NASHOBA'S KEY TO WAIT FOR MILLIONS

Nashoba's Key (Silver Hawk) will bypass Sunday's GII San Gorgonio H. at Santa Anita in favor of the Jan. 26 Sunshine Millions. The San Gorgonio is scheduled for

Both the Classic and the Filly and Mare Turf are nine-furlong races run this year at Santa Anita. The \$1-million Classic is run over the Cushion Track. SANTA ANITA DRAINAGE WOES CONTINUE

Santa Anita is hopeful that it will be able to cope with four days of forecasted wet weather, despite drainage problems with its new Cushion Track. "After today's races we'll probably put a seal on the track," said Santa Anita President Ron Charles yesterday. "We're trying to get through the predicted four days of wet weather. If we close here, we'll certainly go back to the plan we had where we could accommodate horsemen shipping to Hollywood Park to train." Santa Anita closed its Cushion Track for three weeks for a renovation project prior to the start of its current race meet Dec. 26. Officials of Cushion Track Footings have restated their commitment to finding a solution to the drainage woes that have plagued the new synthetic surface. Paul Harper, technical director of Cushion Track Footings, indicated that the company was hopeful that it could stabilize the track and allow it to drain vertically, but added, "If we are unable to do that, we will install a new surface at the end of the meet." The current Santa Anita meeting runs through Apr. 20. Cushion Track was installed in 2006 and used without problems at Hollywood Park.

LOVE OF THE GAME

Woodbine-based Reade Baker earned a Sovereign Award as Canada's leading trainer in 2005, when his charges Gold Strike and Judith's Wild Rush were honored with championships as top three-year-old filly and top sprinter, respectively. Judith's Wild Rush successfully defended his title in 2006, while Baker was a finalist in the training category. In 2007, Baker was a finalist once again, but made a couple of raids south of the border and could be poised to make a bigger impact in 2008. Bear Now

(Tiznow) captured three stakes by big margins at Woodbine in 2007, including the GIII Selene S., but posted her biggest tally by toppling Octave in the \$750,000 GII Fitz Dixon Cotillion H. at Philadelphia Park in September. Though she faded to eighth in the sloppy going in the GI Breeders' Cup Distaff a month later, Bear Now was a Sovereign Award finalist in the sophomore filly category. After getting some time off, she is set to rejoin Baker's string at Palm Meadows at any moment. "She'll ship in from Ocala," Baker said. "She hasn't done a thing since the Breeders' Cup, but she should be ready to run by the end of Gulfstream."

Baker campaigned another Sovereign Award finalist last year, the unbeaten two-year-old colt Bear Holiday (Harlan's Holiday). The grey colt captured the Colin S. in July and added the Silver Deputy S. in August over Woodbine's Polytrack, but was scratched on the eve of the Swynford S. Sept. 15. Danny Dion's colt has been sidelined since. "Bear Holiday has not recovered yet," said Baker. "He had a stress fracture to his femur, which is a Poly injury." When asked if more hind-end problems were seen on the all-weather surfaces, Baker replied, "You see more in a year than you would have in an entire career."

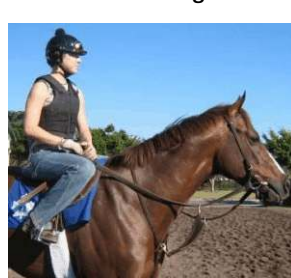

While it remains to be seen whether Bear Holiday will recapture his sparkling juvenile form, Baker does have some promising newly turned three-year-olds among his 15-horse string at Palm Meadows. Among them is

Notgivinmyloveaway (Not for Love), who faces a class test in the GII Hutcheson S. on Saturday. After winning first time out at Woodbine Sept. 14, the chestnut ran in a pair of allowance contests at that track, finishing third by a half-length Nov. 8. He then shipped down to Philadelphia and dusted his foes by five lengths in the Pennsylvania Nursery S. Nov. 24.

