#### PYRO POSTS PROFESSIONAL SCORE

It may have lacked the electrifying quality of his Feb. 9 GIII Risen Star S. victory, but yesterday's

GII Louisiana Derby showcased the professional side of **Pyro** (Pulpit). The Winchell homebred waited for running room in midstretch, came through smoothly and went on to post a threelength tally in the \$600,000 affair. "The last time we were very cautious," said winning trainer Steve Asmussen. "Today, these were some very

good horses. We prepared well. It looks like he's right on target." Pyro, who at 4-5 was the first odds-on winner of this race since Repent in 2002, gave Asmussen his second Louisiana Derby victory following Fifty Stars in 2001. **Tale of Ekati** (Tale of the Cat) broke poorly on his way to a sixth-place finish in his seasonal debut. **Majestic Warrior** (A.P. With Aqueduct shrouded in fog yesterday, observers had to take announcer John Imbriale's word for it that **Visionaire** (Grand Slam) caboosed the field early, but

the chestnut came into sight rapidly as the wire approached in the GIII Gotham S. He reeled in Texas Wildcatter (Monarchos) to win by a nose. "We went in the TV room and couldn't see a darn thing," said co-owner Barry Irwin of Team Valor. "That's the way to watch a horse race: just

watch the last eighth, then you don't get nervous. We were very nervous because of the way the track was playing." The highly regarded colt will likely try to follow in the hoofprints of Team Valor Hall of Fame member Captain Bodgit, runner-up in the GI Kentucky Derby in 1997. "Captain Bodgit won the Wood Memorial in the slop, so maybe this one can," Irwin noted. "But we'll take it one race at a time." The handsome colt showed an impressive turn of foot in winning the GIII Risen Star S. Feb. 9 over track and trip, covering the distance in 1:44 3/5. The visually impressive effort was countered by relatively low speed figures--96 BRIS, 90 Beyer--but no one told the three-year-old to worry this time. Bet down to odds-on, Pyro settled into a ground-saving fourth as 60-1 **My Pal Charlie** (Indian Charlie) showed the way through splits



of:24.10,:48.07 and 1:13.86. Pyro was trapped behind horses turning for home, but Shaun Bridgmohan sat chilly aboard his patient colt. He came through a seam inside the eighth pole and opened up nicely for his second straight graded win. "I was not panicking with

my position at all," Bridgmohan offered. "I knew what I had, and he gave it to me. A spot opened for him on the straightaway for home, and he went about his business." The Winchell homebred is scheduled to head to the GI Toyota Blue Grass S. at Keeneland Apr. 12 for his final Kentucky Derby prep.

My Pal Charlie, a half-brother to MGSW Bwana Charlie coming off a pair of Fair Grounds scores, stayed on for second over Yankee Bravo (Yankee Gentleman), who rallied from last. "We were the longest shot on the board and we finished second," enthused reinsman Julien Leparoux. "If he relaxes a little more, I think he can go farther. But today we got beat by a monster." Yankee Bravo was perfect in three starts coming into this contest, with stakes wins on turf and Tapeta. "He did not break well," said jockey Alex Solis. "I wanted to be fourth or fifth. I had to be a little more patient than I wanted to. I think that hurt him, but I settled on the backside. For his first run on dirt, I was very pleased." GI Hopeful S. hero Majestic Warrior (A.P. Indy), off since finishing sixth in the GI Champagne S. Oct. 6, had a wide trip en route to a seventh-place finish. The big bay flattened out in the final furlong. "He ran extremely smooth and relaxed off the layoff," reported rider Garrett Gomez. "I was in a good spot throughout the race. I ran a good race to the eighth pole. I am very encouraged with his performance." As for Tale of Ekati (Tale of the Cat), a poor start dashed his chances. "It didn't work out the way we had planned," explained rider Edgar Prado. "I was supposed to be close, but we broke badly." The GII Futurity S. winner, sent off as the 9-2 third choice, wound up sixth.



He returned to action in the GII San Carlos H. Feb. 16 at Santa Anita, putting in a mild run to finish fifth in that seven-furlong contest. Sent off as the fourth choice here with blinkers on, the Tabor homebred made his move turning for home, getting the jump on Grasshopper. The four-year-olds exchanged the lead late, but Circular Quay determinedly got his head down on the line.



Second in his career opener at Delaware Oct. 7, Visionaire captured what has turned out to be a key Laurel maiden Nov. 23, when he defeated Elysium Fields in a one-mile contest. He added a 5 1/2-length allowance score for Vision Racing at Gulfstream Jan. 4, a performance which led Irwin to purchase 51 percent of the sophomore. The rangy colt made his stakes bow in the GIII Risen Star S. Feb. 9 at Fair Grounds, finishing a solid third to Pyro. Sent off as the third choice here, Visionaire was unhurried early by Jose Lezcano as favored Saratoga Russell (Trippi) apparently set splits of :23.78 and :46.37. Those fractions took their toll on the chalk, who was passed by Texas Wildcatter turning for home. Texas Wildcatter looked to be home free inside the final sixteenth, but Visionaire's spirited rally brought him to the wire in the nick of time. "I knew there was some speed in the race, and I was in no hurry to ask my horse," Lezcano explained. "I guess I was in mid-pack down the backstretch. My plan was just to make one move and come with a strong finish. I felt I had a lot of horse coming off the turn. I think he showed how good a horse he was today--he handled everything." Saratoga Russell faded to eighth. "The first quarter was great, but they went a:23 flat second quarter and that might have been his undoing," trainer Rick Violette Jr. offered. "[Jockey] Eibar [Coa] said he heard some noise galloping out, so he could have displaced or he could just have been really tired. We might go back to sprinting before stretching him out again to give him some confidence back. This is a setback--I'm not sure the first Saturday in May is in our sights." 

