A One-Turn Specialist...

Lion Tamer kicked off the year with three consecutive wins at his preferred seven furlongs, including the Mar. 6 GII Richter Scale Breeders' Cup H. at Gulfstream Park and the GII Commonwealth Breeders' Cup S. at Keeneland Apr. 10, but faltered to be fifth in the one-mile GIII Westchester H. at Belmont May 5. Fourth behind Ghostzapper in the GII Tom Fool H. at Belmont on Independence Day, the diminutive chestnut took the Formal Gold S. going two turns at Monmouth Sept. 11 then was eighth to stablemate Balto Star in the GII Meadowlands Breeders' Cup S. Oct. 8, but bounced back to finish a strong second in this track's GIII Sport Page H. Oct. 31. "I really didn't plan on going here with him, but he ran so well in the Sport Page...we decided to take a shot," Pletcher explained.

Eclipsing Pico Central...

Pico Central arrived in the Big Apple earlier this week looking to become the first horse since In Excess (Ire) in 1991 to win four Grade I races in New York. He was also seeking to enhance his Eclipse Award credentials, but weakened in the drive to be third after setting a very demanding pace for the opening six furlongs. "With the rail, there is no option," said trainer Paolo Lobo of the inside draw. "We talked before the race about trying to leave one or two horses in front of him, but from there, it was impossible." Lobo also explained that Pico Central lost his right hind shoe during the running of the race, and, despite yesterday's results, he thinks his charge has done enough to be named champion. "Pico won the [GI] Vosburgh, [GI] Carter and [GI] Met Mile," he commented. "He ran the first three-quarters of the Carter in less than 1:08 [1:07 2/5]. Now, we'll have to wait until January." He added, "We have no plans with him right now, but he will run next year."

Fourth in a Santa Anita down-the-hiller Jan. 7, the chestnut kicked off his winning skein with a 2 1/2length victory going a mile in Arcadia Jan. 31. He repeated over that course and distance Mar. 20 then set a track record of 1:38 2/5 in winning the 8 1/2-furlong GIII Inglewood H. May 1. Off nearly six months following that event, the TNT Stud runner charged from off the pace to win the GIII Morvich H. down the hill Oct. 30 and was the second choice to complete the fivebagger. Well placed along the inside and never far from the front, Leroidesanimaux advanced between rivals leaving the far turn, took command once into the stretch, drew clear and held on to defeat Cal Cup Mile winner A to the Z. Three Valleys, last for the opening six furlongs, was steered off the rail at midstretch and ran on well for third.

TATTERSALLS UPBEAT DESPITE DROPS The numbers from this year's Tattersalls' December Foal Sale were down across the board, but the market held up remarkably well following the autumn yearling sales. An upbeat Tattersalls Chairman Edmond Mahony commented, "There was a measure of uncertainty coming into the December Foal Sale, but we had a successful yearling sale on Monday and the foal trade has been robust throughout the four days. As with so many sales this year, we felt that the spectacular levels of 2003 would be very difficult to match, and in that context we could not be disappointed after returning figures second only to last year's foal sale." The four-day Foal Sale ended yesterday after posting a turnover of 18,270,000gns, which was down by 14 percent on 2003. The average of 26,482gns dropped by eight percent and the median of 14,500gns was 15 percent lower than 12 months ago. But the figures didn't tell the whole story. "From the outset, vendors have reported no shortage of interest from buyers at all levels of the market and this is borne out by a clearance rate, which compares favourably with last year, and a record number of six-figure transactions," Mahony said. "In addition, the number of foals selling for 50,000gns or more has only been bettered once." After a one-day hiatus, the December breeding stock sale begins Monday morning. "Looking ahead to next week, we have a good solid catalogue which has already engendered considerable interest from throughout the world," Mahony continued. "Unlike last year, we do not have any high-profile dispersals, but there is strength in depth which has always been the crucial ingredient for a successful breeding-stock sale." As was the case Friday, a pair of Danehills led the way at yesterday's final foal session, with Demi O'Byrne going to 180,000gns to get the day's topper, a filly from the Churchtown House Stud draft. The foal's dam is the unraced Band Of Angels (Ire) (Alzao), herself a halfsister to Epsom Derby winner Dr Devious (Ire) and champion sprinter Archway (Ire). A Danehill three-parts sister to G1 July Cup winner Owington (GB) (Green Desert) from the Gaines-Gentry Thoroughbreds offering was the second-highest seller yesterday, bringing 165,000gns from Barbara Facchino's Barouche Stud, with farm manager Rory Matthews doing the bidding. "She was a really sporty-looking foal and there are very few Danehill fillies on the market," said Matthews, who added, "She was bought for racing and we have three or four different trainers, so it's too early to say where she might be heading."
