He was taken to Arcadia Methodist Hospital, and released last night. The 25-year-old visited orthopedic surgeon Dr. Dan Capen Friday. "[Capen] said that the fifth and sixth vertebra touched from the impact, and [they] have cracks in them," his agent, Joe Ferrer said. "They didn't crack through, just in the front. He put a brace on Rafael to keep him stable. He should be able to ride in a month.

It could have been worse. If it was

cracked all the way through, it would have been harder to stabilize." Ferrer added, "Dr. Capen will look at Rafael in another week, but he said he should be out, tops, four weeks, and we could be looking at maybe two or three weeks. He said Rafael is young and he'll heal fast." A native of Peru, Bejarano is currently the second-leading rider in the country with \$3,745,780 in purses.




