turns better. We'll see how she is after the race, and we may come back [for the Mar. 8 GII Fair Grounds Oaks]." Cont. p5


GRASSHOPPER TRIUMPHS IN RETURN

Making his first start since a second-place finish in

the GII Super Derby in September, Grasshopper (Dixie Union) found a seam in the traffic at the top of the lane and drove on through to take yesterday's GIII Mineshaft S. at Fair Grounds by 2 1/2 lengths. "That was awesome," said winning jockey Robby Albarado. "He Lou Hodges Jr has such a quick turn of foot. I

Risen Star S. cont. Out of the Shadows...

Pyro opened his career with a game nose victory in a Churchill Downs maiden test July 7, but ran into champion War Pass in his next three starts. The Winchell Thoroughbreds homebred stumbled at the break of their first meeting, an optional claimer at Saratoga Aug. 26, and made up some ground late to finish a distant third. Far back early in the Oct. 6 GI Champagne S. at Belmont Park, he finished full of run to be second, beaten just 1 1/2 lengths. The colt was up against it over the sloppy strip in the Oct. 27 GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile, and was roughed up when the gates opened, but he still managed to close the gap in the final furlong, hitting the line 4 3/4 lengths adrift of the Eclipse hero in second. Finally earning the spotlight yesterday, he gave notice that he will be one for War Pass to fear on the Triple Crown trail.

From Last To First...

Sent off the 9-10 chalk in the Risen Star, Pyro was hard held in last as 112-1 shot Rich Young Ruler (Vic-

tory Gallop) cut out leisurely fractions of :24.52, :49.50 and 1:14.62. He still had the entire field in front of him as they hit the stretch, but jockey Shaun Bridgmohan guided him through the Lou Hodges Jr traffic to get to the outside at the eighth pole


and it was all over but the shouting. Pyro hit not fifth gear, but sixth, shot to the front in the final yards and was drawing away at the wire. "I did what I was told to," said Bridgmohan. Z Fortune, who ran his record to three-for-three with a 2 3/4-length score in the Jan. 12 GIII Lecomte S., closed from just off the pace to take the lead in the stretch. He couldn't hold off the winner, but fought off a determined Visionaire to get the place. "He is a nice horse," jockey Garrett Gomez said. "He is still learning, just like a teenager. He was half-way idling when he made the lead. I think the longer distances will definitely help this colt."


A Group 2 winner in her native Brazil, Double Trouble was fourth in the Apr. 25 GIII Wilshire H. at Hollywood to open her stateside account. She came back to take an optional claimer on the all-weather May 25 and an allowance on the grass July 1. Kept on the turf for her next six outings, she was third in three of those appearances, including the July 21 Osunitas H. at Del Mar and the Nov. 28 Intercontinental H. at Hollywood, before getting up for a nose victory in an optional claimer at Santa Anita Dec. 29. Trying the Polytrack this time, Double Trouble rated last in the four-horse field as Zardana (Crimson Tide {Ire}) took them through a half in :48.58. Tough Tiz's Sis and Somethingaboutlaura took over on the far turn, but Double Trouble drove past the leaders at the eighth pole and opened up to hit the wire a decisive winner. "I was sitting with a lot of confidence because she relaxed so well," said jockey Rafael Bejarano. "I was able to save some ground around the far turn and when we got out there at the top of the stretch, she won pretty easy." A seven-length winner of the Irish Sonnet S. going two turns over the Delaware main track Sept. 26, Bsharpsonata tried the turf for the first time in the Epitome BC S. at Monmouth Oct. 26 and acquitted herself well in a fourth-place finish. She's still perfect. Champion Indian Blessing ran her record to five-for-five, but vesterday's result left a question mark as to just how far she can carry her speed. Dominant in winning the GI Frizette S. and GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies last year, the dark bay filly just held on to beat Golden Doc A in the seven-panel GII Santa Ynez S. at Santa Anita Jan. 13, and the field was gaining on her again here. Jockey Garrett Gomez had the Eclipse winner in hand in second as 90-1 shot Miss Missile (Golden Missile) cut out moderate fractions. Indian Blessing took over as they raced out of the turn and opened up daylight in the stretch, but she was all out to hold on as a dogged Proud Spell closed the gap. "She has to learn how to handle two turns," Gomez said. "I think she can because she's a smart filly. She got a little tired with the super-long stretch at the sixteenth pole." Trainer Larry Jones said of the runner-up, "First race back, it was a nice effort. You don't want to knock them out. Our eye is on the...GI Kentucky Oaks [May 2] and even the Fair Grounds Oaks." 

He followed up with a half-length score in the Nov. 25 GI Hollywood Derby and hung on gamely to cap off the season with a 3/4-length win in the Dec. 30 GII San Gabriel H. Jockey Mike Smith sent Daytona right out to the

lead again yesterday, and he powered away from his rivals in the final furlong to keep the streak alive. "He's a special horse," trainer Dan Hendricks said. "That's one of the most relaxed races I've seen him run. Mike just sat and rode perfect. We learned a lot--he can change course, he can ship, and he can win again." As for what's next, he added, "We've got to think about it. We've got to decide whether to come back [to Fair Grounds for the GII Mervin Muniz Memorial Mar. 8], stay home or go to Dubai." Daytona was catalogued for Monday's session of the Fasig-Tipton Kentucky Winter Mixed Sale, but he has been scratched. MGISW Better Talk Now (Talkin Man), at the back of the pack early, was put to a drive at the top of the lane, but had little response and finished off the board.
