TAMBURELLO GOES THE DISTANCE

Tamburello (Chi) (Rich Man's Gold) powered his way clear to an impressive victory in yesterday's GIII Gallant Fox H. at the Big A. "I was saving ground the first couple of turns," winning rider Norberto Arroyo Jr. said. "At some point on the backside I got him to the outside. The owners told me that he likes to run on the outside, so it worked

out fine. I saved as much ground as I could around the first two turns and I had a safe trip around the outside on the third turn." The chestnut had never gone the marathon distance of the Gallant Fox, but turned in a solid third in his final start in Chile, in the 1 3/8-mile G1 Gran Premio Hipodromo Chile S. May 1.

"You wouldn't think heaven would strike me twice with the same horse, but I think it's happened with this colt," Biancone commented. "It is not easy to control Spanish Chestnut's speed, but he's a very smart horse." The juvenile colt, owned by Derrick Smith and Michael Tabor, is being pointed to the GII San Rafael S. at one mile Jan. 15.
