#### INTERCONTINENTAL DOMINATES MATRIARCH

Heading into Sunday's GI Matriarch, Grade I winners Musical Chimes (In Excess {Ire}) and Ticker Tape (Royal Applause {Ire}) appeared to have a chance to move into the forefront of the filly and mare turf division with a victory, but it was the Juddmonte home-bred Intercontinental (Danehill) who stole the show with a convinc-

ing 2 1/2-length score. A winner of her first three starts in the U.S., including the GIII Jenny Wiley S. at Keeneland in April and the GII Just A Game Breeders' Cup H. at Belmont Park June 5, the Bobby Frankel trainee showed her dislike for the soft going and had to settle for fifth in the nine-furlong GI Diana H. at Saratoga July 31. The full sister

to champions Banks Hill (GB) and Dansili (GB) rebounded to finish a much improved second, beaten only a half length, in her latest in the GIII Senator K. Maddy H. at Santa Anita Sept. 29 and was given a 9-2 chance to collect her first Grade I victory this time. The filly built up a head of steam in the early going of this mile contest, but jockey Jerry Bailey was able to get the filly to relax down the backside. Placed into contention turning for home, Intercontinental powered to the front in the final sixteenth and drew off late to account for stablemate Etoile Montante (Miswaki). "I was able to get a good position on the first turn, which is crucial in a mile race," explained Bailey. "She did get a bit rank around the first turn, but by the time I was headed up the backstretch, I was where I wanted to be. At that point, I thought it was just a question of when I had a chance to let her run." Trainer Bobby Frankel, who was responsible for the top two finishers, became the first trainer to saddle more than two winners in one year during Hollywood Park's Turf Festival. Among his four victories were Cajun Beat, winner of Friday's Hollywood Turf Express H. and Leroidesanimaux, who scored in Saturday's Citation H. As for his latest winner, Frankel said, "We wanted to get a Grade I for this filly, because the whole family is Grade I winners." #### ZENNO ROB ROY WINS JAPAN CUP

Favored **Zenno Rob Roy (Jpn)** (Sunday Silence)

forged to the front in midstretch and pulled clear down the lane to score a confident three-length victory in yesterday's G1 Japan Cup in Tokyo. It was the second straight win for the four-year-old colt, who captured the G1 (JRA) Tenno Sho Autumn last month. Yesterday's 16-horse field was strung out in a line down the backstretch, with pacesetting Magnaten (Danzig) in front by as many as five lengths. Traveling in eighth position, jockey Olivier Peslier steered Zenno Rob Roy to the outside on the final bend and overtook Cosmo Bulk (Jpn) (Zagreb) with 200 meters to run to win going away. "I'm happy

to win the Japan Cup after running third twice with Symboli Kris S.," said winning trainer Kazuo Fujisawa. "Zenno Rob Roy has become a much tougher horse over the last year and he trained well after winning the Tenno Sho Autumn. Watching him today, he looked calm and bold, so I had high expectations for today's race." European invaders Powerscourt (GB) (Sadler's Wells) and Warrsan (Ire) (Caerleon) never threatened and finished 10th and 15th, respectively. For a video replay: modem or broadband. ### GOOD REWARDS AT HOLLYWOOD

It had been 15 years since trainer Shug McGaughey started a horse in California, but his extended absence from the West Coast scene didn't deter him from sending Good Reward (Storm Cat) in for Sunday's GI Hollywood Derby. McGaughey, whose most recent West Coast victory was recorded by Lass Trump in the 1984 A Gleam H., was well represented this time with the impeccably-bred colt, but the crowd was unconvinced and let him go at generous 16-1 odds. Unhurried early, the bay came from off the pace to take home the lion's share of the \$500,000 event and establish a stakes record for 10 furlongs over Hollywood's Turf course. (cont. p2)

### Good Showing for Ticker Tape

One of only two sophomores in this year's Matriarch, Ticker Tape (Royal Applause {GB}) probably needed a victory to secure year-end championship honors, but according to trainer James Cassidy, the bay filly gave a good account of herself. "I thought we were second. I still don't believe the photo," he said. "She didn't have a great trip. She was a bit too far back I thought; I told [Victor Espinoza] to stay a little closer...If they didn't fan so wide, they would have been OK, but she had to go inside and outside and around." Despite the finish, Cassidy remained optimistic, "First time against older horses, it looks like she fits."

