and Riddle clinic in Lexington, Kentucky. "Dr. Bramlage said the chip is in the right kind of spot and the long-term prognosis is excellent," trainer Dale Romans told DRF. The three-year-old is scheduled to be out of training for 90 days; Romans expects him to join his string at Palm Meadows in February. A multiple Grade I winner this term, the colt ran second as the odds-on chalk in his most recent start, the GI Breeders' Cup Turf at Lone Star Park Oct. 30.

A TREASURE AT KEENELAND

The first of a pair mares in Book Two consigned by Craig and Holly Bandoroff's Denali Stud on behalf of Bob and Beverly Lewis brought a session-topping bid of \$600,000 during yesterday's action at Keeneland. John and Martha Jane Mulholland were the successful bidders on hip 1158, the four-year-old filly **Beautiful Treasure** (Unbridled), carrying a foal by the Lewises champion sprinter Orientate. A \$500,000 Keeneland July yearling purchase, the chestnut was second in the 2002 Astoria S. at Belmont Park. "We had to pay a little more than we wanted to," Martha Jane Mulholland admitted. "She's one of the more expensive mares that we've ever purchased. As an individual, she was one of the nicest horses we saw at the sale. She was a gorgeous individual from a lovely family and her two-year-old race record was really what encouraged us to keep going. There's not too many Unbridled mares left, and we think Orientate is an awfully nice horse, so it should be a magnificent cross." The Mulhollands, who breed to sell, consign yearlings under the banner of Mulholland Springs. The couple have transacted profitably in the past with the Lewises at Keeneland, selling yearlings to them at the 2003 September sale for \$1.4 million and \$700,000. Martha Jane Mulholland said she and her husband are considering several possible mates for the mare in 2005, including Fusaichi Pegasus.

Fresh off the Presses...

If Dr. Philip McCarthy was in the mood to spend yesterday at Keeneland, it's certainly understandable. The morning after he and his partner Fred Hertrich sold Helsinki (GB) for \$3.9 million and her weanling daughter by Unbridled's Song for \$1.15 million, McCarthy signed the winning ticket at \$200,000 for hip [1072](#). Consigned by Knockgriffin Farm (Jim FitzGerald), agent, the bay filly is a daughter of El Prado (Ire)--Smooth Swinger (by Kris S.). She is a full sister to Senor Swinger, winner in his most recent appearance of the GII Belmont Breeders' Cup H. "She was a lovely filly, wasn't she," said McCarthy. "She's a full sister to a nice horse. We thought she was worthwhile and you never know. She's got a lovely pedigree, it's a pedigree full of runners and we want to try to accumulate fillies and mares like that." The Mar. 31 foal will be taken to McCarthy and Hertrich's Watercress Farm near Paris, Kentucky, where she will be raised and eventually raced by the duo. Asked how he was feeling the day after Wednesday's fireworks, McCarthy simply said, "Relieved," adding, "[Helsinki] was a lovely mare, beautiful pedigree, lovely foal...we just got lucky and that's what happens in the horse business. She's a rare gem, the people that bought her are fortunate to have her. But, the way I look at it is that we can't operate at that end of the market. The values are just too great for us." McCarthy indicated that serious consideration was given to holding on to the foal, but that despite the obvious appeal of the filly, a decision in the best interests of the farm needed to be made. "We really don't feel there's going to be another opportunity to be involved in that family," he explained. "Most of the family is owned by Sheikh Mohammed and now the mare, and I don't think there will be many opportunities to get back into that family. We feel blessed that things went our way, but we really couldn't afford to keep a mare like that, and the same thing goes for the filly. It's the highest price for a weanling sold this year and that's pretty good business."

School of Hard Knocks...

A colt by Mr. Greeley, deemed by one bloodstock agent as "Little Secretariat" because of his chestnut color and four white socks, attracted a final bid of \$440,000, topping the session's weanling offerings. Foaled, raised and consigned by Knockgriffin Farm (Jim FitzGerald), the Mar. 12 foal was produced by the 21-year-old mare **Hard Knocker** (Raja Baba) and was knocked down to Eldon Farm Equine of Keswick, Virginia. Debbie Easter, representing the farm, was pleased with the purchase. "He was just a gorgeous colt and he looks like a runner," she commented. "You've got to like the pedigree. It was as good as anything else that was in here [Thursday]." The colt is a three-parts sibling to Chimichurri, one of the best representatives from the first crop of Elusive Quality, who won the GIII Tempted S. at two and was second in the GI Prioress S. at three. He is also a half brother to Huambo (Green Dancer), a Listed stakes winner in Germany. FitzGerald, who bred the aforementioned Chimichurri, was equally high on the colt, which he co-bred with the Manganaro family. "He's just one of those picture perfect horses," he said. "He had a big, beautiful athletic walk. He was the real deal. There's real pleasure in raising a horse like that because they don't come around that often, so you appreciate when they do." FitzGerald indicated that Hard Knocker is likely to be bred to Mr. Greeley again in 2005.

As Clear as Day...

Peter O'Callaghan, acting on behalf of a pinhooking partnership, went to \$330,000 for hip 1218, the second top priced weanling of the afternoon. The bay colt, consigned by Hidden Brook, agent, is a son of Dayclear (A.P. Indy), herself a daughter of Nine Keys (Forty Niner), winner of the GI Apple Blossom H. "He was a very nice colt and a very good horse for this day," commented Sergio de Sousa, manager of Hidden Brook Farm. "There was a lot of interest in him and everything worked out. A client of mine from Brazil, Mr. Anderson, bought the mare carrying [this foal]...we're going to go for a little samba tonight." Dayclear was purchased for \$140,000 at last year's November sale. She has an unraced two-year-old of this year by Out of Place and is currently in foal to Lemon Drop Kid. De Sousa expected a good performance from his colt, but perhaps not this good. "We felt that he'd make 200 [thousand], but I didn't know he was going to make 330," he said. "He was a nice horse and sometimes you get lucky."

Middle of the Road...

Overall, the November Sale continued to carve out marked increases, while yesterday's fourth session ended with only a modest rise. "I think this was kind of a readjustment day," explained Geoff Russell. "I think the RNA rate went up more than anticipated [yesterday]. [Thursday] was a slight blip on the radar. The middle market is the strength of this sale. What we were missing today was very simple--Jess Jackson wasn't sitting in that corner. They bought 89 horses for the first three days and didn't buy any today. He's had a major influence on the sale."

Aug. 7, has completed his 2004 campaign and will not run in the Nov. 26 G1 Clark H. at Churchill Downs. "He ran his eyeballs out and I'm afraid that we emptied him out," said Ramsey, referring to the four-year-old's latest start, a second-place finish in the G1 Breeders' Cup Classic Oct. 30 at Lone Star. "We're doing what is best for the horse. We're going to freshen him up." According to Ramsey, Roses in May will be sent to Palm Meadows Training Center over the winter and will be aimed for the Feb. 5 G1 Donn H. at Gulfstream Park before a tilt at the G1 Dubai World Cup at Nad al Sheba Mar. 26.
