Sept. 1. He will be the 123-pound highweight Monday. The field for the six-furlong Palos Verdes is expected to have Barbecue Eddie (Stormy Atlantic) (116), Greg's Gold (Lake George) (120), In Summation (Put It Back) (122), and Soul City Slew (Slew City Slew) (114) entered, while Copa de Plata (Pioneering) (113) is possible, according to DRF.

POSSE COLT TOPS OBS WINTER OPENER A colt by 2007 leading first-crop sire Posse (Silver Deputy) was knocked down for a final bid of \$95,000 to top yesterday's consignor preferred session of the Ocala Breeders' Sales Company's Winter Mixed Sale in Central Florida. Brent and Crystal Fernung's Journeyman Stud was responsible for the top two selling yearlings as well as the session's top mare. Catalogued as hip 151, the New York-bred son of Navarro Rose (Native Prospector) was purchased by Josham Farms Limited, agent. Hip 99, a son of Malibu Moon, realized a final bid of \$75,000 from Pick Six Thoroughbreds. The Feb. 18 foal was produced by Jamie's Sunshine (Temperence Hill), a half-sister to GISW Mademoiselle Forli (*Forli). The eight-year-old mare Kabeeb (Labeeb (GB)) was sold to Adena Springs for \$90,000. Catalogued as hip 112, the stakes-winning daughter of Kalene (Carson City) was offered on an Apr. 25 cover to Bandini (Fusaichi Pegasus). The sale suffered significant statistical losses compared to the opening session of 2007. Despite reporting sales on 45 percent more horses, gross receipts were effectively static, while the average declined by 31.1 percent. The median was down by 23.8 percent, though the clearance rate, which saw just two of each five horses find new homes 12 months ago, improved somewhat to just over 55 percent. Adriano May Try Dirt Next:

Courtlandt Farm's **Adriano** (A.P. Indy), an impressive allowance winner on the Gulfstream turf last Friday (video), could try his luck on the main track next out, according to *Daily Racing Form*. "I guess with a three-year-old at this time of year you have to start thinking about trying them on the dirt at least once," trainer Graham Motion told *DRF*. "I'll probably nominate him for the [GII] Fountain of Youth [Feb. 24] and take a

look, although that might be asking a little too much right now. What I'd really like to do is stretch him out to a mile and one-eighth for the next one, because I think the further he goes, the better it will be for him." After breaking his maiden in his second

start over the turf at Saratoga, the big chestnut ran fourth on Polytrack in the GI Lane's End Breeders' Futurity Oct. 6, but disappointed in his juvenile finale, finishing fifth to Cowboy Cal in the grassy Laurel Futurity Nov. 24. "To be honest, the race at Laurel was kind of a puzzle," Motion explained. "We had expected him to run better coming off his previous race over the Polytrack at Keeneland. Ramon [Dominguez] was very high on him after that race." The homebred is the third foal from his winning dam, Gold Canyon (Mr. Prospector), who was acquired by Courtlandt for \$400,000 as a KEEJUL yearling in 1997. Gold Canyon is out of Golden Treat (Theatrical {Ire}), a Grade I-winning halfsister to 1987 GI Belmont S. hero Bet Twice.

Plesa Has Two Bullets for Millions Classic:

California-trained horses have taken the last four renewals of the \$1-million Sunshine Millions Classic, but Florida conditioner Eddie Plesa Jr. has two live chances to right the ship this year at Gulfstream Park. The veteran horseman, who took the inaugural Sunshine Millions Classic with Best of the Rest, confirmed yesterday that his stable will be represented by Centaur Farm's Gottcha Gold (Coronado's Quest) and Padua Stable's **Electrify** (Delaware Township). "They're both right on schedule and worked Friday morning," Plesa Jr. commented. Gottcha Gold, who upset Lawyer Ron in the GIII Salvator Mile H. and added a win in the GIII Philip H. Iselin H. last summer, breezed five-eighths of a mile at Gulfstream in 1:00 3/5. In his most recent appearance, the five-year-old was runner-up to Corinthian in the Breeders' Cup Dirt Mile Oct. 26. Electrify, last-out winner of the GIII Fred W. Hooper H. at Calder Dec. 15, went five furlongs at Calder, stopping the clock in 1:00 4/5.



CHRB Teleconference Canceled:

It does not appear to be necessary for us to consider any waiver in light of the direction they have chosen."