Looking to make it two for two this time, Good Reward made it to the front first, but had to survive a steward's inquiryto gain his first Grade I victory. "As for the inquiry it was Desormeaux's horse [Imperialism] who initiated the contact with me," explained jockey Jerry Bailey. "It was nothing we initiated." Explaining the colt's long odds, he said, "His numbers were better than some, maybe not as good as a couple of others, but you have to depend on the guy your are riding for. Time Paradox settled in 11th along the inner rail down the backstretch, angled in between horses on the final turn and charged to the front in the final furlong en route to an authoritative victory. "When I won the Japan Cup with Kurofune, I had every confidence in winning the race because he was a proven winner, but I can't say the same for Time Paradox," admitted jockey Yutaka Take, who was winning his second Japan Cup Dirt. "So I was thrilled by the unexpected win." As for his race tactics, Take said, "I concentrated on keeping him relaxed in the first half of the race and waited for the right time to move. Everything worked to our advantage and he was able to keep with the pace and he really held well after taking the lead." Winning trainer Hiroyoshi Matsuda added, "Time Paradox has gotten tougher with age and seems to have room for improvement, even at six." American challenger Total Impact (Chi) (Stuka) settled in a stalking fifth and surged to the front in the stretch, but couldn't hold on and finished fourth. "The pace was a bit fast in the early stages, but we were well positioned and he gave his best," jockey Mike Smith said of the second favorite. "The winner was just awesome." Thunder Touch started his career with a maiden win over the Aqueduct inner track in January, but went to the shelf after running sixth in a Gulfstream allowance test in February. The chestnut returned to finished second in a Belmont allowance June 5, but was DQ'ed and placed fifth. After rebounding to win his next start July 9, the Stronach homebred picked up checks in a pair before adding yet another allowance score at Belmont Oct. 14. Making his stakes debut as a 6-1 shot, Thunder Touch tucked in just off the pace as Uncle Camie (Abaginone) tried to steal the race. The frontrunner still had three on the field at the eighth pole, but the rapid pace took its toll and Thunder Touch rolled on past to win going away. "He's a very nice horse," trainer Kiaran McLaughlin said. "We've always liked him a lot. Everything set up well for us and the jockey [Rafael Bejarano] rode a great race. It worked out great." Added Bejarano, "I was on the best horse." Medallist (Touch Gold), the 2-1 favorite in his first start since running seventh in the Aug. 28 GI King's Bishop S. at Saratoga, made a middle move, but flattened out late to be fifth. "He couldn't keep up," jockey Jose Santos said. "I got no response."

Miss Grindstone started a three-race winning streak in an optional claimer at Woodbine Aug. 6, was haltered for \$50,000 after scoring Sept. 30 and changed hands once again, this time for \$80,000, after a onelength tally Oct. 11. The skein was snapped when the dark bay mare finished fourth in the Nov. 6 Ontario Fashion S., but she started a new one with a decisive triumph here. Normally a horse that does her best running from off the pace, Miss Grindstone changed tactics, taking the lead soon after the start and dashing through a half in :45 and six furlongs in 1:09 3/5. She had a length on favored El Prado Essence at the eighth pole and extended that advantage to the wire to win handily. "She broke great, she was comfortable where she was and she kicked on when she needed to," winning jockey Ray Sabourin said. "[Trainer Frank Passero] said she'd be in tip-top shape and when she turned turned the corner, she went on with it."




