### Vegso, Go & Go-Go...

Before his new status as synthetic star, Peter Vegso's homebred Go Between had long been considered a talented turf horse. In 2006, he won the GII Virginia Derby and GIII Palm Beach S., and last year, he ran

third to Lava Man in the Sunshine Millions Turf here at Santa Anita. But late in the season, Vegso and Mott experimented with Go Between on a synthetic track in the Oct. 27 GIII Fayette S. at Keeneland and were rewarded with a hard-fought neck win. Go Between came back to

be sixth in the grassy GIII Tropical Park H. at Calder Dec. 1, but Vegso and Mott were encouraged by his Fayette score and decided to roll the dice for the big money in the Sunshine Millions. Under jockey Garrett 'Go-Go' Gomez for the first time, Go Between sat well back as Bilo (Bertrando) and a number of pursuers ensured snappy: 22.73,:45.10 and 1:08 fractions over a Cushion Track surface that was playing lightning fast. The closers began to swarm leaving the quarter pole, but it was Go Between who emerged from the pack at the furlong grounds to take command and edge away. "I was concerned about the dirt coming back. I wanted to make sure he got his confidence and was comfortable running into it," Gomez said afterwards. "When I swung him out around the turn, he really cut and went to running." Assistant Leana Willaford, on hand to saddle Go Between for Bill Mott, said she wasn't too surprised. "He ran really well at Keeneland over the Polytrack," she explained. "Obviously, coming all this way [from Florida], we thought he would handle this surface. They were going so fast up front, and he closed well." Asked if she had spoken to Mott, who was at Gulfstream Park, Willaford added, "We've exchanged text messages, but haven't spoken yet. We don't know where he will run next, but it looks like we'll stick with the synthetic surface." Click for the brisnet.com chart or the free brisnet.com catalogue-style pedigree. ### Tale of a Track...

Wet weather and ongoing problems with Santa Anita's Cushion Track threatened to postpone the West Coast portion of Sunshine Millions day, but the skies cleared and racing went on...and very quickly, too. Times over the Cushion Track were nearly on the absurd side of fast, so much so that Bob Black Dash (Stormy Jack) zipped a half-mile in :42.46 . . . and then kept on motoring to set a new world record for a sixfurlong non-turf race in the Dash (1:06.53). But at least one jockey was happy with the surface. "It's firm, but it's safe, and the main thing is, it is uniform and very even," said Mike Smith. "The crew did an unbelievable job getting this track ready today."

Quite a Bride is not particular about where she runs. The chestnut mare had already won stakes on the grass at Monmouth, Belmont, Tampa, Churchill, Ellis Park and Gulfstream, and she added Santa Anita to the list with this impressive score. Three-for-six last season, including victories in the GIII Mint Julep H. in June and the Ellis Park BC Turf in August, she capped off the campaign with a third in the Oct. 6 GII First Lady S. at Keeneland. The five-year-old opened 2008 with a romp in the Jan. 3 South Beach S. in Hallandale, but she was the second choice behind Eclipse finalist Nashoba's Key on Sunshine Millions Day. Jockey Garrett Gomez rated Quite a Bride in second for six furlongs and sent her to the front at the top of the lane. Nashoba's Key made headway in the stretch, but never threatened the winner. As for what's next for Quite a Bride, Leana Willaford, assistant to trainer Bill Mott, said, "She's meant to be retired. Her last race was supposed to be her last one, and we talked her owners into running in this one...so now I don't know what they're going to do." Less than a week after being named 2007 champion older mare and making her first start since winning the GI Breeders' Cup Distaff in thrilling style, Ginger Punch was settled into a perfect tracking position under jockey Rafael Bejarano. Two furlongs out, only the pacesetting Peach Flambe, running the race of her life, stood in her way, but that one duly gave way to the champ and Ginger Punch strolled home virtually uncontested. It was a sweet win for the mare's owner and breeder Frank Stronach, who launched the Sunshine Millions six years ago. "I had no anxious moments, but horses aren't machines," he said. "You always pray. You can't take it for granted. She seemed to come out of the race fine, and the jock said he never used the whip." Added Bejarano, "When I came into the far turn, my horse exploded. This horse is very special in my career. She really gives me a special feeling. I've ridden her so many times; [trainer] Bobby [Frankel] doesn't give me any instructions." Peter Vegso's late-starting War Monger announced himself as a possible player in the turf division this year with this break-out win. The handsome bay won in his second start over Belmont's sod last June and came back two starts later to clear the first-level allowance hurdle with style at Saratoga Aug. 20, winning that day by 4 1/4 lengths. Asked to take on the likes of Nobiz Like Shobiz in the GII Jamaica H. at Belmont Oct. 6, he found himself on the front end--tactics theretofore unknown--and failed to see out the nine furlongs of the race, tiring to fourth. He was favored for the Oct. 24 Rutgers S. at Monmouth and didn't disappoint, rallying to win easy, and was put away until this one.

