Red Ransom is also responsible for Lot 176, a filly out of Gaye's Express (Timeless Native) who was an \$85,000 Keeneland RNA in September. Pine Bluff has a rare European representative in Lot 183, a colt out of Viva Maria (GB) (Hernando {Fr}) bred by Kirsten Rausing and consigned from her Irish stud, Staffordstown. #### WEIGHT COULD ALTER AZERI'S PLANS Azeri

(Jade Hunter)'s particpation in Thursday's GII Falls City H. at Churchill Downs has been cast in doubt by her 126-pound impost in the 1 1/8-miles race. Trainer D. Wayne Lukas said a final decision on a possible Falls City start for the champion would be left to owner Michael Paulson. Azeri has breezed once since finishing fifth in the Breeders' Cup Classic, going a half mile in :47.60 on Nov. 9. "She doesn't need much," Lukas explained. "That last race was a very good one." Should she bypass the Falls City, Azeri would ship back to California and would likely get the rest of the year off. Another Falls City contender, **Indy Groove** (A.P. Indy), worked five furlongs Sunday at Churchill in 1:02.


