SHOW MUST GO ON...BUT WILL IT?

Today's Sunshine Millions races will take place as scheduled at Florida's Gulfstream Park, where champion and GI Breeders' Cup Distaff winner **Ginger Punch** (Awesome Again) is the headliner in the \$500,000 Distaff. The situation is a lot more fluid at Santa Anita. For the second time in the month of January, torrential rains have pummeled the Southland area of Southern

California and an additional 3 1/2 inches of rain have fallen on the already deficient Cushion Track. The storm also left about two inches of hail on the surface Thursday morning, forcing the cancellation of that day's live racing program. Officials at the Arcadia track were forced to call of yesterday's action due to the wet conditions. Nevertheless, there remains optimism that racing will take place today at Santa Anita, where a competitive field of 12 is set to face the starter in the \$1-million Sunshine Millions Classic. "Any decision we make will be in full consultation with trainers, owners, jockeys, officials and track maintenance personnel," said Santa Anita President Ron Charles. "We realize that many people, including our fans and horsemen are being inconvenienced by the uncertainty wrought by the current weather and track conditions. At this point, due to the uncertain weather, we need to maintain the flexibility to be able to take advantage of favorable conditions, should they materialize in the next 24 hours. If we get a break in the weather, we will make every attempt to try and run," he added. According to published reports, the weather was expected to clear enough during the overnight hours to allow maintenance crews to work the track in an attempt to have it ready for today's races.

A Wide-Open Classic...

A field of 12, split evenly between Florida- and California-breds, race for the \$550,000 winner's share of the purse in the Classic. Horses from the Golden State have dominated the race over the past years, but

Woodward S. at Saratoga last summer before taking the GII Meadowlands Cup Oct. 5. He was most recently a troubled third in the GII Clark H. at Churchill Downs Nov. 23 and merits respect from off the pace, though trainer Richard Dutrow Jr. is taking nothing for granted. "We're taking a big chance hoping he likes that track, and he's going to have to like that track to win that race because it's not an easy spot," the conditioner told *Daily Racing Form*. He added, "He's traveling cross-country, and we're just hoping he handles whatever they call that track. We're not confident, but it seems like [most] horses in the race are in the same boat."

McCann's Mojave (Memo {Chi}), who upset last year's Classic at odds of 33-1, will try to continue California's dominance in the race. The eight-year-old entire has taken nicely to racing over synthetic surfaces, having won the GIII All-American S. on the Tapeta at Golden Gate Nov. 17 followed by a runner-up effort to **Now Victory** (Sharp Victor) in the Dec. 26 Forty Niner S. at the San Francisco-area oval. It would certainly make for an easy post-race interview should he successfully defend his title; McCann's Mojave is campaigned by Mike Willman, director of publicity at Santa Anita. Trainer Eddie Plesa Jr. took the inaugural running of the Sunshine Millions Classic with Best of the Rest and has two bullets to fire if they race this afternoon. Padua Stables' homebred **Electrify** (Delaware Township) comes into today's test in career-best form, with a victory in the Carl G. Rose Classic for Florida-breds at Calder Nov. 10 and a score in the GIII Fred W. Hooper H. Dec. 15. Plesa's other runner, **Gottcha Gold** (Coronado's Quest), had a breakout season in 2007. A homebred for Vernon Heath's Centaur Farms, the five-year-old upset champion Lawyer Ron in the GIII Salvator Mile H. at Monmouth Park June 23 and took the GIII Iselin Breeders' Cup H. Aug. 18. He makes his first start since filling the runner-up spot behind Corinthian in the Breeders' Cup Dirt Mile back at the Jersey Shore Oct. 26.

Her most recent outing here was a game victory in the GI Yellow Ribbon S. Sept. 29. Shipping in from Florida is **Quite a Bride**, winner of the GIII Mint Julep H. last season. She tuned up for this test with a front-running tally in the South Beach S. for Florida-breds Jan. 3 at Gulfstream.

Presious Passion lit up the tote board in winning his second graded event of 2007, the GII W.L. McKnight H. Dec. 15 at Calder. The Florida-bred chestnut has won two of five Gulfstream outings, and trainer Mary Hartmann has him ready. "He's going into this race super, and things have worked out well for us so far," she said. "He broke his maiden and won an allowance race here as a three-year-old. People can only see what he did here last year [fourth in two allowance races last March and April], but I didn't have him fully cranked the way he is this year." The likely favorite will be MGSW **Icy Atlantic**, who hasn't been out since finishing ninth in the GI Breeders' Cup Mile Oct. 27. The seven-year-old has been training steadily at Palm Beach Downs. **War Monger** steps up in class for his seasonal opener. Fourth in the GII Jamaica H. Oct. 6 in his stakes bow, the Vegso homebred made a nice move to land the Rutgers S. at Monmouth Oct. 24.

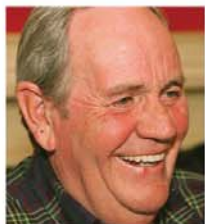

ORC ESTABLISHES 90-DAY BAN FOR POSITIVE-TEST HORSES

The Ontario Racing Commission Wednesday announced it is adopting a series of measures in 2008 designed to protect the health of the horses and ensure the safety of racing's participants. The most dramatic of the new regulations is a rule making any horse that tests positive immediately ineligible to race for 90 days. It was introduced "in an aggressive move to improve the welfare of the horse and communicate that the ORC is serious about owner responsibility and eliminating the use of illegal medications," according to a press release. In a statement, Rod Seiling, chair of the ORC said, "These measures have resulted from the community's expressed desire for regulation that is fair, consistent and which holds all to the highest standards of accountability." In addition to the ban on positive-test horses, the new regulations reinforce a trainer's liability when it comes to positive drug tests, and revise the penalties for equine drug, TCO2, and non-therapeutic drug offenses. These rules go into effect Jan. 31. Under the new guidelines, there will also be a withdrawal time of 96 hours for the use of shock wave--or pulse wave--therapy (effective Jan. 31); and only ORC licensed vets will be authorized to treat racehorses, unless it is an emergency or an area under serviced by vets (effective June 1).

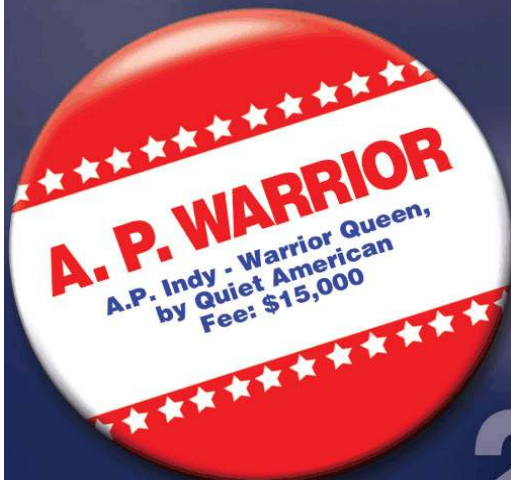

Mullins Gets 90 Days for Positive Test:

The California Horse Racing Board yesterday suspended trainer Jeff Mullins for 90 days after one of his horses tested above the threshold level for the substance mepivacaine. The conditioner will be forced to serve 20 days of the suspension, while the balance of the penalty will be stayed, assuming that Mullins obeys all racing laws and CHRB regulations for the one-year probationary period. Rob's Coin, who finished second in the seventh race at Hollywood Park on July 8, 2006, was found to have excess levels of mepivacaine.