Bet down to 9-5 from his 4-1 morning-line odds, War Monger and jockey Kent Desormeaux were content to give the field some breathing room as they settled in eighth. War Monger began to tire of playing that game and moved into striking distance on the turn as Desormeaux continued to ask his mount for some restraint. The jock gave the green light as they straight-

ened for home and War Monger, once in the clear, quickly assumed command and was going away late. Desormeaux was impressed with his charge's professionalism. "Bill's [trainer Mott] done a great job training

this horse," he said. "When I first rode him, I couldn't get him within two lengths of another horse. To have him come through horses like he did today really impressed me. He's come a long way. He's a very talented animal. He's really matured. He held his ground and didn't let the other horses push him out of the way." Added Mott, "When he switches off [leads], he's got a nice punch. He ran well today. Is he better at a flat mile? I can't tell you. He didn't have a good trip. It's amazing, when those jocks have a lot of horse, they are able to find room. 

and moved to trainer Richard Dutrow. The 'Bull' ran second to Midnight Lute in the GI Forego S. in August in his second start for the stable, then was a good fourth in the GI Breeders' Cup Sprint at Monmouth Park next time. He came flying to win the GI Frank J. de Francis Memorial Dash S. in a stylish seasonal finale and was looking to get 2008 started the right way here. Under jockey Edgar Prado, he settled off the pace as Mach Ride headed the charge through an opening half-mile in :44 2/5. Deftly handled by Prado, Benny the Bull went around a rival on the turn, angled back

toward the rail in upper stretch, found room soon after and scampered clear under a hand ride. The nearly 50-1 bomb Santana Strings completed the exacta, as Mach Ride held for third. goes."

Dearest Trickski, a dream claim for Tom Mankiewicz and trainer John Sadler, continued her remarkable run with this facile score. Less than a year ago, in April of 2007, Dearest Trickski was beating \$10,000 claimers at Lone Star Park. After winning an allowance race at that track in June, she traveled west and was haltered by Mankiewicz for \$32,000 when second in a Del Mar claimer in August. Stepped up to face \$50,000 claimers, she won at that level at Del Mar Sept. 1, took two consecutive allowance races at Bay Meadows in October and Hollywood in November, then registered the biggest win of her career in the GI La Brea S. over this strip Dec. 29. Sadler opted to return Dearest Trickski in this spot rather than today's GI Santa Monica H.--where she would have been up against mares like Hystericalady and Pussycat Doll--and was rewarded with a good-looking win. Hammered down to odds-on favoritism, she jumped out and blazed the way through :20 2/5 and :43 1/5 over the speed-crazy Cushion Track surface. She turned for home with a four-length lead and was under only nominal urging down the lane from regular rider Mike Smith. "She's just about the quickest thing I've ever been on," enthused Smith afterwards. "They just don't come any quicker than that. She's like a deer leaving the gate. She runs 'em off their feet, relaxes and then she's got another gear." Added Mankiewicz, "Mike said the most wonderful thing after she won the La Brea. He said, 'She comes out of the gate like she's going 870 yards at Los Alamitos, and then for some reason, she relaxes.' And then when she relaxes and she sees the finish line, it's almost like a re-break. She gets really excited and






