



AIN'T HERE TAKES CUP TRIAL

Ain't Here (Aus) (Dehere), always travelling well beneath jockey Brett Prebble, stormed down the center of the Sha Tin stretch to win yesterday's HK\$3 million G2 International Cup Trial by a deceptively easy 1 1/4 lengths. Settled in fourth in the 2000-meter event, Ain't Here responded when set down leaving the quarter pole, hit the front with a furlong to run and stayed on well to defeat Bowman's Crossing (Ire) (Dolphin Street {Fr}). Bullish Luck (Royal Academy), the 2-1 favorite in the wagering, nosed out High Intelligent (Aus) (Anabaa) for third money. Five-year-old Ain't Here, third in the 2002 G1 Victoria Derby and in the G1 Hong Kong Derby this past March, lost his first 13 starts in the SAR before snapping that streak with a neck victory over Bowman's Crossing in the G3 Sha Tin Trophy H. Oct. 17. He was in receipt of 11 pounds from the runner-up that afternoon, but vesterday's Cup Trial was run at level weights. Trainer David Hayes, who was winning this for the fourth time in the last six years, will decide in the coming days whether to run his charge in the G1 Hong Kong Cup over 2000 meters or the 2400-meter G1 Hong Kong Vase. Both races are to be contested Dec. 12.
