

Moved to the stable of Brian Lynch-an Adena regular--after that win, Sugar Swirl captured the first graded victory of her career with a good-looking tally in a sloppy renewal of the six-furlong GIII First Lady H. at Gulfstream Jan. 13. Yesterday, she successfully doubled up with style while adding a furlong in the Hurricane Bertie. "She's really blossomed as a five-year-old," said Lynch. "She just puts herself into the race when she wants. I wouldn't mind trying to stretch her out again, but we've got the mare that won earlier today [Spring Waltz took the sixth race allowance at 1 1/8 miles] for the GII Rampart H. [at Gulfstream Mar. 91, so we'll let this one come back in the seven-eighths [\$200,000 GII Shirley Jones H. at Gulfstream Mar. 22]. As good as she is now there are all kinds of options for her."



Rated Fiesty DQ Upheld:

After a 45-minute hearing Saturday morning, the Arkansas Racing Commission voted 4-0 to uphold the disqualification of Heiligbrodt Racing Stable and JMJ Racing's Rated Fiesty (Exchange Rate) from first to third in the \$50,000 Dixie Belle S., according to published reports. The commission also upheld the three-day suspension given to the three-year-old filly's rider in the race, Luis Quinonez. Hot Springs attorney Larry Honeycutt, representing Quinonez and Heiligbrodt, said both cases would probably be appealed to Garland County Circuit Court, but not heard until after the Oaklawn meeting ends April 12. Unbeaten in three starts last year, including wins in the GIII Debutante S. and GIII Kentucky Breeders' Cup S., Rated Fiesty hit the line a neck in front in the Dixie Belle, but had her number taken down when stewards determined the filly came in on a rival. Kadira (Kafwain) was awarded the victory. Steve Asmussen trains Rated Fiesty.

"Ron Sayers wanted me to pick the best filly in the sale on type and residual, and she was it," Gabbedy said. "She's a beautiful filly--very correct. Her sire is going great and her pedigree is first class." Records were established as yesterday's session concluded the first section of the Sale. The cumulative average of A\$50,514 topped last year's record of A\$46,080 and the aggregate of \$A16,265,500 also set a new high. "Quality yearlings attracted great interest and we were delighted to have plenty of new faces-particularly from the Eastern States at the sale," Magic Millions Managing Director David Chester said. "As well, a few interstate vendors have already suggested they will be looking at bringing more quality yearlings to Perth in 2009. Plenty of our interstate clients said they had trouble securing the horse's they liked with the locals providing stiff opposition.