Mauralakana, runner-up in the 2006 GI QE II Cup at Keeneland, got her picture taken twice last term under the care of trainer Patrick Biancone, including in the GIII Locust Grove H. at Churchill in July. Making her dirt debut in Monmouth Park's GII Molly Pitcher Breeders' Cup H. in August, she crossed the wire a well-beaten seventh. Back on the lawn in Saratoga's GIII Glens Falls H. in September, she rebounded with a good secondplace finish. Shipped to California for the GI Yellow Ribbon S. Sept. 29, the bay could do no better than sixth. Making her first start since selling for \$900,000 at Keeneland November, Mauralakana was settled in the early stages while racing in third. With Rene Douglas in the irons, she crept up to get within striking distance of the leaders on the turn for home, but had to await racing room. Aggressively swung off the rail in mid-stretch, she came flying on the outside to prevail in a blanket finish. "We got pretty lucky," trainer Christophe Clement said. "I had thought that her best distance was a mile-and-a-quarter, so the change in distance was not too big a concern. She's a good filly. She had a good year last year with Patrick Biancone. She did what good horses do. We will likely look at the [GIII] Orchid [H., on Mar. 30] even though it is at a mile-and-a-half. We don't have much of a choice right now." Douglas added, "I wasn't concerned when I got stuck behind horses. As a rider you have to be confident. I just had to ride my race. When you ride on the grass you have to have patience. I knew that the pace was slow, but I wasn't worried because the horse I was on is very good."

#### Yielding Turf Course Forces Distance Change...

Gulfstream Park track officials were forced to change the distance of the GIII Very One H. due to the yielding turf course. Originally carded to be run at 1 3/8 miles, the Very One was cut back to 1 1/8 miles. "Staff and I contacted horsemen involved in this race and they recognize that, since the safety of horse and rider is the most important concern for all of us, we needed to call an audible," said Bernie Hettel, Gulfstream Park's racing operations manager. "We wanted to keep the race on the grass, but for that to happen, we needed to move the rail [to 84 feet]. Although we labeled the course 'yielding,' it was safe. With the rail placement in mind, we thought the most prudent course of action was to change the distance. Horsemen understand the reasoning for this and support our decision."

Your family is strongly associated with Xtra Heat. What are your favorite memories of her? That Breeders' Cup with Squirtle Squirt (2001 GI Sprint). She got beat just a half-length, I think, and that was about the most memorable race I'd ever seen, at least until this filly came along. It's a little different when you train them.

Do Xtra Heat and Bsharpsonata have anything in common?

Physically, they're totally different, but their temperament is the same.

They both know when it's time (to race), and they both conserve energy. It's so wild to see with a good horse; they know when not to act all crazy. You could lay down and sleep next to these fillies in the stall if you wanted to.

How did you start training for John Sykes's CloverLeaf? Actually, we just called and asked him if we could have a chance with Southwestern Heat (Xtra Heat's son by Gone West). John owned part of the horse, and they were kind of down on him after his first few starts. So I called and asked him to give me a chance. (Note: Southwestern Heat won the Sonny Hines S. in his seasonal finale).

Favorite vacation spot? Huh, I don't do that often (laughs). But I'd have to say Dubai. We went over there twice with Xtra Heat, and I'd go back tomorrow, even if I was 100-1 in the race. They treated us like kings over there and actually give us a little respect. I didn't meet Sheikh Mohammed, but he was very visible and very much around. He was always there, just sitting in his box watching the races.

Favorite food? A big T-bone steak.

What's on your CD player right now? You know, all I listen to is Howard Stern.

Funniest movie? Superbad was pretty funny.

Favorite sports team/favorite athlete? I'm a (Baltimore) Orioles fan, unfortunately. I was a big Cal Ripkin, Jr. fan.

Last purchase? I just got a 2008 Chevy Silverado yesterday! I'm driving home in it right now.

Sent off a history-making A\$1.70 favorite, boom sophomore Weekend Hussler delivered his fourth Group 1 trophy after defying seasoned older sprinter Magnus. #### **New Mount Fees for NYRA Jockeys:**

The New York Thoroughbred Horsemen's Association and the Jockeys' Guild have agreed to a new scale of mount fees for jockeys at the tracks operated by the New York Racing Association. The fees a jockey earns in races with a value of \$99,999 or less has been set at a flat \$100. On the previous scale, jockeys would earn anywhere between \$50 and \$80 per mount, depending on the value of the race. The mount fees on races with purses in excess of \$100,000 will remain at \$105. "It has been more than 15 years since riders last had an increase," commented NYTHA President Rick Violette Jr. "The jockeys were due for an increase and I am pleased we were able to come to an agreement that is fair to both the horsemen and the riders." Added Terry Meyocks, national manager for the Jockeys' Guild, "We appreciate the efforts of Rick Violette and the NYTHA's board on behalf of its membership. Rick and [Guild Chairman] John Velazquez are to be commended for their dedication to coming up with an equitable scale for all concerned parties."
