was about as close to perfect as you can get," commented Duncan Taylor. "He was well-balanced, had a great hip and shoulder, and that's what everybody is looking for." Taylor indicated that the horse had been out of his stall "about 80 times" and was seen multiple times by several would-be buyers. The winning bidder was listed as Athens Woods (Donovan Bradshaw). A representative for the operation indicated that the purchase was for a group of pinhookers who wished to remain anonymous. The afternoon was characterized by spirited bidding, especially for foals by first-crop stallions. "There are still a lot of people here," Taylor remarked. Gran Senorita is the dam of Gilded Gold (Gilded Time), a three-year-old filly who was second in the Polly's Jet S. at Delaware Park prior to winning an Arlington allowance Sept. 3. Under the second dam, Dr. Kashnikow (El Gran Senor) has added a victory in the Oct. 15 GIII Cliff Hanger H. at the Meadowlands since the catalogue. 

Lewis Dispersal Proves Profitable...

The decision by Bob and Beverly Lewis to disperse the bulk of their breeding stock at Keeneland not only provided a financial windfall for the sales company, but also gave the bidding public a rare opportunity to buy into some very fashionable pedigrees. The portion of the Lewis dispersal handled by Craig and Holly Bandoroff's Denali Stud realized gross receipts of over \$11 million for eight horses sold. Miraloma was withdrawn from the sale. John Moynihan, who has served the Lewises for many years as bloodstock advisor, explained their approach to the sales. "When we go in, we try to buy great looking yearlings," he commented. "It shows that it pays off, at least a little bit. When you buy that great looking horse, these commercial breeders come back and want that kind of quality and we've been rewarded by that." Moynihan was reluctant to accept undue credit for the success at Keeneland and hastened to point out that it was more the fruits of a team effort. "Whether it's me, Bob Baffert or Wayne Lukas, all three of us put the most emphasis on conformation," he said. "Then when you bring pedigree into it, Santa Catarina, for example, obviously she's going to cost more. Fortunately, she also carried over her quality to the races and it worked out well." According to Moynihan, the stars aligned at this sale. "We're very pleased," he said. "It looks like we caught a good market. This is probably the best market I've seen in the short term. There's a lot of enthusiasm here. There are people buying mares, there's people that are upgrading their programs, and I think a lot of that came together at this sale and boosted everything." A smaller draft of Lewis foals will be sold in the remaining books.

A native of South Florida, the 32-year-old horsewoman grew up on the Calder backstretch, where her mother trained horses. She took out her jockey's license in 1992 and earned the Eclipse Award as the country's top apprentice that year. She led the standings at Hialeah in 2001 and made it to Churchill Downs on the first Saturday in May, piloting Supah Blitz in the 2003 Kentucky Derby. She retires with 1,726 career victories. "I made the decision this summer to retire at the end of the Tropical Park meet," Homeister said. "Then a lot of things started happening at one time and I started thinking more about my future. I want to start a family." Married to jockey Jose Ferrer, Homeister took her realtor's test in March and will now embark on a new career as a real estate agent.

Chief Steward Gary Wilfert met with the jockeys to inform them of this decision and to ask them to vacate the premises, but 10 riders refused to leave and had to be escorted off the track by the local police. Also ejected was Albert Fiss, vice president of the Jockey's Guild. He and regional rep Darrell Haire were in the jocks' room Friday, and Hoosier Park President Rick Moore stated that he felt it was the visit by the Guild members, and not a problem with the inner rail, that was behind the jockeys' refusal to ride. "We believe the presence of Albert Fiss and Darrell Haire in our jockeys' quarters [Friday] evening points to the real reason that jockeys elected not to ride," Moore said. "The Guild has publicly supported the actions of Kentucky-based jockeys who refused to accept mounts earlier this week at Churchill Downs. Based on Friday's events, we have reason to believe that jockeys were encouraged by Guild representatives, and refused to ride at the direction of the Guild." More than a dozen riders were banned for the remainder of the Churchill meet after a protest over medical insurance, but there have been enough jockeys willing to ride that there have been no cancellations at that track. Hoosier was also able to field enough riders to get back in action last night.
