### “RAK” SOLID AT SHA TIN

The temperamental **Rakti (GB)** (Polish Precedent) pleased his connections with a composed gallop over the Sha Tin training track Friday morning and is on course for the G1 Cathay Pacific Hong Kong Cup this afternoon. “He’s much more relaxed today, thankfully,” trainer Michael Jarvis said. “He’s like that. He can be a completely different horse from one day to the next.” The five-year-old was on his best behavior for the 2003 edition of the Cup, running second in the 2000-meter test. He opened 2004 with a victory over **Powerscourt (GB)** (Sadler’s Wells) in the G1 Prince of Wales’s S. going that route at Royal Ascot, but finished off the board in both the G1 Eclipse S. in July and the G1 Irish Champion S. in September. The bay rebounded when dropped back to 1600 meters for the Sept. 25 G1 Queen Elizabeth II S., but ran 14th after a very slow start in the Nov. 21 G1 Mile Championship. “Once in the stalls, he falls asleep,” owner Gary Tanaka said. “He leans on the side and he can often miss the break, sometimes badly like he did last time. Once he missed the start, [jockey Philip Robinson] knew the game was up and didn’t go too hard on him at the end.” Tanaka added, “I’m told he came out of the race fine and I’m expecting another big, big run in Hong Kong. He has proven that he likes the track and he is definitely best when going right-handed, so I’m pretty hopeful.”

### Good As Gold...

A trio of three-year-old fillies will challenge for top honors in the Cup. **Alexander Goldrun (Ire)** (Gold Away {Ire}), with six wins and four seconds from 14 starts, returned from a three-month layoff to take the Oct. 3 G1 Prix de l’Opera at this trip. She will be joined in the gate by **Lattice (Ire)** (Inchior {GB}), winner of the G1 Prix de Diane and beaten about four lengths when seventh in the G1 Prix de l’Arc de Triomphe; and **Dance in the Mood (Jpn)** (Sunday Silence), who was second in the G1 American Oaks and G1 Tenno Sho Autumn, both at 2000 meters, and runner-up again in the Nov. 21 G1 Mile Championship at Kyoto. *Hong Kong Intl’l cont, p2-4*

### HAPPY VALLEE SHOOTS FOR VASE REPEAT

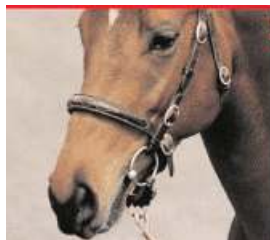
The connections of Ecurie Wildenstein’s **Vallee Enchantee (Ire)** (Peintre Celebre) hope that history repeats itself as their colorbearer goes postward in defense of her title in this afternoon’s G1 Cathay Pacific Hong Kong Vase. A 3/4-length winner from **Polish Summer (GB)** (Polish Precedent) and **Warrsan (Ire)** (Caerleon) a year ago, the pint-sized filly has yet to win in four tries this term, but comes off a respectable sixth in the G1 Prix de l’Arc de Triomphe, going down by just four lengths to Bago (Fr). “I’m very happy with her, no problems, thankfully,” said trainer Elie Lellouche. “This has been her end-of-year target all along. We know she likes the track and the ground here, so I’m hopeful she’ll go well again.” The four-year-old will make a fashion statement in today’s race. Lellouche has been granted special permission by the Hong Kong Jockey Club to equip Vallee Enchantee with a noseband with leather tassels. The equipment reportedly helps to keep her from throwing her head while racing. *Vase cont. p2*

### HERE COMES THE JUDGE

**Truly a Judge (Judge TC)**, who once toiled in the claiming ranks, yesterday became a graded-stakes winner with a front-running victory in the GIII Native Diver H. at Hollywood Park. The six-year-old raced for as little as \$16,000 in 2001 and changed hands no less than three times, finally landing in the barn of trainer David Bernstein after beating \$20,000 claimers in October that year. Under new management, the dark bay climbed through his allowance conditions and earned a Philly Park stakes score in 2002. He took an optional claimer and placed in four stakes last season, including two graded events. After finishing fourth in three of his first four tries this year, Truly a Judge captured an optional claimer at Del Mar in August, added another win at that level at Hollywood two starts later Nov. 18 and was a 6-1 shot to take it to a new level yesterday. *Native Diver cont. p2*

Truly a Judge, who had shown more speed than had been his custom when wiring the field at Hollywood last time out, was sent to the front once again here. He cruised along through a half in :47.50 and six furlongs in 1:11.32 and had plenty left in the tank when favored Dynever launched his late bid, holding off the crowd's choice handily. "I finally figured out that's the way he wants to run," said trainer David Bernstein, who lost a 12-way shake the first time he tried to claim the horse, but came out on top in a four-way shake a month later. "Put him on the lead, tell 'em to come get you. He ran so huge three weeks ago, we decided to take a shot here. Obviously, it paid off." Dynever, at the back of the pack early, found running room along the inside when he was ready to roll, angled outside for the final drive, but couldn't catch the winner. **Hong Kong Vase cont.**

