

TRACK WOES CONTINUE AT SANTA ANITA


Santa Anita Park announced the cancellation of Sunday's races, including the GII San Antonio H. due to wet weather conditions. The Super Bowl Sunday card had a scheduled first post of 11 a.m. PST, but, with rain forecast for most of the day, officials conferred with jockeys, trainers and track maintenance officials, and decided to pull the plug on the nine-race card at

8:45 a.m. The San Antonio, featuring a nine-horse field including Student Council and Awesome Gem, has been rescheduled for Feb. 9. "This decision was really made for the safety of the horses and riders," Santa Anita President Ron Charles said. "We also want

to get the track done...If you weigh everything, it was an easy call. As a racing fan, we really would have liked to race today...We're still shooting for [racing] next Friday. I have a feeling we're going to know pretty well where we're going to be either by Monday afternoon or Tuesday morning as to how good Friday looks." Charles added, "It might have been possible to get one or two races in, but with the safety issue, and too much water accumulating in certain areas, this is not a dirt track where we can manipulate a lot of it...hopefully, this is the last day we're going to have to do this." Santa Anita had already cancelled the Monday and Thursday cards this week in order to allow the Cushion Track surface to be amended with Pro-Ride synthetic polymer and binder. Live racing is slated to resume Friday at 1 p.m. with Pick Six carryover of \$181,514.



Third to Country Star in the GI Darley Alcibiades S., the bay filly didn't handle the slop when seventh in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies, and closed out her season with a lackluster eighth in the GI Hollywood Starlet S. Dec. 15. "Frankie Dettori [her jockey in the Breeders' Cup] said she never got a hold of the track from the word go," O'Neill explained. "The race at Hollywood, we loved her. She trained on the track good, but she was horsing on us leading into the

race, and she had her mind on other things, if you know what I mean." Grace Anatomy returned to form with a sharp second in the GIII Santa Ysabel S. Jan. 13, and will be tough to handle in the one-mile Las Virgenes, a race that launched Rags to Riches to fame a year ago.

INFORMED DECISION TO DAVONA DALE In-

formed Decision (Monarchos) will make her next start in the Mar. 2 GII Davona Dale S. at Gulfstream. The threeyear-old filly, a 6 1/2-length maiden winner at Gulfstream Jan. 3, remained unbeaten when she inherited the victory over J Z Warrior in a Hallandale allowance Saturday (video). John Velazquez, aboard Informed Decision Saturday, lodged a claim of foul against J Z Warrior and jockey Kent Desormeaux after his mount was hit across the face by Desormeaux's whip inside the final sixteenth of the 6 1/2-furlong race. "Regardless of the DQ, I think it was a great effort," said trainer Jonathan Sheppard. "We wanted to see what would happen and it's pretty clear she's getting better as we gradually add distance. The Davona Dale is coming up in a month's time. I think we will definitely look at that."

GOLDEN SPIKES COULD BE FOUNTAIN BOUND

Golden Spikes (Seeking the Gold) may have earned a return trip to the graded-stakes ranks after a determined runner-up effort behind Cool Coal Man in a Jan. 26 allowance at Gulfstream Park (video). "We haven't decided for sure what's next," trainer Marty Wolfson said Sunday morning. "Right now I'm leaning toward the [Feb. 24 GII] Fountain of Youth because that gives him four weeks rather than three if we went to Tampa Bay [for the Feb. 16 Sam Davis S.]. Owned by M375 Thoroughbreds Inc. and Suarez Racing Stable, the bay colt was produced by a half-sister to Grade I winners Cash Run and Forestry.