"We sent him there because he's a Pennsylvania-bred," Baker noted, "but part of the reason...we sent him to Philadelphia was to see if he could be as good a dirt horse as he is on Polytrack." Baker added, "He got a 7 on the Ragozin sheets. It's a big number, but he'll face a different kind of beast in the Hutcheson. We'll see if he can maintain that kind of number." The Pennsylvania Nursery has some distinguished alumni in recent years, with Smarty Jones winning in 2003 and Hard Spun taking the honors last year. "We think he'll be a two-turn horse, but I don't know if he'll be up to those kind of horses," said Baker. **Cont. p3**

Notgvinmyloveaway shipped back to Woodbine after his victorious stakes bow, then came down to Florida in mid-December. Baker commented, "He's doing fine. He worked a minute the other day [five-eighths in 1:00.60 Dec. 30]." Should the Jus Luk Stable colorbearer pass his class test in the Hutcheson, Baker will look to stretch him out. "If he runs well, then we'll take a look at races like the [GI] Florida Derby [Mar. 29]...or the [GIII] Holy Bull [Apr. 12]. We'll take it one step at a time."

Baker, who grew up with horses, has been on the racetrack since 1965. "I've galloped horses, was a jock's agent and managed Afleet," the Ontario native recalled. Baker served as a racing manager for Richard Kennedy from 1985-1990, whose stable during that time included the likes of Canadian Horse of the Year Afleet (Mr. Prospector), Canadian champion One From Heaven (Affirmed) and MGSW Storm on the Loose (Lyphard). Of all the hats he's worn in the business, Baker said, "[Being a] jock's agent might be my first choice." He quipped, "I love being with horses every day, and training horses, but don't like being a trainer."

Baker and his wife, Janis Maine, have enjoyed success with a small broodmare band, campaigning homebred stakes winners Elusive Thought (Elusive Quality) and Ontheqt (Mazel Trick). But he also has an interesting hobby, namely, of showing birds--chickens and ducks. "My dad gave me birds when I was little," said Baker.

GOMEZ HOPING FOR FIRST ECLIPSE The finalists for the 2007 Eclipse Awards will be announced today, and jockey Garrett Gomez is hoping his name is on the list. Gomez, 36, was the leading rider in North America last year, earning \$22,800,074 in purse money. He captured 265 races, including the GI Las Virgenes S., GI Santa Anita Oaks and GI Kentucky Oaks with Rags to Riches, the GI Frizette S. and GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies with Indian Blessing and the GI Breeders' Cup Sprint with Midnight Lute. How does Gomez feel about being a top candidate to take his first Eclipse? "It would mean a lot to my career," he said. "It's an award you always hope to have an opportunity to win. We were nominated in 2006 and hopefully we'll be nominated again next year. You see guys winning throughout the years and you're kind of in awe about it, and always hope you have the same opportunity. A rider always hopes to reach a pinnacle like this. Now we have to see if we can stay there." Gomez was out of action for 21 months while battling substance abuse problems, but returned in the fall of 2004 and has been at the top of the game since 2005. "Back then, all I was thinking about was riding again, not winning an Eclipse Award," Gomez said. "I didn't even know if I would have a chance to ride again. But I was able to win two Breeders' Cups in 2005, and from there things just kept going. Me and Ron [agent Ron Anderson] hooked up early in 2006 and the rest is history."

The club's board of stewards approved provisions for field inspections in August 2005 due the increasing number of Thoroughbred foals reported born in the first several days of January and a concern over the accuracy of foaling dates. "Our registry staff inspected more mares this year and found fewer foals than in the past two years," explained Alan Marzelli, president of The Jockey Club. "These results are consistent with the general trend we've seen over the last few years in the reporting of breedings."

TONY RICHARDS DIES

Prominent racehorse owner and Ewar Stud Farm owner Tony Richards died on New Year's Day, aged 80. Having achieved international renown as the owner of the 1986 GI Kentucky Derby runner-up Bold Arrangement (GB), he bred the only Group 1 winner to race in his silks in Village Star (Fr), who conquered the Grand Prix de Saint-Cloud two years later. His longstanding patronage of the Newmarket stable of Clive Brittain resulted in decades of success, with Kandidate (GB) winning the G3 Round II of the Maktoum Challenge at Nad Al Sheba last February. Others to hit the heights include the 2004 G2 Gimcrack S. hero Tony James (Ire) and the 1981 G3 Palace House S. scorer Standaan (Fr). Brittain paid tribute in the *Racing Post*. "You couldn't have wished for a better owner to train for," he said. "I trained for him for something like 33 years and you were never worried about ringing Tony, whether it was good news or bad. He came as close as he could to winning the Kentucky Derby--we went over together for that race and we had an amazing time. And, of course, he owned Kandidate, who was a bonus over these last few months when he was not well. He'll be missed, not only by me but also by my staff, as he was a very kind and generous man." Richards is survived by his wife Emily, four children and 10 grandchildren.
