Kela (Numerous) had to skip last Saturday's GI Cigar Mile after developing a fever, but he recovered quickly

and looms the one to beat in the GIII Vernon O. Underwood S. at Hollywood Park this afternoon. The sixyear-old, winner of the GI Bing Crosby Breeders' Cup H. and GII Pat O'Brien Breeders' Cup H. at Del Mar, closed well to be second in the Oct. 30 GI Breeders' Cup Sprint. Shipped to Aqueduct for the Nov. 27 Cigar, he flew home Tuesday with nothing to show for the cross-country trip. But, none the worse for the wear, the bay was supplemented to the

Underwood. "It was a call I made," trainer Mike Mitchell said. "I could look like a genius, or I could look like an idiot." Kela has been first or second in five of seven starts at Hollywood. **Our New Recruit** (Alphabet Soup) has a win and three seconds from his four tries on the Inglewood oval. Second to Watchem Smokey (Alphabet Soup) in this event a year ago, the chestnut opened 2004 with a third in the GII Palos Verdes H. at Santa Anita, then shipped to Nad al Sheba to capture the Mar. 27 G1 Dubai Golden Shaheen. The five-year-old took a well-deserved vacation after that effort, returning to win the Sept. 6 Pirate's Bounty H. at Del Mar, but he has to rebound after running 12th after a rough trip in the Breeders' Cup Sprint. "It wasn't his day," trainer John Sadler said. "Another horse jetted out in front of him, and dirt hit him in the face hard. He lost his action and it was all downhill from there."

Pellegrino was close to Group 1 success in 2002, finishing second by a neck in the Gran Premio Jockey Club, second again in the Argentine Derby and third in the Gran Premio Carlos Pellegrini. He made just one appearance in 2003, finishing fourth in another Group 1 in February, then disappeared for 11 months. Joining the stable of trainer Donald Burke during his break, he was not pressed to climb the ladder too quickly, earning his first American score in his fourth try, a Hollywood allowance May 2. The Gary Tanaka colorbearer picked up another win in an optional claimer two starts later, then stepped up to the stakes ranks and ran fourth in the Aug. 4 Escondido H. at Del Mar. Freshened after that effort, he returned to be a fast-closing second in the Oct. 23 GIII Carleton F. Burke H. and was primed for his second start back. "Don Burke did a great job with this horse," winning jockey Gary Stevens said. "His feet were stinging him in his last race and he still ran great. Don told me I was riding a different horse [yesterday], and he was right."

Better Days Ahead?

Sent off the even-money favorite, GI Breeders' Cup Turf hero **Better Talk Now** (Talkin Man) was hard-held while sitting off the early pace. He pulled his way to the front with a quarter mile to race, but weakened while drifting in deep stretch and finished sixth.

BODEGUITA TOPS DEAUVILLE OPENER They saved the best for nearly last at the opening session of Agence Francaise's December Mixed Sale at Deauville yesterday. The day's topper, who entered the ring with just six left to sell, was the two-year-old Bodeguita (Fr) (Cape Cross {Ire}), from the consignment of Haras d'Ommeel. Secured by Pegasus Farms for €280,000, the winner of a fillies-only conditions race at Saint-Cloud Oct. 26 is out of the Red Ransom mare Red Bravo, a half sister to G3 Gordon S. winner St Mawes (Fr). There were a number of fillies offered by His Highness the Aga Khan, the most popular of which proved to be three-year-old Behlaya (Ire) (Kahyasi {Ire}). The half sister to G2 Prix Hubert de Chaudenay winner Behkara (Ire) was bought by Emerald Bloodstock for €185,000, the second highest price of the opening session. Helped by a healthy clearance rate of nearly 80 percent, the session aggregate advanced almost seven percent to €3,882,500. The average also saw an upturn, rising 16 percent to €24,266.

KEEP AUCTION RAISES \$2.3 MILLION The live auction of stallion seasons to benefit the Kentucky Equine Education Project, held Friday night at the Hyatt Regency Hotel in Lexington, raised \$2,309,300, The Blood-Horse reports. The one-mile GII San Rafael S., run last year on Big 'Cap Day, has been moved to Jan. 15. It will be followed by the Mar. 5 GII Santa Catalina S. and the Mar. 19 GII San Felipe S., both at a mile and a sixteenth. The \$750,000 GI Santa Anita Derby at nine furlongs is set for Apr. 9. The track will also offer the \$100,000 Sham S. at a mile and an eighth Feb. 5 and the GII San Vicente S. going seven furlongs Feb. 13. "What we're trying to do is have different starting spots for horses who are already ready to go," explained Santa Anita Racing Secretary Rick Hammerle. "The [trainers] who don't quite know what they have can progress through the distances. And the races are spaced a little better now."


