INDIAN BLESSING HOLDS ON

Heavily favored Indian Blessing (Indian Charlie) had to fight hard for it, but bravely held on for a narrow victory in yesterday's GII Santa Ynez S. at Santa Anita. The likely two-year-old champion, making her sopho-



more bow, had not been out since winning the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies last October at Monmouth Park, but looked much the best on paper and was sent off the 1-10 crowd's choice. Pressed on the early lead by Peisinoe (Yes It's True), Indian Blessing Benoit began inching clear after a half over the lightning fast

Cushion Track in :43.76. She completed six furlongs in 1:07.14 and was clearly tiring in the final furlong as 12-1 longshot Golden Doc A (Unusual Heat) closed stoutly to come up just a head short of catching the champ, who completed the seven furlongs in a track record 1:19 4/5. "She was a little fresh today," admitted winning rider Garrett Gomez. "Alex [Solis, aboard Peisinoe] put quite a bit more pressure on us than I expected and I wasn't able to get her to settle like I wanted. I knew with the pressure we got somebody might be coming at us and at the sixteenth pole, I could feel that filly coming. At that point I had to get after her a little bit. "It was supposed to be an easy out, but those are the hardest ones to win," admitted winning trainer Bob Baffert. "She ran her heart out today. It's exciting to have a filly like that. She keeps winning, that's all she does." Baffert added that Indian Blessing's next start is still up in the air. "I don't know what I'm going to do with her," the trainer, celebrating his 55th birthday yesterday, commented. "She ran pretty hard today, so I'll let her dictate where she wants to run next, but we're not in a hurry with her."

Zenyatta employed her late-running tactics to win her 6 1/2-furlong debut at Hollywood Nov. 22 and added a 3 1/2-length win in a 1 1/16-miles allowance at that track last time out Dec. 15. "We'll go race by race, but we'll look at the [Feb. 10 GII] La Canada, absolutely," said winning trainer John Shirreffs. "That's why she ran long at Hollywood, so she'd have a route race for this race. She hasn't uncorked her big stride yet, so we're still waiting for that." 



PATTERN UPGRADES ANNOUNCED Horse Racing Ireland has revealed that a further two races will receive upgrades to Group 3 status in 2008. After consultations with the European Pattern Committee, Ireland's ruling body announced that both The Curragh's June 29 Richard H Faught Memorial S. and Leopardstown's July 16 Silver Flash S. will be boosted from their former listed status. The latest upgrades to the five-furlong sprint and seven-furlong juvenile fillies' contest, respectively, brings the total of domestic group races to 59. HRI Chief Jason Morris said, "In 2007, every Irish group race achieved a pattern-race rating above its required parameter, which we believe to be the first time that this has ever been achieved by any EPC country. It is testimony to the growing strength of our flat horse population, and reflects the success of HRI's key strategic policy to encourage the production and retention of high-quality horses in Ireland under both codes."

KEENELAND JANUARY CONCLUDES Keeneland realized a gross of \$70,446,000 as the seven-day January Horses of All Ages Sale concluded yesterday in Lexington. "We are very pleased with the results, given the variability of January sales," said Keeneland's Director of Sales, Geoffrey Russell. "The sale unfolded as anticipated; buyers were very discriminating in their purchases in a continuation of what we saw in November." The sale's highest price was achieved at last Monday's opening session, when Southern Equine signed a \$2.7-million ticket for Irish Cherry (Irish Open), in foal to Ghostzapper and the dam of Grade I winners Daaher and Spun Sugar. The 14-year-old mare was one of four offerings to break the seven-figure barrier.

By the Numbers...

Last year's January Sale was held over eight sessions, and Russell pointed out major increases in the overall number of sale days offered by the auction company. Keeneland conducted 27 days of selling in 2002, versus 39 in 2007; the September Yearling catalogue has increased by 1,200 in the last five years, and Russell echoed widespread industry concerns of overproduction. "Our sales have expanded dramatically over the past five years, yet the size of the North American foal crop (37,900 in 2001 versus 37,300 in 2006) has remained virtually the same," he said. "That shows there are too many non-commercial horses being offered. We get questions about the number of days and number of horses we now catalog, but as Keeneland is the marketing arm of the industry, it is our role to catalog what we are offered. We raise the issue of overproduction out of concern for the long-term profitability of our commercial breeder clients." In 2007, Keeneland's four sales (January, April, September and November) realized a record cumulative gross of more than \$814 million, with buyers representing nearly all 50 states and 45 countries, up from 42 the previous year. However, Russell cautioned that success was attributable to the global economy rather than market strength. "Make no mistake; record sales last year were built on the weakness of the U.S. dollar, which drove foreign spending," he explained. "If not for that, we would have experienced a major market correction. One only need look at the recent downturn in European sales, which did not have the benefit of the favorable exchange rate. It will happen here too, unless breeders make some hard decisions." Cont. p6
