The complexion of this race changed completely when it was announced that it would be moved to the dirt due to the unsafe condition of the turf. The likelihood that the favorites will be scratched could benefit Midwife. The three-year-old filly did break her maiden on the dirt, albeit with a \$12,500 tag on her head at Golden Gate 13 months ago. She finished fifth for the same price in her most recent main-track try at Solano in July, then reeled off three straight turf wins, including the Oct. 9 Palo Alto H. at Bay Meadows last time out. Festival is the only other runner with a dirt win, scoring four times in her native Japan, but she wasn't close in 10 starts last season. She made her lone U.S. appearance in the Sept. 29 GIII S.K. Maddy H. on the Santa Anita lawn, running a decent sixth to Belleski.



FOKINE TAKES HK DEBUT

Fokine (Royal Academy), multiple group placed in England at two and three, made a successful Hong Kong debut Saturday, taking the featured Class 1 handicap event over 1200 meters by 3/4 of a length. Formerly owned by the estate of Robert Sangster and trained by Barry Hills, the bay colt missed by a head to Balmont in last year's G2 Gimcrack S. and held his form nicely this season, with a victory in the Listed King Charles II S. sandwiched between runner-up efforts in the G3 Greeham S. and the G3 Jersey S. Saturday's run was his first in over six months. "I am very pleased with the way this horse has come to hand, and winning his first Hong Kong start is very satisfying," trainer C.H. Yip told South China Morning Post. "He is not really a sprinter, but the Royal Academy breed are very good when fresh and I thought he could sprint well first-up." Potential longer-term goals for Fokine include the G1 Mercedes-Benz Hong Kong Classic Mile Feb. 11 and the 2000-meter G1 Mercedes-Benz Hong Kong Derby Mar. 13. Both races are restricted to four-year-olds.