**Warrsan** sat the garden trip in last year's Vase, racing just behind the speed before being outquicked to the wire. Campaigned nearly exclusively at the highest level this season, the veteran defeated Doyen (Ire) and Vallee Enchantee in the Coronation Cup June 4 and just missed by a head to Refuse to Bend (Ire) in the G1 Eclipse S. July 3. Ninth in the G1 King George and Queen Elizabeth II Diamond S. three weeks later, he bounced back to take the G1 Grosser Preis von Baden by a neck Sept. 5 and was a midpack ninth in the G1 Arc de Triomphe before a dismal next-to-last effort in the G1 Japan Cup Nov. 28. Lightly raced **Simonas** has attracted his fair share of attention this week. Fourth to Warrsan at Baden-Baden, the five-year-old posted an outstanding second to Sulamani (Ire) in the GI Canadian International in his latest effort Oct. 24. "He's in good form, his jockey [Kieren Fallon] has a lot of confidence in him and I hope he's right," said trainer Andreas Wohler. "I think that if he can reproduce the form that he showed in Canada, he'll have a chance."

**Hong Kong Mile cont.**

**Durandal** earned the role of favorite with his second straight victory in the G1 Mile Championship at Kyoto Nov. 21. The five-year-old has won four of his five tries going 1600 meters on right-handed courses. **Eagle Rise** also has a solid record under today's conditions, winning in five of his nine attempts. The champion two-year-old in Germany in 2002, he didn't win a stakes event at three, but has blossomed this season, most recently taking the Sept. 25 G2 Europe-Meile and the Nov. 7 G2 Premio Ribot. "He's in top form," trainer Andreas Schutz said. "Often, European horses come here after a long season and their form is tailing off, but not him--he's still improving." **Antonius Pius** is also getting better as the year progresses, according to his connections. The quirky three-year-old would have won the G1 Poule d'Essai des Poulains if he hadn't veered into the rail and nearly fallen. He went on to be third in the G1 St James's Palace S. at Royal Ascot and in the G1 Moulin de Longchamp in September. The erratic bay also ducked toward the inside during the stretch run of the Oct. 30 GI Breeders' Cup Mile and still managed to be second, beaten just a half length. "Obviously he is a class horse and he has learned plenty this year," regular rider Jamie Spencer said. "I'm just hoping his class puts him in the finish." Added trainer Aidan O'Brien, "We probably learned more about him [in the Breeders' Cup] than we have all year. If we have him right on the day, it is very possible that the best is yet to come."

The defending race champion, Horse of the Year **Silent Witness** will be odds-on to make it 13 for 13 this afternoon. Following his victory in this last December, the Australian-bred gelding swept the three-race Champion Sprint Series before earning a well-deserved vacation. The bay made a triumphant return to action following a seven-month absence with a one-length victory in the G2 International Sprint Trial Nov. 21. "He's a physically stronger horse than he was last year," trainer Tony Cruz commented. "He came out of his win in the Sprint Trial very well and obviously his defense of this race has always been the target." He completed his preparation for this with a 400-meter blowout over the all-weather Thursday in :21.3. **Var**, the former U.S. claiming horse, looms the biggest threat to the favorite. Rated just four pounds below Silent Witness in the International Classifications, the bay lost to **The Tatling** by a head in the G3 World Trophy at Newbury Sept. 18 before turning the tables on that rival, **Royal Millennium** and **Osterhase** by a half length in the G1 Prix de l'Abbaye Oct. 3. The Japanese have never factored in this event, but have their best chances this year in the form of G1 Sprinters' S. hero **Calstone Light O** and G1 Takamatsunomiya Kinen winner **Sunningdale**.

"She's training good--she's never been like this," trainer Wally Dollase said. **Hollywood Story** was off the board in the Santa Anita and Kentucky Oaks, but managed third in the GII Hollywood Breeders' Cup Oaks and again when switched to the turf for the GI American Oaks. She was 10th in her latest, the GI Breeders' Cup Distaff.

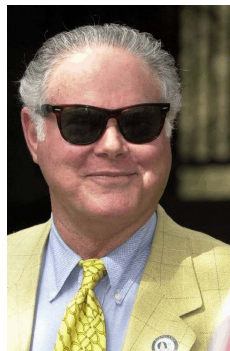

**If you could have dinner with one historical figure—past or present—who would it be, and why?** Federico Tesio. He bred and trained some of the most important horses of the 20th century. What little that has been written by and about him seems contrived, so I would like to speak with him one on one.

**What is your drink of choice?** Tomato juice, no ice, lime twist.

**Hamburger or Steak?** Steak over the burger, but I prefer sea bass grilled.

**What is the one secret you know about horse racing you're worried everyone else will find out?** The extent to which illegal performance-enhancing drugs are used in racing and which famous horsemen use them. Regulators and authorities charged with keeping the playing field level have been reluctant to police the sport in great part because of the anticipated reaction among followers of the sport. But, once revealed and dealt with, the drug enforcement will only serve to enhance the credibility of racing.
